Hereafter, after every battle, skirmish, or other engagement, the Commanding Officer of each Regiment, Battery, or other detached portion of a Regiment, there present, will, in addition to the lists transmitted through intermediate Commanders, promptly forward, direct to this office, a correct return of the killed, wounded and missing of his command.

II. As the monthly returns of Regiments, by being transmitted through Brigade Headquarters, are detained and lost, they will hereafter be forwarded direct to this office.
