GENERAL ORDERS, No. 217. WAR DEPARTMENT,

I..It appearing that 2d Lieutenant Curven B. McLellan, 6th U. S. Cavalry, was absent on account of wounds received in battle at the time of his dismissal, paragraph II of "General Orders," No. 199, dated December 4, 1862, by which he was dismissed, is, by direction of the President, hereby revoked.

II. By direction of the President, Assistant Surgeon Thomas C. Pollock, 171st Regiment Pennsylvania Volunteers, is hereby dismissed the service, for improperly furnishing certificates of discharge to drafted men.

III.. So much of "General Orders," No. 195, of November 24, 1862, as dismisses 2d Lieutenant Samuel B. Morse, 7th Wisconsin Volunteers, is hereby revoked, he having previously resigned.
