For her contribution to all our lives, we happily dedicate this issue of the Lancer to her.






BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees of Surry Community College has thirteen members. Each of the following appoints four of the Trustees: the Governor of North Carolina, the Surry County Board of Commissioners, and the boards of education of Mount Airy, Elkin, and Surry County. The thirteenth member is the President of the Student Government Association, who is an ex officio non-voting member. The twelve appointed members serve eight-year terms, but the terms are staggered so that three new members are chosen every odd year.

The Student Advisor Program at Surry Community College is a program in which second-year College Transfer students serve as a big brother/ sister, a helping friend, or a small-group facilitator to the first-year College Transfer students. The program is designed to help individuals understand themselves and to attempt to understand and help those with whom they come in contact.

All of us use coping mechanisms to deal with life's everyday pressures. Some of us use these mechanisms more effectively than others. Some of us find these everyday pressures overwhelming and feel as if we have nowhere to turn for assistance. For most of us, discussing our concerns openly can be the first step in coping more effectively. Hopefully, the Student Advisors will be someone the college transfer students can confide in and from whom they can get help.

Each helper is selected on the basis of his maturity, interest in helping others, ability to relate to others, and willingness to complete all of the training sessions.

Each peer helper is responsible for ten to fifteen students. During the first month of Fall Quarter, each advisor meets with his or her group for one hours each week at a time convenient for the group. During these group sessions, the freshmen have an opportunity to discuss concerns or ask any questions they might have. Group topics might focus on such topics as transfer information, how to adjust to college life, how to make friends, and how to make decisions. Sponsor, Mrs. Sue Jarvis


Marsha Medley
