#1. "LOVE GOD"

... "The most important one," answered Jesus, "is this: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no commandment greater than these."

Mark 12:28-31

... All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.

Matthew 22:40

HEART (EMOTION)

#3 "FOLLOW MF"

ILL: Love makes people do silly things... running red lights... LOVE => Changes me

Following Jesus means **going** where **hegoes**.

...he saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax collector's booth. "Follow me," he told him, and Matthew got up and followed him.

Matthew 9:9

Following Jesus means **doing** what **he does**.

I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you.

John 13:15

ILL: People feel loved when you know their names... people's names in Chicago

Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me."

Matthew 16:24

Following Jesus means **focusing** on him over anything else.
