Life (14:1-8)

- He sought the Lord.
- The Lord gave **<u>Peace</u>**.
- The nation prospered with <u>**strength**</u>.

Test (14:9-15)

Asa found strength by taking a <u>f a i t h</u> <u>r i s k</u>.
God had promised to fight their battles! / Asa is living by God's promises!

Lesson (15:1-7)

"The Lord is with <u>y o u</u> when you are with <u>h i m</u>."
he was the anointed king / WE ARE ADOPTED CHILDREN / ANOINTED BY HIS SPIRIT!
ASA'S LIFE, PHASE 2:

Life (15:8-19)

• They sought God even **<u>more</u>**.

• The nation had peace for 25 years.

• There was even more **<u>prosperity</u>**!

good experience -> do MORE // ILL: PAPER FOR MRS. HINZ ('however's) sometimes you build on what you learned, sometimes you revert to what's easy Test (16:1-6)

Asa found strength by <u>buying off</u> an enemy with God's treasure!

Why? / GP: Have you ever seen God work but then choose to do the next on your own? Lesson (7-9)

• As a could have had <u>**God's**</u> strength at any moment!

If God has our hearts, we have his strength.

ASA'S LIFE, PHASE 3:

• Asa gets a foot disease but fails to <u>**Seek</u> <u>God**</u>.</u>

FINAL LESSONS FOR US:

- God wants to be **<u>involved</u>** in our lives.
- A committed heart still faces <u>temptation</u>.
- The strength we need is **<u>always</u>** there for us.
