Reginald Rose wrote Twelve Angry Men as a ninety-minute segment of the CBS Television series, "Studio One." (Mr. Rose was a colleague of the better-known Paddy Chayevsky, writer of the movies "Marty" and "Network.") Henry Fonda originally starred as Juror Eight.

The action, set, in New York in the late 1950's, details the deliberations of a jury in the murder trial of a nineteen-year-old Black alleged to have knifed his father.
