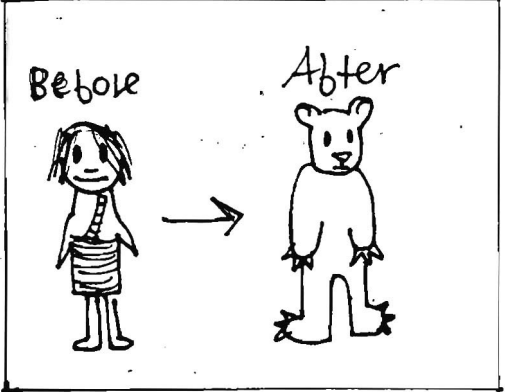

90,000 years ago, a Caveman was mauled by a bear.

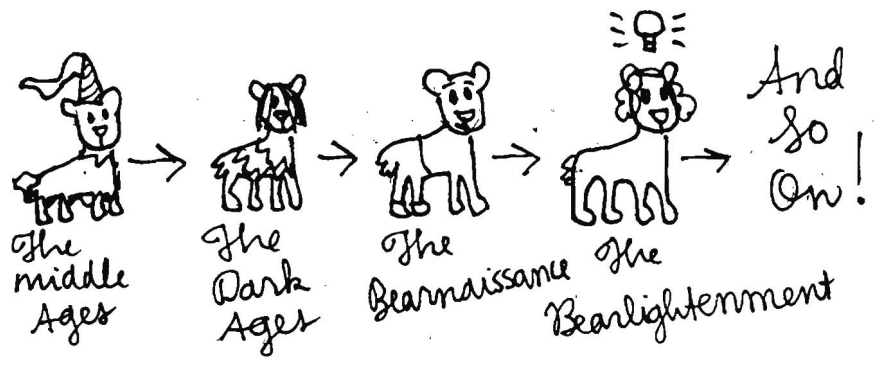
Unfortunately, that bear was carrying a virus that turned the man into a bear.

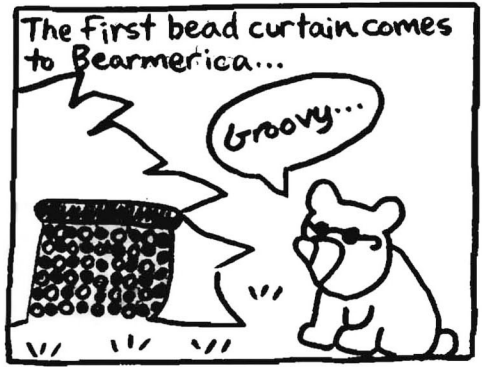
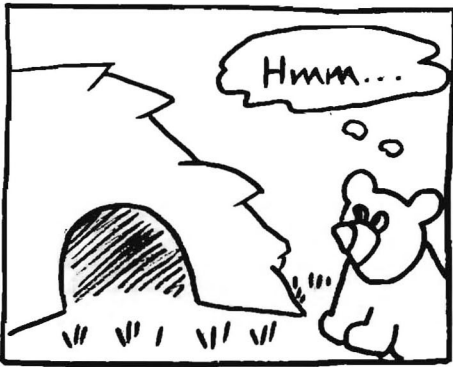


He spread this horrible bear disease throughout the human race until everyone on Earth was a bear with a human brain and bear instincts/powers.

And so, history continued in a familiar pattern—except that everyone was bears, with bear names.





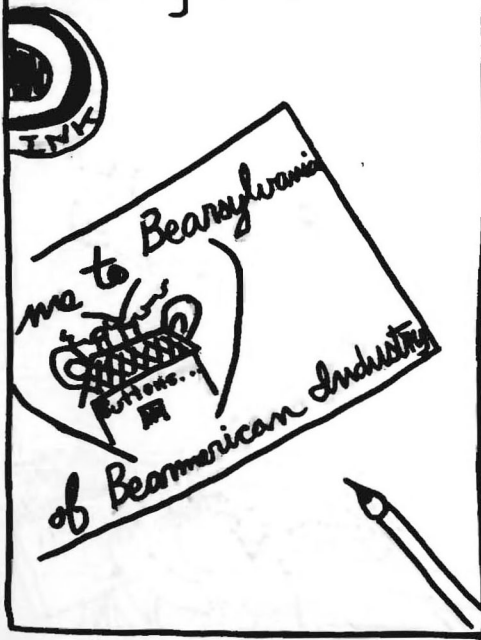

What do I mean by this?

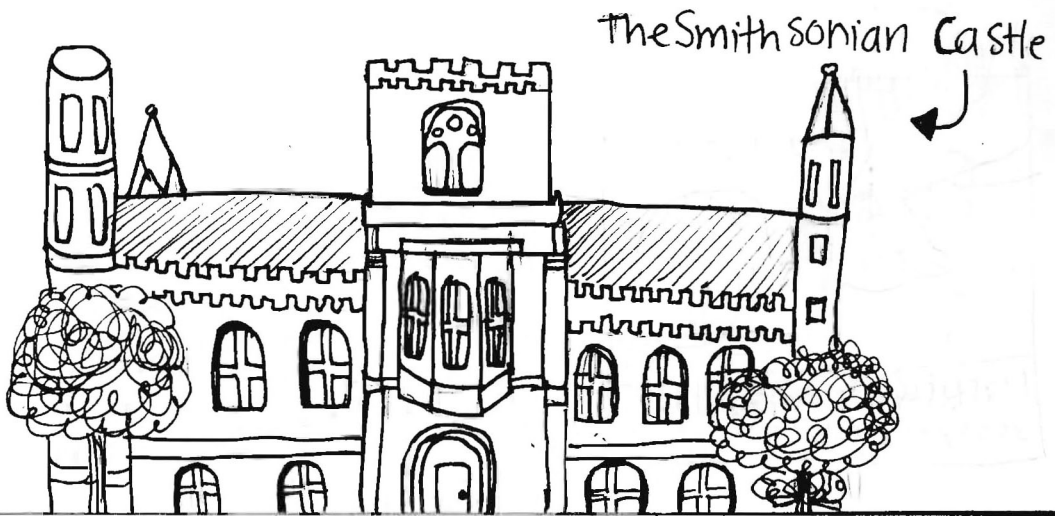
Just take it easy - don't do more than 2 things a day (3 at the extreme).

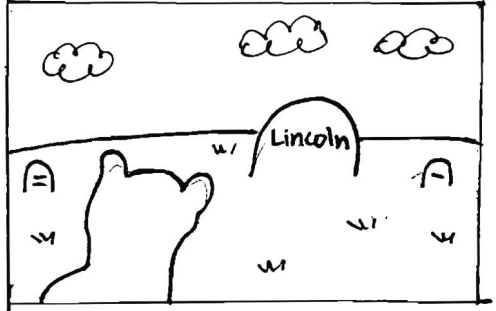


Guiding BEARMERICA through

when he was nine.

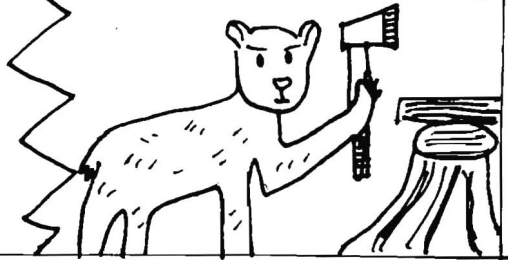


Bearbraham Lincoln was mainly self-educated.  
He was also good with an axe.

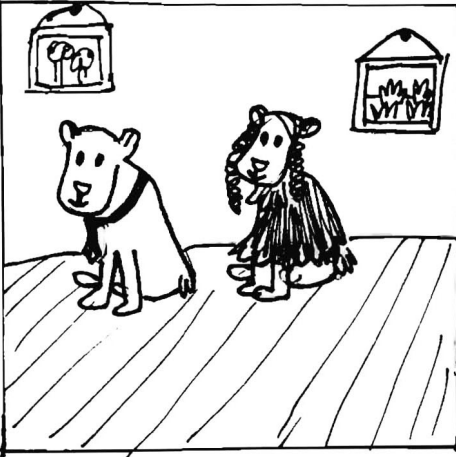

Lincoln on Nov. 4, 1842.



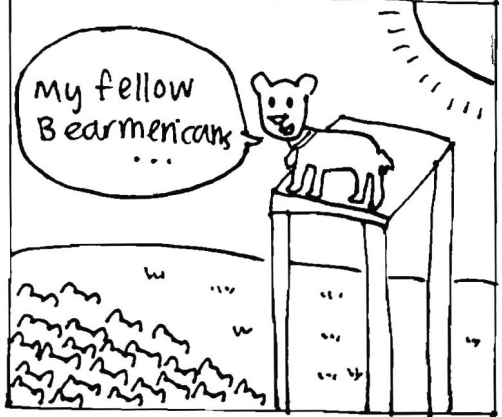
They soon had children.

However, he really wanted to be in politics.

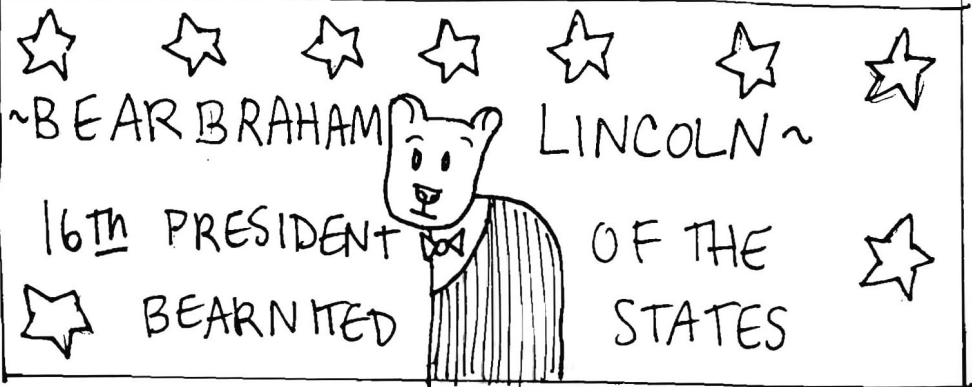


He returned to politics & faced off against Douglas for the Senate.

The Civil War!!!!!!



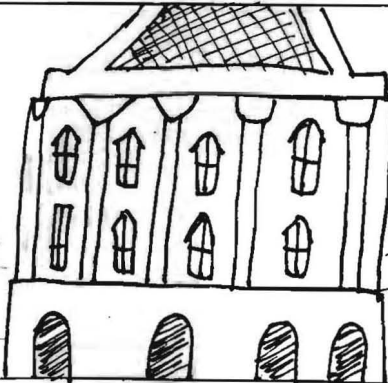
It was a truly terrible
