Iroquois Wanderers



One of the strangest stories in the history of North America is that of a group of eastern Indians who traveled more than 2,000 miles from their homeland and settled in the far west.

In the 1760's a group of 250 Iroquois Indians was recruited by the North West Company to serve as free trappers in distant Alberta, Canada. Woodland Indians, they were not alert to the dangers of life on the plain. Several of them were nearly killed while hunting buffalo. Others were

mangled by enraged grizzly bears.

Nor did the Iroquois get along too well with their red brothers in the west. A party of seventy-five Iroquois stopped at a Gros Ventre Camp and started a gambling match.

A quarrel resulted. Twenty Iroquois were killed and the rest had to run for their lives. Fortunately, some friendly Cree Indians intervened and made peace.

The Iroquois trappers took their steel beaver traps westward to the base of the Rockies and settled down to their trade. Many of them married local Indian women. One group whose descendants were known as Michel's Band (after their leader Michel Calihool) lived on a reservation near Edmonton. Iroquois free trappers crossed the Rockies in their hunt for beaver and other game. There they settled among other tribes such as the Kutenai Indians. The fur traders regarded the Iroquois as expert hunters and trappers. It was said that the Iroquois introduced the use of castor, a scent, as a bait for beaver traps. This became the standard beaver trapping method among the mountain men.

The Iroquois were not merely hirelings of the big fur companies. Many of them were in open competition with such huge organizations as the Hudson's Bay Company. The Iroquois traded guns, ammunition, traps and other items to the Black Feet, Nez Perces and Shoshonas.

By the 1830's Iroquois trappers were found among the mountain men of Wyoming. Indeed, an old tale recounts how an Iroquois trapper working with one of the famed Jim Bridger's fur brigades, led two successful attacks against a Black Feet war party.

One small group of Iroquois settled among the Flat Head Indians in Montana. Here they converted the local tribes to Christianity. They did not hunt, fish, trade or move camp on Sundays.

Other Iroquois were known to have settled among the Crow Indians, too. Today descendants of these Iroquois pioneers are scattered widely throughout almost all of the northwestern states. Historians are just beginning to appreciate the role of the Iroquois in the taming of the far west.
