IS A NOVEL FOR CHILDREN BY ITALIAN AUTHOR CARLO COLLODI (1826 – 1890). THE FIRST HALF WAS PUBLISHED IN SERIAL FORM BETWEEN 1881 AND 1886, AND THE COMPLETED AS A BOOK FOR CHILDREN IN FEBRUARY 1886. IT IS ABOUT THE MISCHIEVOUS ADVENTURES OF PINOCCHIO, AN ANIMATED MARIONETTE, AND HIS POOR FATHER, A WOODCARVER NAMED GEPPETTO. IT IS CONSIDERED A CLASSIC OF CHILDREN'S LITERATURE AND HAS SPAWNED MANY DERIVATIVE WORKS OF ART, SUCH AS DISNEY'S CLASSIC 1940 ANIMATED MOVIE OF THE SAME NAME, AS WELL AS COMMONPLACE IDEAS, SUCH AS A LIAR'S LONG NOSE.
