

- 3. Pull straps over your head and place the lower strap at the base of your neck and the upper strap on the crown of your head.
- 4. Conform the nosepiece across the bridge of your nose by firmly pressing down with your fingers. Check to ensure no air leaks around the edge of the mask.
- 5. Continue to adjust until you have achieved a good facial fit.
