We could read more and more into punk, but let's just leave it as one of culture's outer edges. The punk group playing was R.U.R., sounding straight-out, hard-nose rock and roll with guitars and drums guaranteed to make you jump up and down without synthesized jolts and laser lights.

But punk, it turned out, wasn't necessarily the reason Bookie's was jammed to the rafters Tuesday night. Johnny and the Juke Joints, it turned out, was J. Geils — Peter Wolf, Mean Dick and all that crowd who had just finished three exhausting nights at Pine Knob for \$2,000. They were going to do a gig for free at Bookie's because the word is out nationally. At Bookie's is now Detroit's top stop for anyone on the tour who wants to let it all out.

The limo-driven Geils band came on at 1:15 a.m. and turned out as torrid a set of rock and blues as I have experienced. Had me dancing atop a bar stool. Reminded me of the old Grandee Ballroom scenes a decade ago. From The Den of Forty Thieves to Bookie's, quite a counter-edge odyssey.

OK, brief and to the point—RUR and Flirt were good, the classical group and the jazz band were a decent change of pace (you know, to go walk around outside, make a liquor run, etc.), Sonic's sucked, and the only thing which made Patti's set interesting were the oldies the band performed (Jailhouse Rock, Secret Agent Man,.....)
