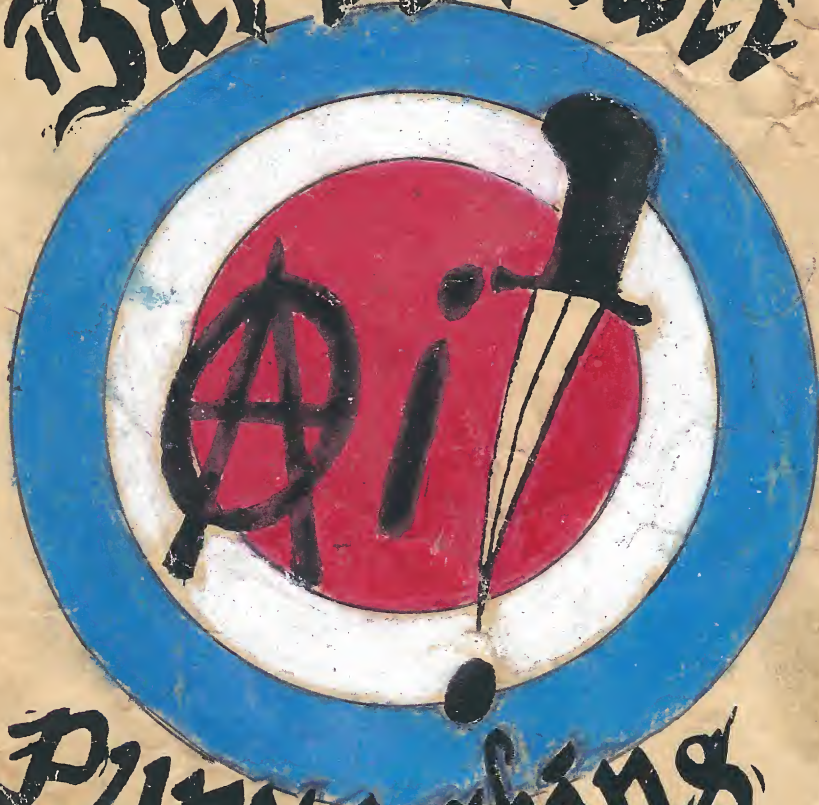

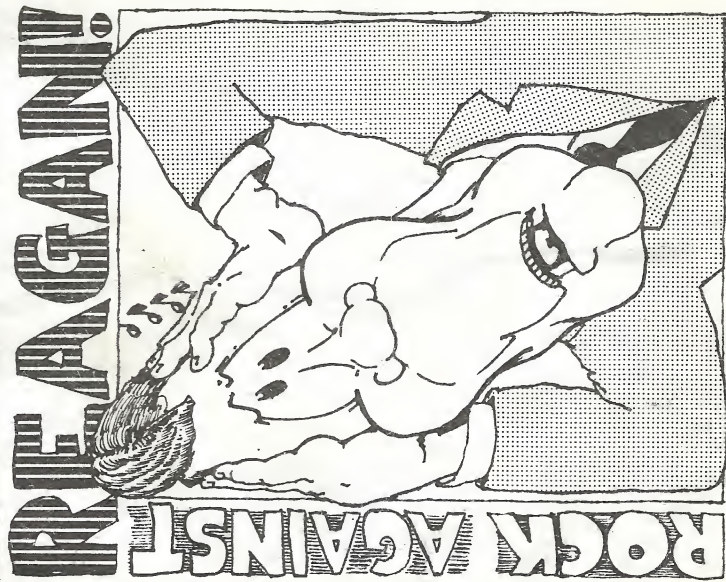

ROCK AGAINST RACISM...

was formed in England during "the hot summer of '76" by musicians and fans in response to a wave of racial violence as opportunistic politicians and a growing neo-fascist party called the National Front tried to blame a floundering economy and high unemployment on nonwhite immigrants taking available jobs. Gangs of alienated white skinheads responded to the N.F. with unprovoked assaults on the immigrants. Along with 'Paki-bashing' came street violence against gays and women.

Amidst this turmoil, one-time Cream guitarist Eric Clapton, speaking between sets at a Birmingham concert, drunk, railed against "foreigners" and urged support for ultra-conservative Member of Parliament Enoch Powell.

Rock Against Racism first surfaced with a letter to *Melody Maker*: "When we read about Eric Clapton's Birmingham concert when he urged support for Enoch Powell we nearly puked." The authors vowed "to organize a movement against the racial poison in rock music."

With punk rock just breaking on the English scene, not yet touched by the music industry establishment, RAR couldn't have picked a better time. Due to a lack of recorded punk sounds, and their similar anti-establishment stance, punks had already begun to listen to reggae, popular with Britain's large West Indian population. Soon reggae and punk bands were playing the same stages to racially mixed audiences.

From 1976 to 1978 RAR had organized over 56 chapters throughout the British Isles. 1978 alone saw some 400 gigs, including many legal defense benefits for demonstrators arrested at anti-racist confrontations. That year RAR coordinated at least two major carnivals in conjunction with the Anti-Nazi League, which resulted in England's largest anti-fascist rallies since the 30's. Among the many bands involved were Steel Pulse, The Clash, Tom Robinson, X-Ray Spex, Misty, the Gang of Four, Elvis Costello, the Buzzcocks, and Graham Parker.

RAR has since become a world-wide phenomenon, branching out autonomously to France, Belgium, Germany, Norway, Australia, Canada, and elsewhere.

In the U.S., concerts have been staged in Los Angeles, CA; Houston, TX; Columbus, OH; and Fayetteville, AR; to name a few. In some places RAR has become an annual happening. For instance, in New York City, an RAR has occurred on the first Saturday in May since 1979.

ROCK AGAINST REAGAN...

has been fostered largely by New York Rock Against Racism and the Youth International Party. We are well aware that Reagan's removal is not a panacea that will solve all our problems, but rather a first step. Reagan's Presidency gives a green light to private interests, opportunists, reactionary law-makers and tax-sponsored weapons fanatics.

The purposes of our concerts are many, but primarily we want to focus on the awareness that people are not inherently powerless against the system.

Reagan exploits each of us in varying ways, by supporting sexism, racism, the draft, nukies, etc. He relies on the splits among us to weaken our effectiveness. When we join together on diverse issues, we undermine the government's ability to dominate us.



The ROCK AGAINST REAGAN Tour

is our way of saying "Heads up, Rommie! You can't sweep us under the rug!" We are looking for people throughout the eastern half of the U.S. who are arranging demonstrations or other anti-Reagan events, and could use our help. We are touring to stop policies like Reagan's:

- **STEPPED UP INTERVENTION IN THE THIRD WORLD**
- **RACISM REVIVAL**
- **REGISTRATION & DRAFT SYSTEM**
- **PREPARATION FOR 'LIMITED NUCLEAR WAR'**
- **NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS**
- **GUTTING OF WOMEN'S AND GAY RIGHTS**

The events will generate a forum on a variety of issues fertilized by Reagan and his obvious motives. The organizers in each locale will determine the priorities of each event, dependent upon which aspects of Reagan-infestation they deem most important.

We are making available:

- *Entire networks of bands, soloists and other performers. See enclosed literature or call for details.*
- *A flatbed truck outfitted as a mobile stage, complete with a custom-built, self-powered, shattering sound system engineered by N.Y. RAR technicians.*
- *T-shirts, buttons, books and other tour paraphernalia.*

The 90-day tour will begin on the Spring Equinox and culminate on the Fourth of July in Washington, D.C. This is actually only the beginning of the build-up for activity surrounding the Republican National Convention in Dallas during August, 1984. A planning conference for 1984 will be scheduled for this September.
