In the late 1950s, his interest in pre-Columbian cultures and architecture lead him to establish his compositions of highly colored and brilliant palettes featuring layers of architectonic elements and geological formations. His art contemplates time and space in its reference to the metaphysical presence and power of Mexico's rugged landscape and its ancient ruins.

Again MOLAA is providing an opportunity through our October art auction for collectors of Latin American contemporary fine art to acquire pieces by emerging artists that have been invited by the MOLAA Exhibition Division and Curatorial Department.

No longer will you have to travel to New York to the Sotheby's or the Christies' auctions to bid on pieces that must be crated and transported back to California as an only option.

We are bringing Latin America to you on Saturday, October 18, 2008 at our Annual MOLAA Art Auction. Personally I am delighted with the auction since I used to travel all over Latin America finding artists and dealers in an attempt to uncover good, emerging artists to acquire for the MOLAA collection. Now our exhibition staff finds them for us by attending every major art show during the year and bringing this art to us here in Long Beach.

This is a unique opportunity to acquire Latin American fine art that varies in price from \$500 works on paper to \$200,000 masters.

Lexus will be sponsoring \$40,000 in prize money for the MOLAA Award competition. In addition, we hope to have in-kind donations to cover most of the auction expenses. This means that what you pay for a piece of art can go directly to MOLAA to support our annual operating expenses. Your cost of purchasing may be partially tax deductible.

You can pick up your art at MOLAA avoiding shipping, insurance and crating costs.

I hope to see you at the Saturday night opening cocktail party and auction where the best opportunity lies for purchase of unique pieces. Auction pieces will be hung on display four weeks prior to the auction giving you plenty of time to peruse the offerings and decide what you want to bid on.

For those people that are unable to attend the Saturday night auction we have an auction on Sunday that is admission free, which will include the remainder of the juried pieces offered as well as other important masterpieces.

MOLAA'S HISTORY& WISSION

In just over a decade, the Museum of Latin American Art (MOLAA) has grown into one of the most comprehensive and representative institutions of contemporary Latin American fine art and culture in the United States. To the community, MOLAA is more than just a museum; it is an enriching educational resource and a magnetic cultural center.

MOLAA's mission is to educate the public about contemporary Latin American fine art through the presentation of a significant permanent collection, dynamic exhibitions and related cultural and educational programs. MOLAA's programs are designed to give a cultural context to the art on display, offering an enhanced understanding of the various peoples and regions of Latin America.

The Permanent Collection, which continues to grow, is the foundation from which all of MOLAA's educational and cultural programming is derived. MOLAA's collection includes paintings, works on paper, sculptures, photographs and video by artists who have lived or worked in Latin America since World War II. In addition to presenting works by Latin American masters, MOLAA introduces the public to contemporary artists of today who are well known in their native countries but who have had little or no exposure in the United States.

The art displayed in the permanent collection galleries is rotated periodically, offering visitors the opportunity to view more of the collection. MOLAA also presents significant temporary and traveling exhibitions to further enhance visitors' experiences with contemporary Latin American art. In 2001, MOLAA was named a Smithsonian Affiliate. This prestigious partnership allows MOLAA to borrow important works from the Smithsonian's vast national collection.

MOLAA's recently expanded building, designed by internationally renowned architect Manuel Rosen, serves as a landmark in Long Beach's East Village Arts District. Monumental arches represent bridges to and from the Americas and the unity of the Western Hemisphere. The expansion doubled the museum's capacity to 55,000 square feet, enabling MOLAA to broaden the range and scope of its exhibitions and public programs and to serve three times more visitors each year.

Through important exhibitions and related educational and cultural programs, MOLAA communicates the reality of Latin America today with the cultural, social, political and economic influences that have shaped its artists. MOLAA builds bridges between diverse peoples and inspires cross-cultural understanding, appreciation and tolerance.

3RD ANNUAL MOLAA AWARDS



Established in 2006, the MOLAA Awards is an invitational Juried Art Competition that recognizes the artistic achievement of contemporary Latin American artists. The MOLAA Awards is one of the museum's most exciting programs. It invites mid-career and emerging Latin American artists from Mexico, Central and South America and the Spanish-speaking Caribbean, to participate in a competition with prize money totaling \$40,000. The competition was created to raise the profile of Latin American art in the United States, to encourage the recognition of Latin American artists by North American audiences and to introduce new trends in contemporary Latin American art.

This year's MOLAA Awards presents a wide range of art created in diverse media and techniques by over 80 Latin American artists. The participating artists have been selected, reviewed and invited by the MOLAA Awards Selection Committee. The MOLAA Awards winners are selected by a panel of distinguished judges from the field of contemporary Latin American art. The judges this year are Dr. Selma Holo, Dr. Catha Paquette and Jose Tasende. Five cash prizes are awarded in the categories of: Best of Show (\$20,000); Two Dimensional Art (\$5,000); Three Dimensional Art (\$5,000); Photography/Video Art (\$5,000) Works on Paper (\$5,000). The five winning works of art will become a part of the MOLAA Permanent Collection; all other works are auctioned on either, Saturday night, October 18, or Sunday afternoon, October 19.

SELMA HOLO

Dr. Selma Holo is Director of USC Fisher Museum of

Art. She is a professor in the USC Department of Art History and Director of the USC International Museum Institute which currently works in close association with the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM) in Mexico City and other museums throughout Mexico. Throughout her career, Dr. Holo has significantly contributed to the advancement of international museology the study of museums and their influences on the shaping of our culture—with a special focus on Spain and Latin America. Among her publications on art and museum practices she authored a book on the art, history and politics of museums in Mexico titled, Oaxaca at the Crossroads: Managing Memory, Negotiating Change (2004). Her most well-known work on Spanish museums and their relationship to society is Beyond the Prado, a study of museums in Post-Franco Spain. Dr. Holo was a Fulbright Scholar and received a Senior Research Award in 1994, earned a Ph.D. in Art History at UC Santa Barbara in 1980, an M.A. in Art History, Hunter College, City University of New York, in 1972, and B.A. in Spanish Literature, Northwestern University in 1965.



CATHA PAQUETTE

Dr. Catha Paquette is Assistant Professor of Latin American Art in the College of the Arts at California State University,

Long Beach. In her research and publications, she focuses on Mexican art in the early to mid-20th century, including mural art produced by Mexican artists working in the United States. Dr. Paquette also investigates issues concerning U.S./Latin American intercultural relations and U.S. museums' reception of Latin American art. She is a recipient of the 2007-2008 Getty Foundation Postdoctoral Fellowship in the Arts and Humanities and is currently working on a book about Diego Rivera's 1933 Rockefeller Center mural. Paquette received her Ph.D. in the History of Art at University of California, Santa Barbara in 2002, an M.A. from UCSB in 1997, an M.B.A. from New York University in 1980, and a B.A. from Wheaton College, Massachusetts in 1974.



JOSE TASENDE

Jose Tasende is the President of Tasende Gallery. Established in the late 1960s in Acapulco,

Mexico, Tasende Gallery is internationally recognized for representing some of the most important 20th Century artists including Matta, Henry Moore, Isamu Noguchi, Lynn Chadwich, Eduardo Chillida, Niki de Saint Phalle, among others. In 1979, Tasende moved the gallery to the United States, opening in La Jolla, California and subsequently in West Hollywood (1998). Since its inception, Tasende Gallery has represented the art of Jose Luis Cuevas. In the early 80s, the gallery organized a traveling exhibition for the artist titled *Intolerance* based on a series of large format drawings.

The exhibition traveled to UCLA's Frederick S.Wight Gallery and 12 other American and European museums. Tasende Gallery is also highly recognized for its important monographs on artists such as Helen Frankenthaler, Auguste Rodin, Lynn Chadwich, Eduardo Chillida, Andres Nagel and others. Jose Tasende has recently authored a book on John Ford titled, *Action! Memoirs of a Spectator.*

3 All bidders must register in order to bid on items in the auction. Registration will be on a confidential basis and no bids will be accepted from unregistered bidders. To register prior to the day of the auction, call MOLAA at 562.437.1689.

4 On the day of the auction, registered bidders will receive a numbered paddle for identification during the bidding and as an instrument with which to make their bids. The lots listed in the catalog will be offered in their numerical order. We reserve the right to withdraw any property at any time and shall have no liability for each such withdrawal. We reserve the right to reject any bid. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer will be the purchaser. In the event of any dispute between the bidders or in the event of doubt on our part as to the validity of any bid, the auctioneer will have the final discretion either to determine the successful bidder or to re-offer and resell the article in dispute. If any dispute arises after the sale, our sale record is conclusive. Although in our discretion we will execute absentee bids as a convenience to clients who are not present at the auctions, we are not responsible for any omissions therewith.

5 If the auctioneer decides that any opening bid is below the value of the article offered, he may reject the same and withdraw the article from sale, and if, having acknowledged an opening bid, he decides that any advance thereafter is insufficient, he may reject the advance.






