

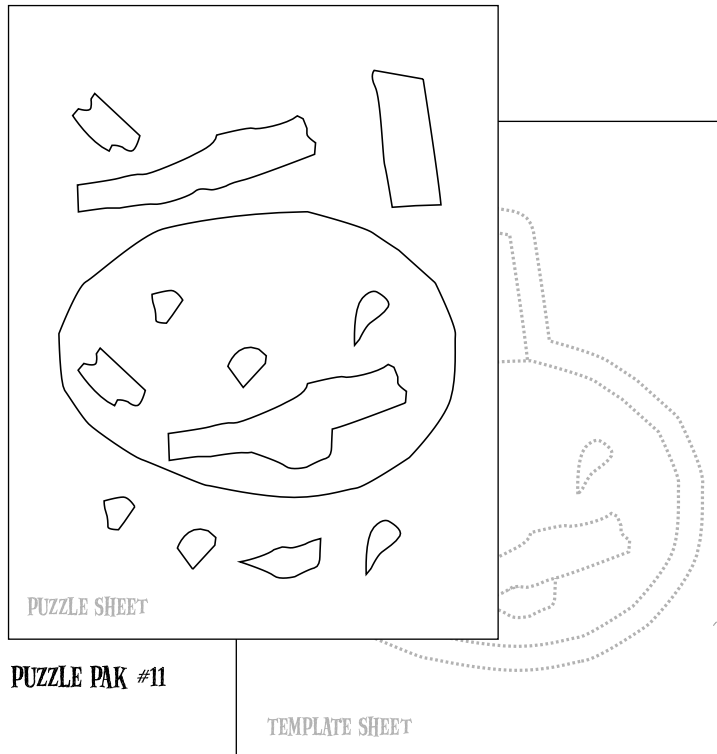

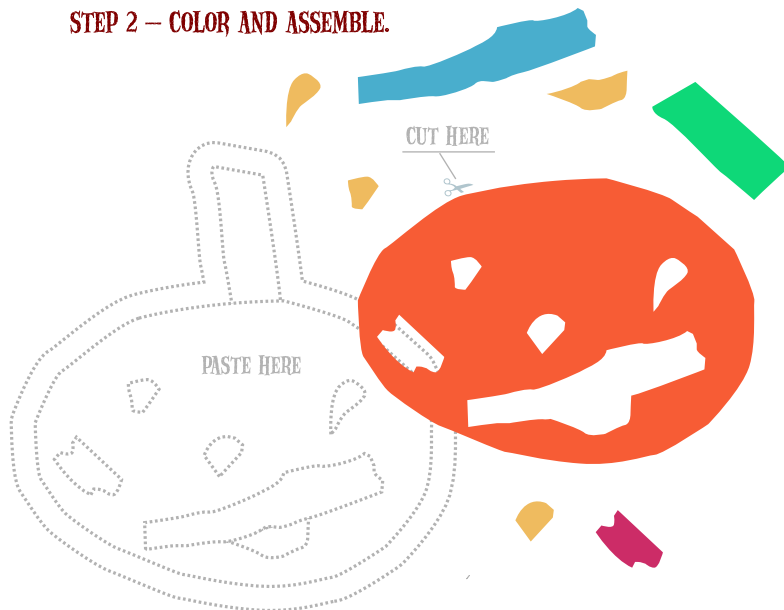

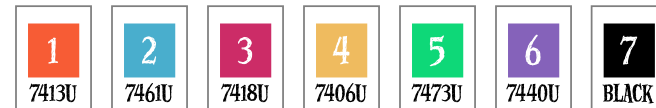
ABOUT THIS BOOK: The Pumpkin Puzzle Pak Book began as an arts and crafts project with my son. We made pumpkin faces out of construction paper and digitized each one for posterity by photographing them with a Canon EOS D60 and painstakingly tracing and calibrating each one using Adobe Illustrator and the Pantone Color Matching System. Once that process was complete, we realized that we could reassemble each one by creating puzzle paks, and that the puzzles become exponentially more challenging with each pak that you add to the mix.



YOU WILL NEED:

STEP 3 – VOILÀ! INSTANT ART. >>

- One printed copy of each puzzle pak you want to use
- Crayons, paint, markers or construction paper closely matching the seven colors used in the original pumpkins*:

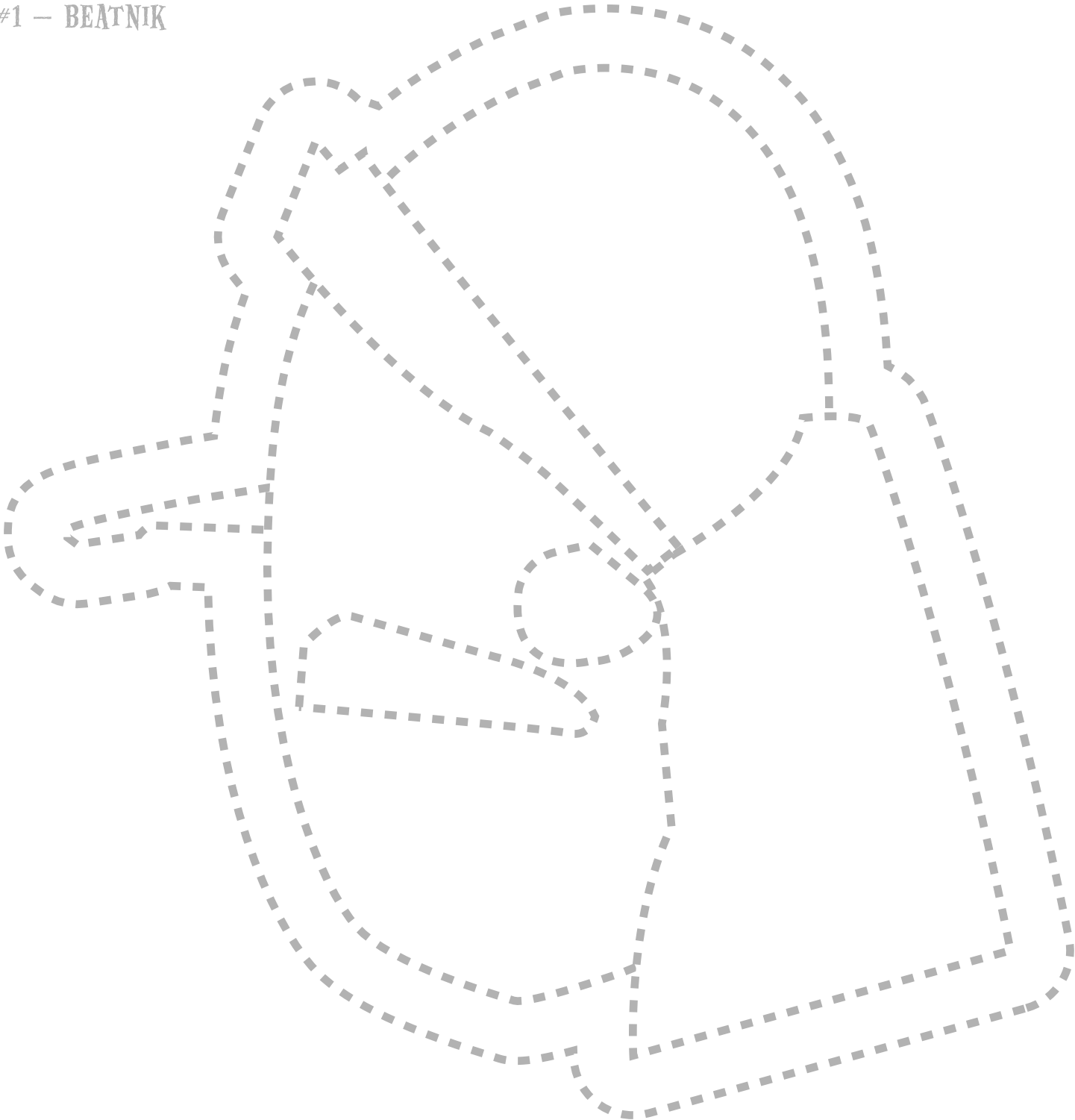


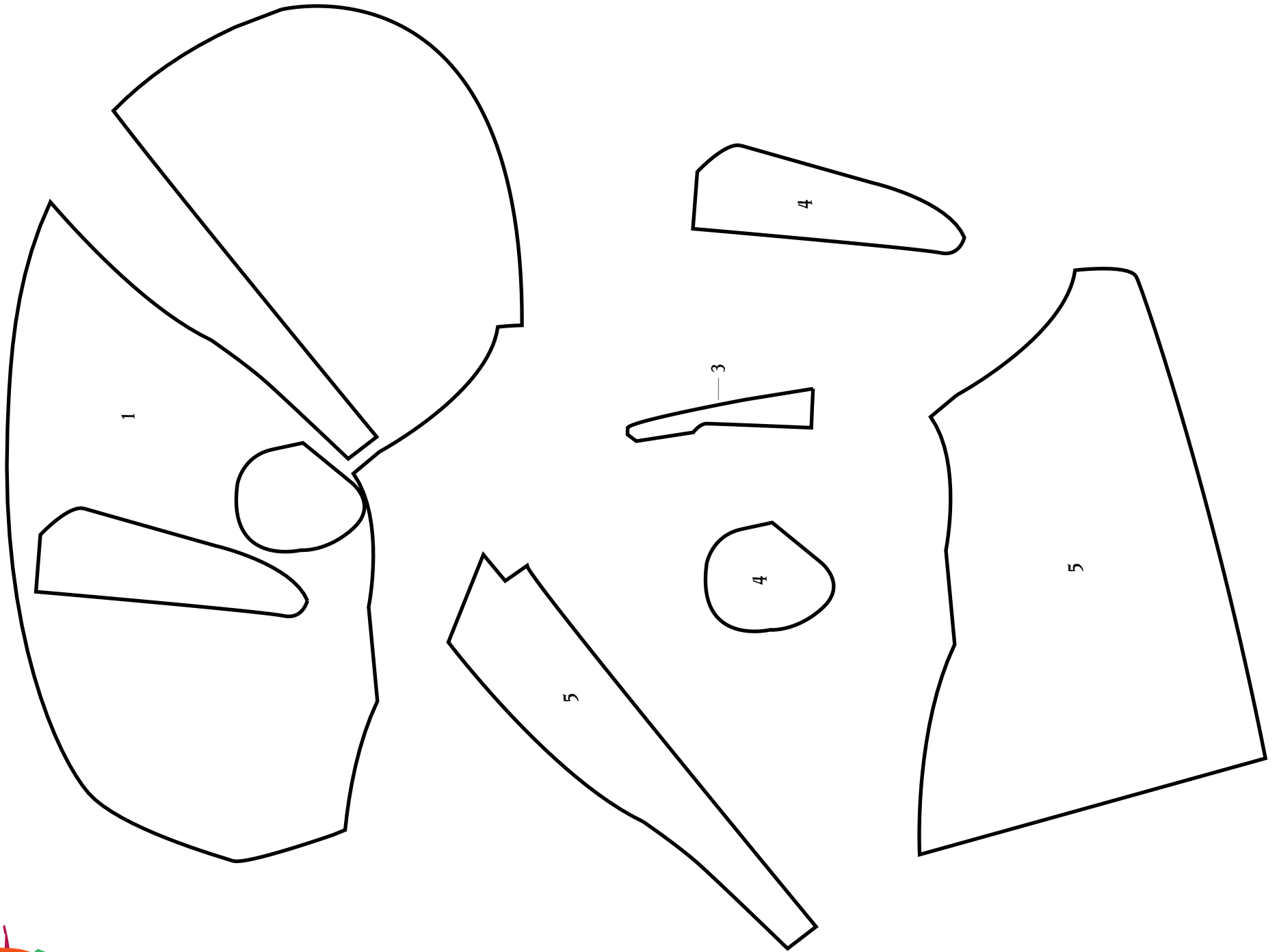
- One pair of scissors
- One bottle of kid-safe glue or glue stick.
- One roll of tape (for hanging up your finished creations!)

Print the desired puzzle paks to your printer (puzzle and template sheet). If you are using construction paper, use the puzzle sheet as a cutting template for the sheets. Otherwise, color or paint directly onto the puzzle sheets using the Pantone numbers as a guide. Once you have a cut-out of each of the puzzle pak sheets you want to work with, mix the pieces of the puzzle sheets together to make the project more challenging. Match up each of the pieces to their space on the template sheets and glue into place.

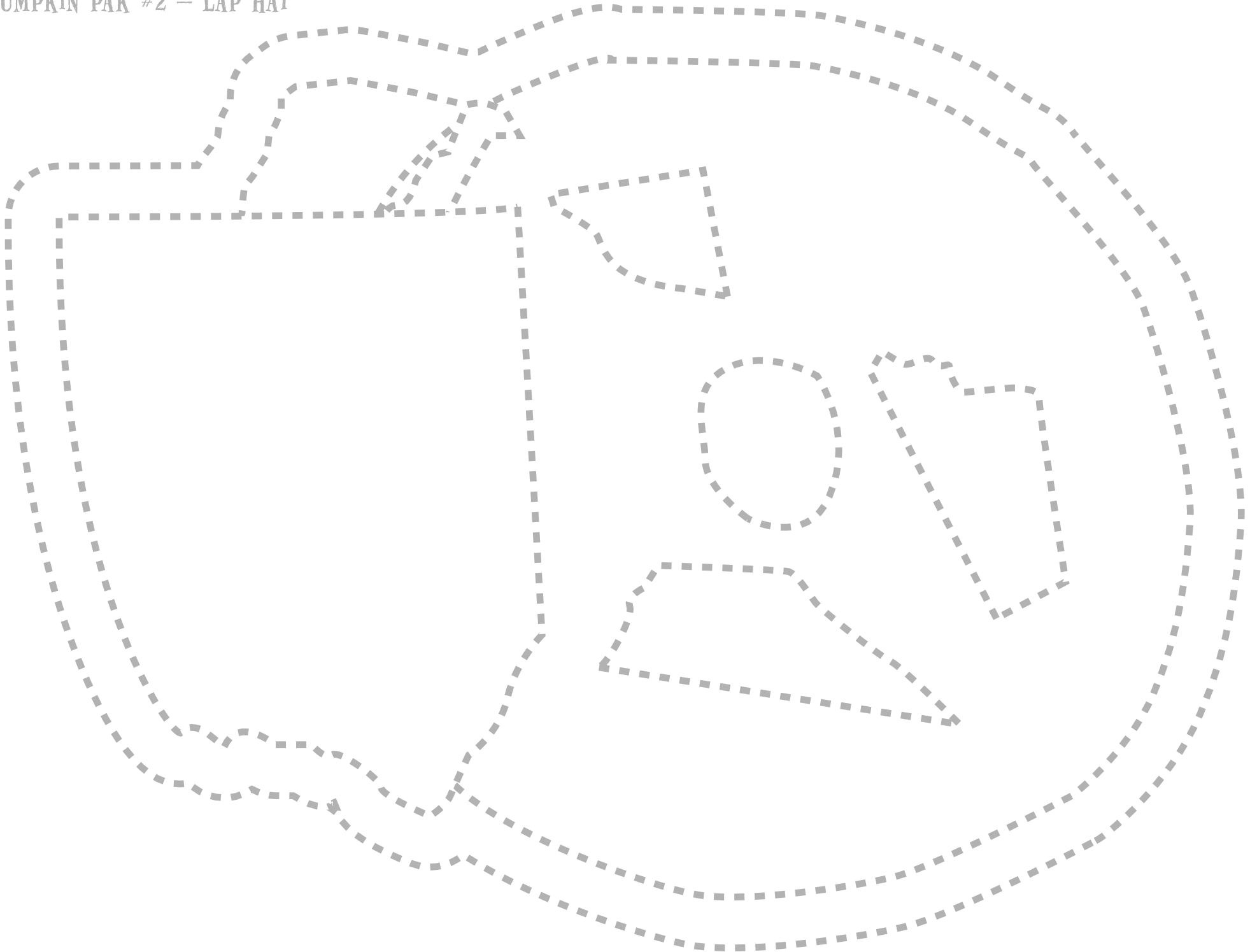
*Pantone color selections were based on standard construction paper sheets used in the original pumpkin designs. However, based on the selection available at your local arts and crafts store, YMMV (your mileage may vary).
