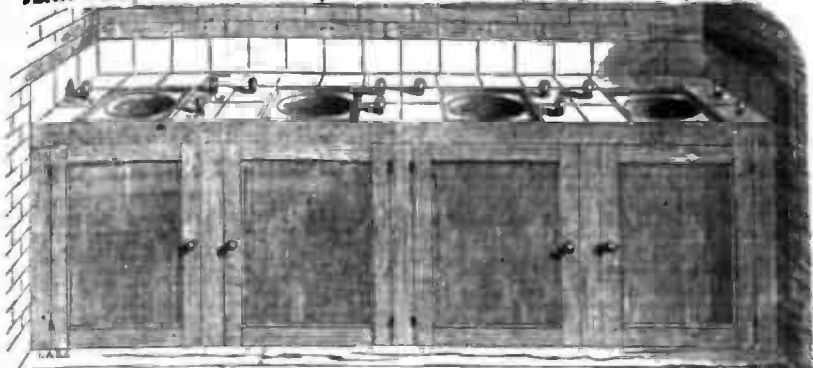
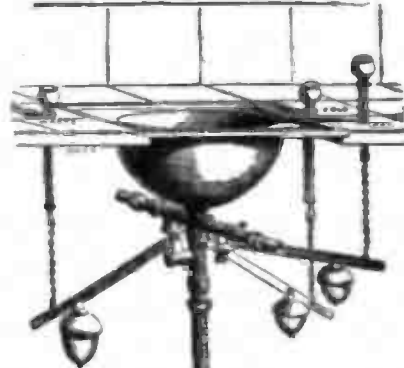

These Lavatories, from the simple arrangement of the THREE INDIA RUBBER TUBE COCKS—HOT, COLD, and WASTE,—have been much approved of, the cocks (being self-closing) cannot be left running—this is most important in LUNATIC ASYLUMS and PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

They were adopted throughout the WEST DERBY ASYLUM by Wm. MOSSELEY, Esq. in the early part of 1860; they have given such satisfaction that they are at this time described to be used by the same gentleman in several important works.

They were also adopted by T. H. WYATT, Esq. at the NEW WILTSHIRE ASYLUM, DEVIZES, in 1860; and they are now being supplied throughout the ST. LUKE'S LUNATIC ASYLUM, LONDON, under the direction of the same gentleman.

They have also been fitted in the mansion of Sir J. K. SUTCLIFFE, GAWTHORP HALL, LANCAHIRE, now in progress under the direction of Sir CHARLES BARRY. They have also been approved and adopted by W. S. DICKIN, Esq. Architect.
