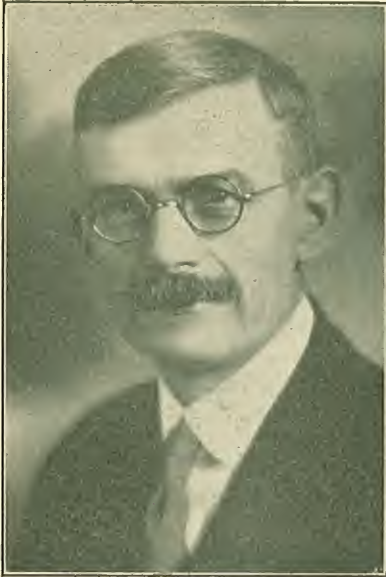

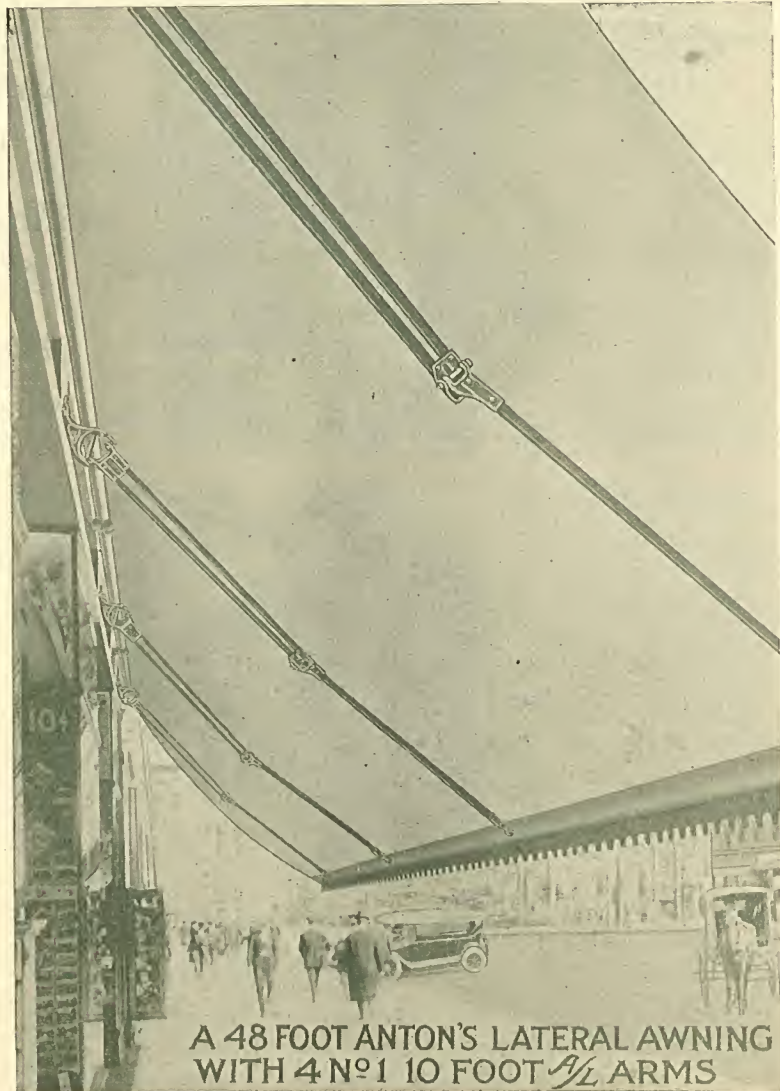

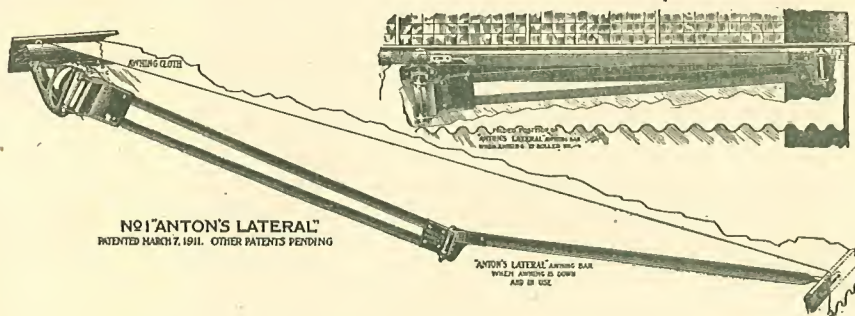

# No. 1 Anton's Lateral Arm

Especially designed to be used on high store fronts or in cases where a large projection is wanted. Made in two lengths.

No. 1 Anton's Lateral Arm 9 feet long, weight 49½ lbs.  
 No. 1 Anton's Lateral Arm 10 feet long, weight 53 lbs.



On this page is shown design No. 1, in which design we manufacture two lengths of Anton's Lateral Arms, 9 ft. and 10 feet. The projection on a given length of arm varies, depending to what height of wall the arm may be adjusted.

The various projections on each length of arm, 9 ft., 10 ft., adjusted to the various heights of wall, are enumerated in the table below. Allowing one wrap around a 3 inch wood roller, we cut the cloth for each arm as indicated in table as slant.

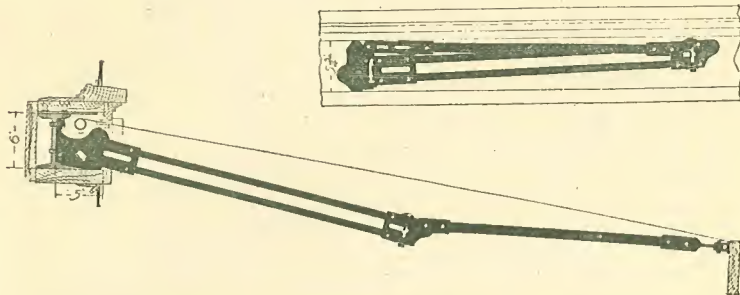

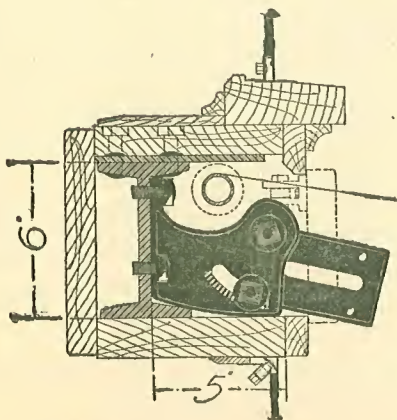

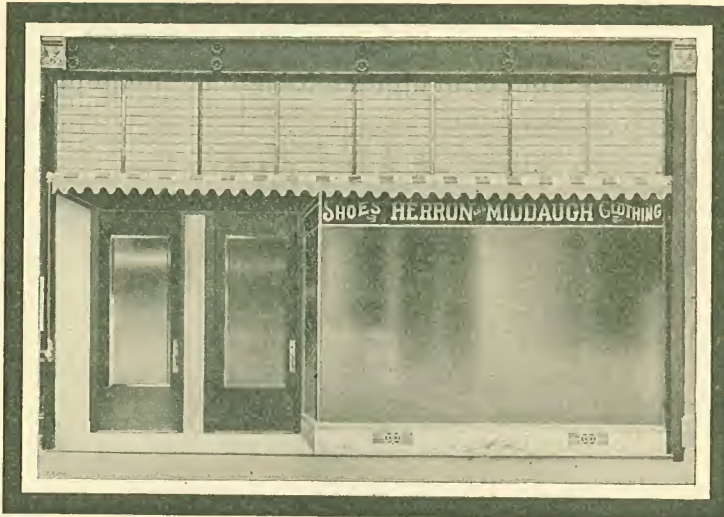

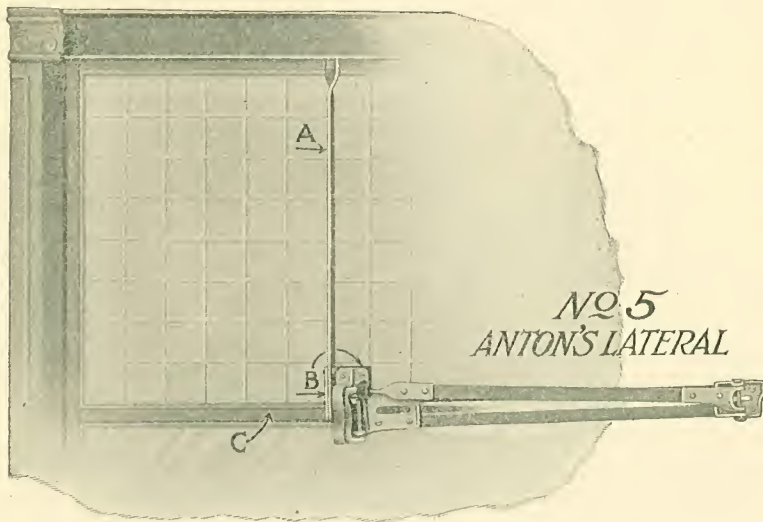

## The Modern Front MINUS a Modern Transom Bar



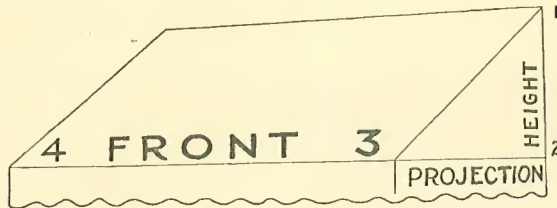
THE SKETCH above shows a modern prism plate glass store front, with a transom bar as much out of date as only lack of knowledge can devise it. Thousands of fronts are built every year similar to the illustration above. The awning is supposed to be carried by and fastened to the weak and flimsy transom bar, in construction so light that often it will not carry the weight of the window light. It is out of the question to expect such a faulty design and construction to stand the strain of an awning.

The picture above shows how to overcome the difficulty in a satisfactory and highly efficient manner, by transferring the strain to the I Beam or wood jamb above. A is a steel bar  $\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{4}$  inches, fastened on top by means of one bolt or lag-screw, and on the bottom to plate B by means of two rivets. B is a plate  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch thick, one edge turned to receive the bar A. The plate B, aside from being riveted to bar A, is fastened on the bottom with two wood screws to the weak transom bar C. The plate B is provided with holes to receive the hanger bracket of Anton's Lateral Arm or other roller fixtures.

# INSTRUCTIONS

## FOR FINDING PRICES OF PORCH AND STORE AWNING COVERS



- Measurements for HEIGHT.....from Figures 1 to 2.  
 Measurements for PROJECTION.....from Figures 2 to 3.  
 Measurements for FRONT.....from Figures 3 to 4.

In figuring on Awning Covers note:

- 1st: The sum of the Height and Projection.
- 2nd: The Width of Front.

METHOD: Add the feet and inches of Height to the feet and inches of the Projection. (Example—Height 6 feet 2 inches plus Projection, 6 feet 2 inches—12 feet 4 inches.)

As prices are figured in even feet only, take next higher scale; as in example 13 foot rate should be used. Locate the figure "13" under heading "SUM OF HEIGHT AND PROJECTION" at the top of column. Follow down this column until you locate the number representing the feet of FRONT measurement. Where front measurements exceed the foot measurement over 4 inches take next highest scale.

### Directions for Putting Up Regular Style Gear Roller Awnings

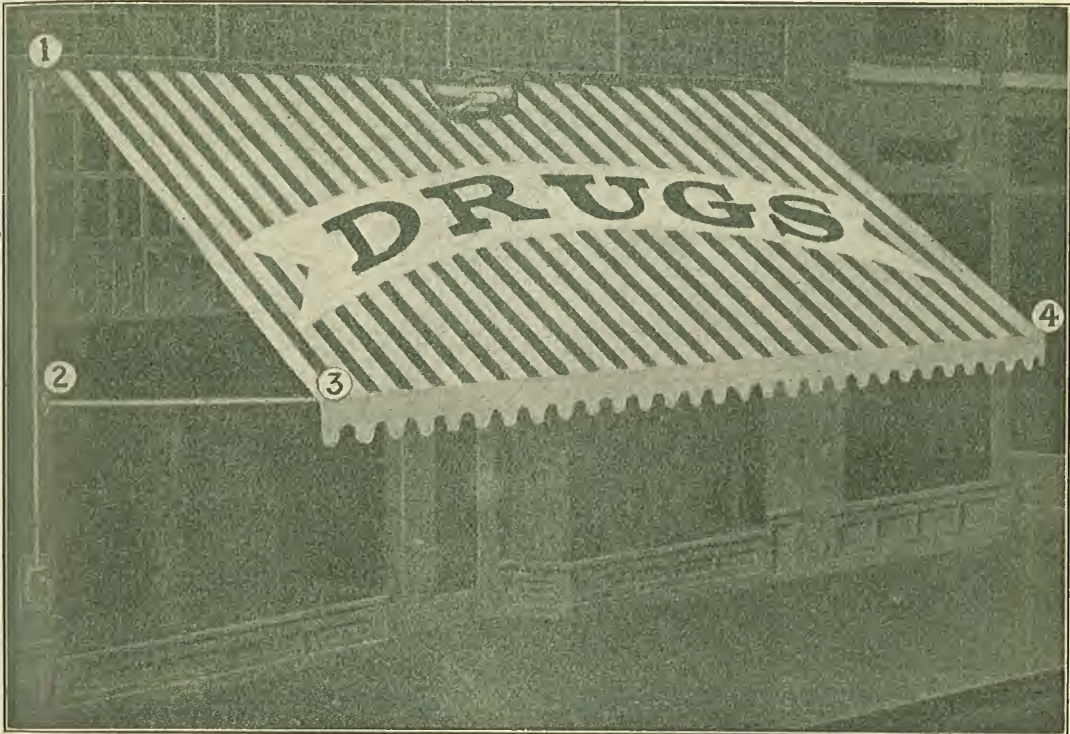
Determine the place where the awning fastens to the building at the extreme right and left ends at the top. The end at which the gear box is to be placed, fasten the cog gear for top. On the opposite end place the end bracket. The bearings of these two parts must be in perfect line. After these parts are securely fastened, draw a line from center of cog gear to bracket, across the building; ascertain how many center supports you have, divide the extreme widths into as many equal parts as there are center supports.

The center supports consist of top and bottom part; the lower part of the supports is the one that has several rollers on it, while the top part has but one roller. Place the center support in position, allowing space for the roller between them. After center supports are fastened place the long roller in position, and fasten securely at each end, then tack the cloth on the roller, allowing the cloth to roll over, not under. Be careful to get the cloth to come straight. By measuring from the front bracket to the roller you will get the equal distance all along. Do not be guided by the upper edge of the canvas, for it is not always straight.

After the cloth is fastened to the roller, place the joints or hinges on the building at proper distance from the top, then put the front pole in the bracket provided at the front above the scalloped curtain. Then fasten the extending arms through the front pole to the joints, which you have fastened to the building. Attach the gear rod to the top gear, then fasten the winding box, so the lower end of the gear rod will fit right into the gear box. Tighten up all bolts and your awning is ready for operation.



## Regular Style Bevel Gear Roller Awnings



**A** BEVEL GEAR ROLLER AWNING is popular because it operates easily and does not get out of order. It has a neat appearance and is made for service.

We use only the very best of fixtures and make the Awnings extremely rigid.

If re-inforcing bands are wanted on the covers, add one foot to the front of the cover for each band, when finding price.

### Directions for Measuring Bevel Gear Roller Awnings

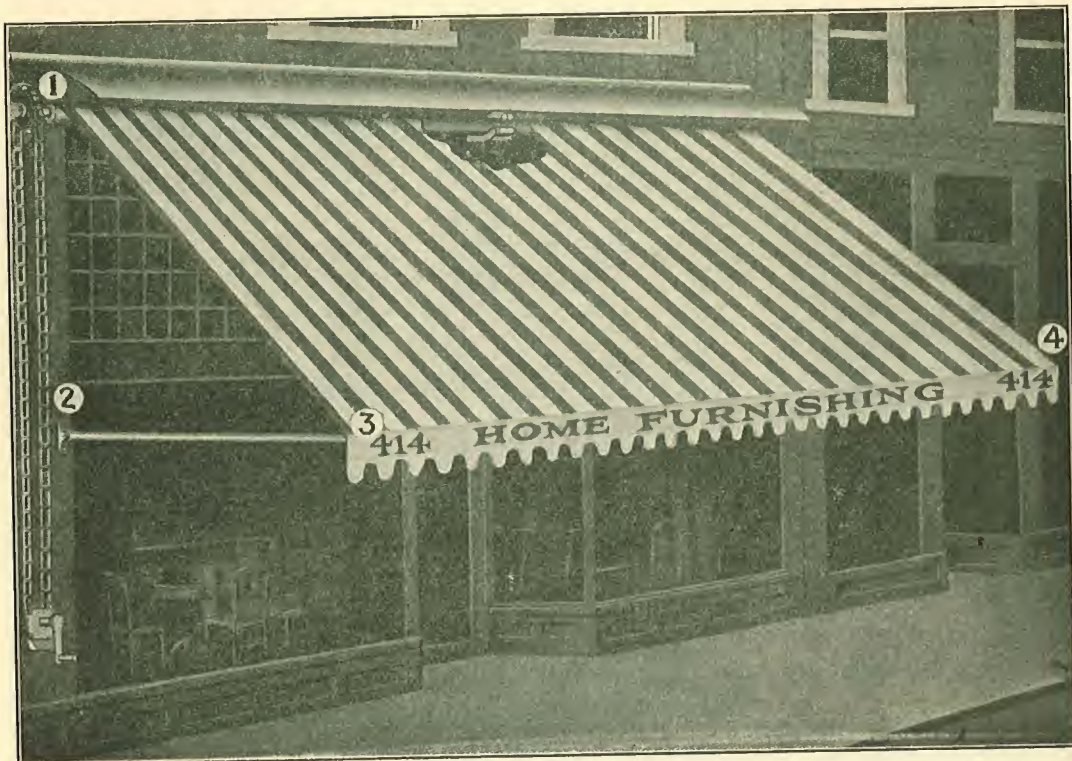
First determine the place where joints of frame should be fastened to the building; which should be 7 feet from the side walk. Then measure from where the frame fastens at the top (1 to 2); then measure from where the joints fasten to the building where awning is to project (2 to 3). The last measurement is the width of the awning, as illustrated (3 to 4).

State if awning fastens to wood, stone, brick or iron. Also if in line with the upright column. Also advise what material is in the columns.

## Chain Gear Roller Awnings



**T**HIS STYLE AWNING is popular; it operates easily and is easily repaired if it gets out of order.

THE CHAIN GEAR ROLLER AWNINGS are the same price as the Regular style Gear Roller Awnings, and you may figure them on the same list which appears on pages 20 and 21 for Covers. Page 22 for Fixtures.

THE DIRECTIONS for measuring and putting up are also the same.

YOU WILL NOTICE that the Roller Awnings are illustrated without ends, but if ends are wanted specify right or left end. This can be determined by standing in front of the Awning facing it.

If ends are not especially needed we do not recommend them, because Roller Awnings work more smoothly without them.

Always specify on your order whether ends are wanted or not.

## Automatic Roller Awnings



**T**HIS STYLE AWNING is designed for use on low store fronts. It is used on the same style fronts as the Anton-Lateral, but we do not recommend it as highly as the Anton-Lateral for the reason, that it is not as neat and not as practical. It is a little less expensive and for this reason we list it.

It is used when more of a projection is needed than height. The illustration shows that a slide rod is used instead of a hinge joint on the building, so that the end of the arm will slide up or down and allow the Awning to open or fold up.

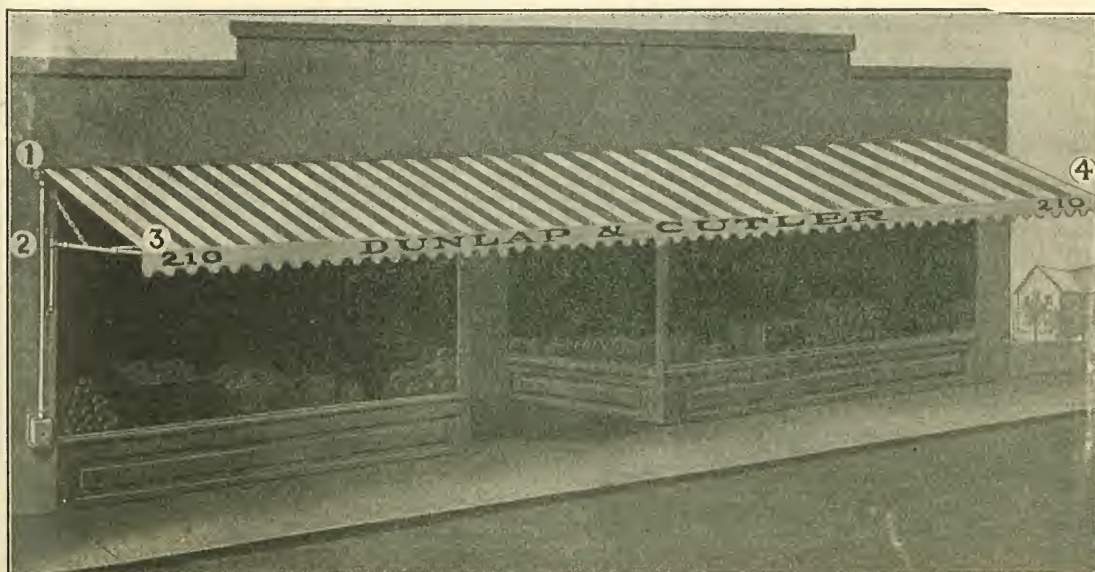
This style Awning can be used either with cog gear, or chain roller.

Directions for measuring and putting up is the same as common roller awnings, except the Automatic arrangement, which is very simple as shown on illustration.

The Automatic Roller Awning was used exclusively before the Anton-Lateral was designed. We believe that eventually the Anton-Lateral Awning will take the place of the Automatic Roller Awning altogether.

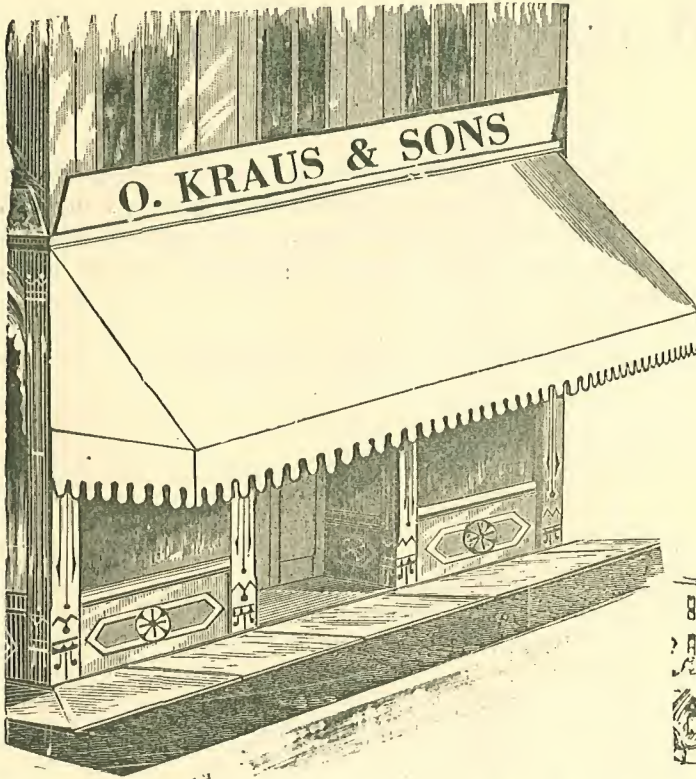

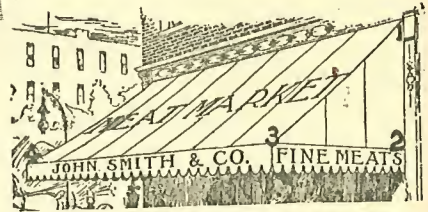

The illustration on this page shows the Rope Pull Up Awning, which is the most commonly used Awning. It is operated as shown in the illustration, by means of ropes and pulleys.

### DIRECTIONS FOR MEASURING.

Determine the place where the joints of the frame will be fastened to the building, which should be seven to eight feet from the side walk, according to the height of the front. Then measure from there to where the top of the Awning can be fastened above the windows, from (1 to 2). (2 to 3) in a high building should measure the same as (1 to 2).

The width of the store from center of column on the side of the center column, of column on the other side, which will be the distance from (3 to 4) or width of Awning. If the top where the Awning is to be attached projects out or sets back from the face of the building state how much and which way.

When ordering the Awning complete state whether it is to be fastened into wood, brick, stone or iron. Also state if the door posts and outer column are in line with the top fastening. State how many posts or places of fastening there will be between the two outer columns.

### DIRECTIONS FOR MEASURING RECOVERS.

Measure from (1 to 2) (2 to 3) (3 to 4). State if the front rod of your frame is wood, iron or gas pipe. Also state if the front rod fits in a pocket, and if the front pocket of the Awning cover is to be made with the solid pocket or is to be made with a lace pocket.

See the decorated awnings illustrated on page 29. They can be made in any style Awning.

### DIRECTIONS FOR PUTTING UP.

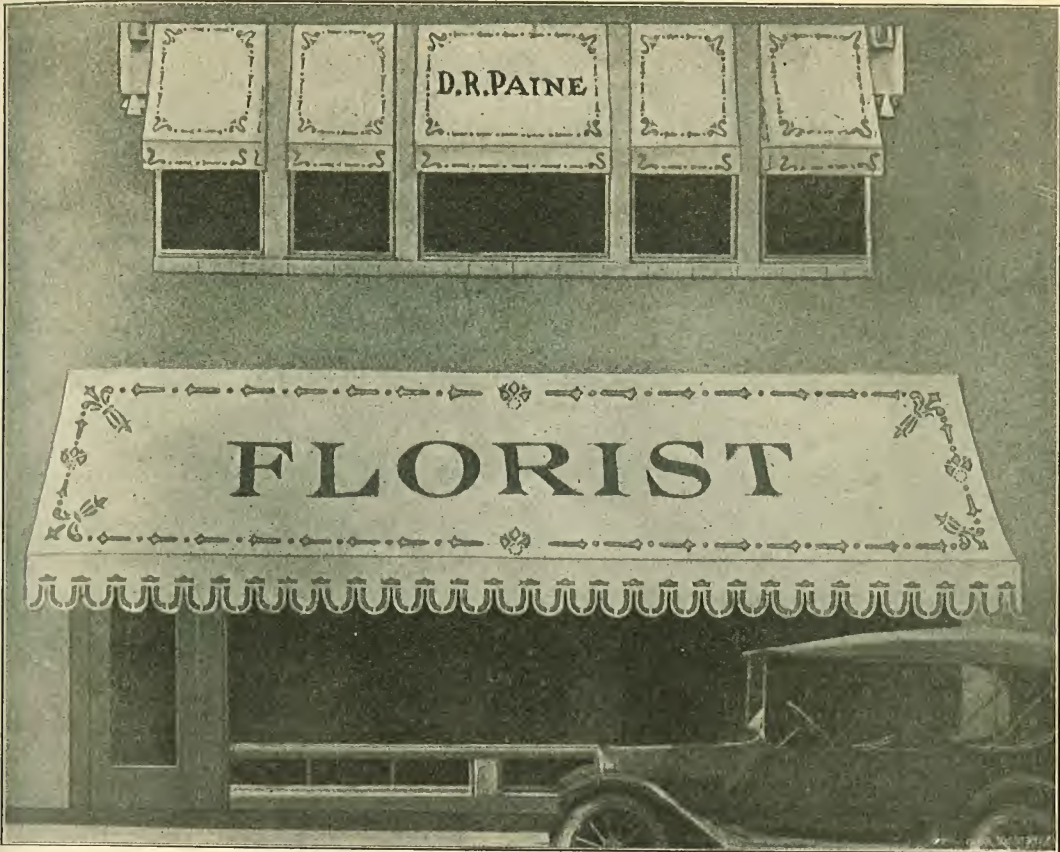
First determine where the Awning is to be fastened at the top, and measure the top to where the joint fastens on the building. (1 to 2.) If the columns are wood fasten the joints on with screws. If stone or brick make holes about three inches deep, and fasten with expansion bolts; if iron it would have to be bored and tapped. Be careful to have joints in line and if any column stands back, put in long joints on the column that do stand back; next put the pulleys or glass rings at the top and put the ropes through them, then attach the cloth to top with screw eyes.

If the Awning has a wood front pole, bore holes in the wood front pole to match joints in the building. Put front pole in pocket provided in the Awning cover, just above the scalloped curtain. Put the front end of the Awning bar that project out from the building through the front pole. Then attach the back ends of the bars to the wall joints. Now fasten ropes to the front pole with screw eyes, and with the screwing on the rope tie cleats the job is finished.

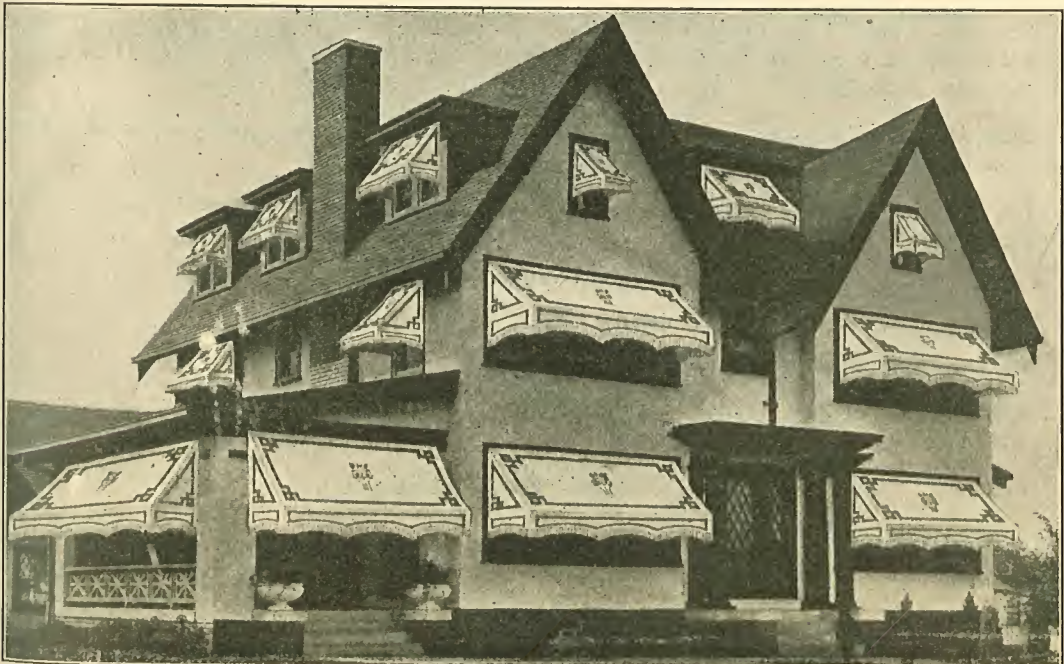

## Automatic Rope Pull Up Awnings



**A**UTOMATIC Rope Pull Up Awnings pull up with ropes, pulleys, or glass rings. This style Awning is used on a low modern store front when more projection is needed than the height will allow on a regular rope pull up Awning.

You will notice that at the end of the bar on the building a slide rod is used instead of a hinge joint, so that the end of the arm will slide up or down and allow the Awning to open or fold up. This slide rod will measure in height the same distance as the difference between the height and projection of the Awning.

This style Awning is to be measured the same as the Regular style rope pull up Awning, but the projection will be more than the height measurement, for instance, three feet from (1 to 2) and six feet from (2 to 3).

Automatic Rope Pull Up Awnings are sometimes used on windows, and residence porches when the measurements require it.

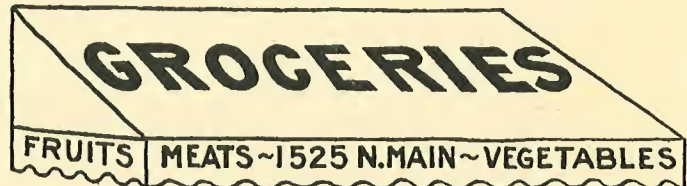

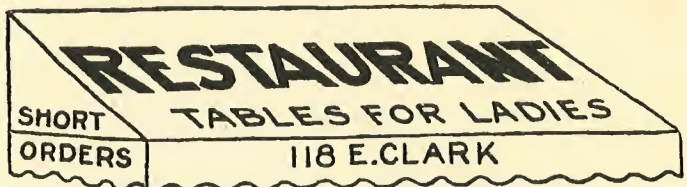

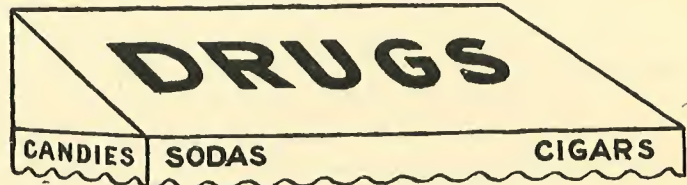

Frames for rope pull-up awnings are figured on the lineal ft. of material used, for example: An awning with a 6 ft. projection and 12 ft. length will take 24 lineal ft. of pipe, because there will be two projecting arms 6 ft. each (one on each end) and 12 ft. of front pipe. On rope pull-up awnings over 12 ft. long, it is necessary to have three projecting arms, and a wood front pole. If there is no place to fasten an arm between each end arm we can make a brace on each end arm which will make the frame strong and rigid. We use different size iron as follows in different size of awning frames:

- $\frac{1}{2}$ " Iron for all small awning frames up to a 3'6" projection and 6" length.
- $\frac{5}{8}$ " Iron for awning frames from 3'6" projection and 6' lengths up to 5' projection with 7' length.
- $\frac{3}{8}$ " Pipe for awning frames of up to 4' projection by 10' length.
- $\frac{1}{2}$ " Pipe for awning frames from 4' projection by 10' length to 6' projection by 12' length.
- $\frac{1}{2}$ " Pipe is used for projection arms on large store and porch awning frames which have a wood front pole.

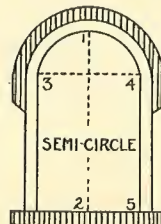
All awnings are made so that the scalloped curtain will drop to within about one-third of the opening above the sill.

In measuring for window awnings, always measure from center to center of wood casing, not on the brick work, and in all cases, give shape of top of window, as per diagrams above. Always state if awnings are for first or upper stories of building. If for first story, give height from the sill of window to ground, state if you want awning high enough so that you can walk under it. When awnings are wanted for doors where screens are used, measure the same as rope holst awnings 1 to 2, 2 to 3, 3 to 4; see page 23 for price list.



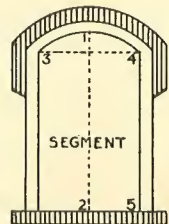

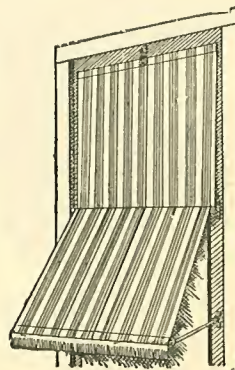
### Box Awnings

(Generally termed Double Frame Awnings)



Box or Double Frame Awnings are used for doors or French windows that open outward. They are more expensive than the common rope pull-up awnings because they require double frames, and much more material to make them. Box awnings are very attractive, and were originally designed in Europe. For figuring prices on box awnings use the list on page 34 for covers, and add 50%. For figuring frames add price for one extra frame because it takes two frames to operate these awnings.

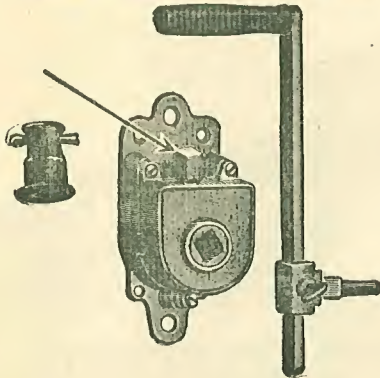
Spring Shade Awnings are operated by means of a spring roller fastened in the center of the goods. On opening the awning the top half raises and the lower half projects. **ON** ACCOUNT of the constant demand for sleeping porch curtains that embody the advantages of the spring roller curtain at a lesser price than the spring roller curtain, we have, after much endeavor, succeeded in making sleeping porch curtains that operate from the bottom upwards the same as the spring roller curtains. These curtains are what we call our sliding curtains.

The sliding curtains when not in use are folded away on the lower edge of the opening of sleeping porch and by means of cords are easily operated, working from the bottom up. They may be used at any height, closing up part of the opening, or in case of stormy or inclement weather may be drawn up all the way to the top, thus shutting out entirely the elements and offering full and ample protection.

Cloth is permanently fastened at the bottom and has a wood slat in top pockets to which ropes are attached and run through glass rings which are attached at the top of the opening, and makes the curtain easily raised and lowered.

The heavy wire which is used on each side of the curtain and at three feet intervals between, helps to hold the cloth close to the wood work and makes the curtain securely tight, especially in stormy weather.

These curtains can be put on inside or outside of porch and if they are put on the outside the ropes can be run through the screen frame and the curtain can be raised or lowered from the inside.

These curtains are the most practical and durable curtains made and they are less expensive than a Spring Roller Curtain; and they never get out of order.

One curtain can be made to cover two or three windows and operate just as easy, and make them more secure.

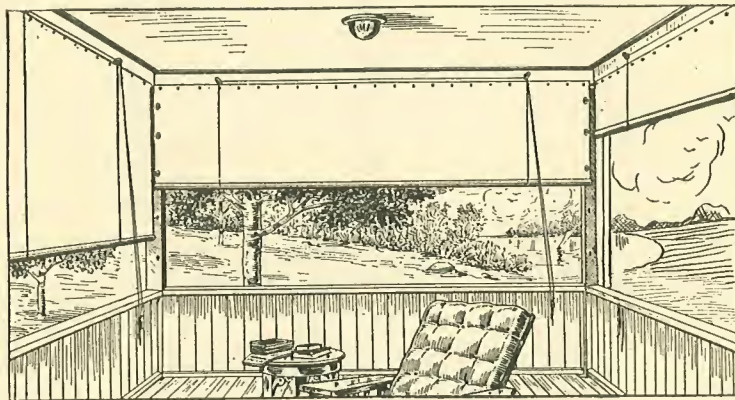
### Directions for Measuring Sliding Curtains

Determine where the bottom and the top of the curtain is to attach, and take the measurements very accurate. Then take the actual measurement in width, exactly the width the curtain is to be (not just the open space that it is to cover) as it should cover over about an inch on the up and down columns, so that it will cover up the entire space.

If one curtain is to cover two or three windows kindly advise so that we can make a rod for each center casing.

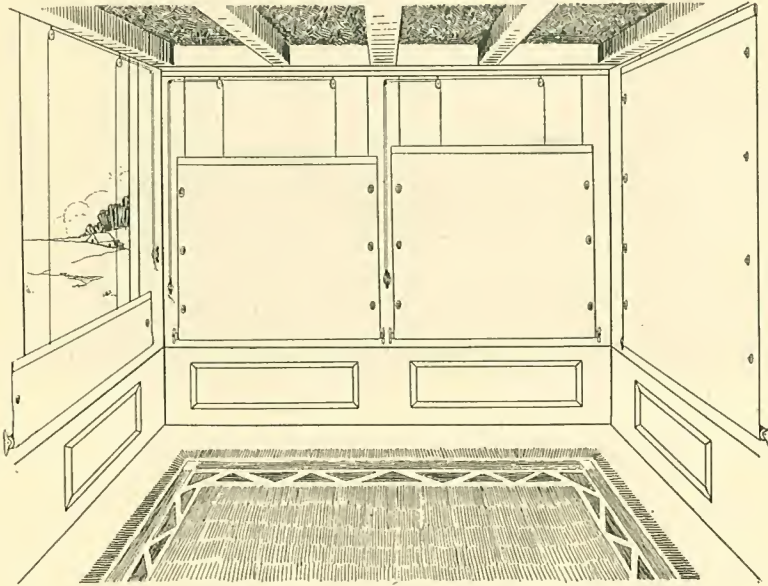

When measuring for spring rollers, please give entire width across from outside to outside of all roller fixtures, also, height up and down of space curtain is to cover. One inch space must be allowed at each end for bracket to fasten, and still give room for cloth to lap onto the woodwork.

Spring roller curtains will either work from the bottom up or from the top down.

## How to use Preservo

Preservo is a compound that makes any canvas water-proof, mildew-proof. Preservo-treated canvas won't rot. It can't! There's nothing to harden or stiffen the canvas—it leaves it *pliable, soft and odorless*.

To apply Preservo—have the fabric DRY. Preservo must be thoroughly mixed and kept stirred while being used.

In cold weather, if Preservo is too thick or dries too slowly, it may be thinned with a little turmoline or naphtha.

### General Directions

Preservo may be applied direct from a bucket, with an ordinary whitewash or paint brush, or it may be sprinkled upon the canvas from a watering can, but in either case the Preservo must be well rubbed into the fabric.

One gallon is sufficient for 100 square feet of 10 or 12 ounce canvas.

### Must Be Thoroughly Stirred While Using

Where several pieces are to be treated, it is desirable to spread them flat, full size, one on top of the other, so that any surplus running through may be taken up by the canvas beneath, and not be wasted. As soon as one piece is treated, it should be removed and allowed to dry.

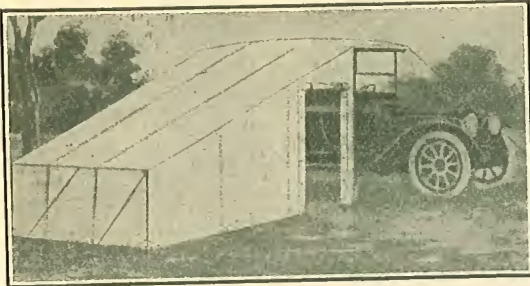


Illustration shows tent used without poles and flap over top of car.

## CAMP FIRE SUGGESTIONS

### THE CAMP FIRE

As a rule, hard woods make good, slow-burning fuel that yields coals, and soft woods make a quick, hot fire that is soon spent. Best of all fire woods is hickory, green or dry. For a cooking fire that will burn quickly to coals, without smoke, the bark of dead hemlock, hickory, pine or sugar maple cannot be excelled.

To make a fire burn well you must have air. The fuel must not be tumbled together; it must be built systematically, so that air can draw under it, and upward through it.

The best way to build a fire quickly and one that is sure to keep on burning as long as it is fed, is first to lay two good-sized sticks on the ground as a foundation, then across them at right angles lay a course of dry twigs or splinters not quite touching each other; on these, at one side, place your tinder of paper, bark or whatever it may be; then on top of this put two other cross-sticks smaller than the bed-sticks; over this a cross layer of larger twigs, and so on, gradually increasing the size of the sticks. Such a pile will roar within a few minutes after a match is touched to it.

### A FEW PRACTICAL RECEIPTS

**COFFEE**—Use one teaspoonful of ground coffee for each cup of water, and then add an extra one for good measure. Put on in cold water and allow to boil up just once. Serve hot.

**FRIED FISH, GAME OR FRESH MEAT**—Clean well. Roll in meal or flour, and fry in hot fat. Salt when nearly done. Never salt fresh meats beforehand, and always fry in hot grease or fat.

**FRIED POTATOES**—Slice and fry in hot fat as above. Season and serve hot.

**BOILED POTATOES**—Put in cold water, and boil until they begin to burst open. Drain them well; dry and serve.

**BAKED POTATOES**—Place in Oven and bake until you can easily pierce them with a fork or stick, when they are done.

**BROILING MEAT**—Have a bed of hot live coals (do not try to broil over a flame fire). Place the slices of meat in a Meat Broiler, and then put the Broiler on side rails inside of stove. Turn frequently until broiled to suit. Season when nearly done.

**BAKED BEANS**—Soak beans over night always. Then place them in an earthen preserve jar with a few pieces of pork or bacon. Add a little hot water. Bake from one to three hours—the longer, the better.

Stale bread and biscuits can be made fresh by wrapping in a damp cloth and placing in the oven for a little while. Never throw your stale bread away. Just dip it in salt water and fry in hot fat until real brown, both sides. It is fine.
