I am responding to your request for access to information.

Partial access is granted to information concerning your request. Access is denied to certain information pursuant to subsection 17(1)(a) of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*. This subsection applies because:

The contract between the University and Coca-Cola is attached. The University only has records related to the sale of Coca-Cola products from 1998 to date. Said information is located in the table below. We do not keep annual records of the number of vending machines. The current number of Coca-cola vending machines is 110.


