## A BILL

To be entitled "An Act to amend An Act to provide revenue from commodities imported from foreign countries," approved May 21st, 1864.

- 1 Section 1. The Congress of the Confederate States of America do

- 4 and merchandice, imported from abroad for the Confederate

- 10 centum; on all articles enumerated in schedule E, ten per
- 11 centum: Provided, That nothing contained in this act shall be
- 12 construed to impose any duty on articles now admitted duty

- 13 free under acts passed since the passage of the said act of May
- 14 21st, 1861.
  - 1 Sec. 2. That the article of salt, in schedule F, be trans-
  - 2 ferred to schedule G, so as to be admitted free of duty.
