## Imported RAYON D'OR.

(WINNER OF THE CLEARWELL, LEVANT AND GLASGOW STAKES IN $187 S$; TIIE ST. JAMES' rALACE STAKES, TIIE SUSSEX, \%ETLAND, SEIECT CIIAMIION, GREAT FOAL STAKES, THE GREAT CIHLLENGE STAKES ANI DONCASTER ST. LEGER, IN IS79; THE IRIX DU CADRAN AND PRIX KAINBOW AT PARIS, ANI TIIE POST STAKES, TIIE IRINCE OF WALES STAKES ANI, TIIE ROUS MEMORIAL STAKES, IN ENGLAND IN ISSo.)
"Rayon d'Or (Kay of Goli), ly Flageolet, son of Plutus, bred in Dangu Stur, France, foaled $1 S_{7} 6$, dam Araucaria, dam of Chamant, Camelia, etc., ly Ambrose, son of Touchstone, out of Pocahontas, dam of Stockwell, Rataplan, King Tom, etc., by *Glencoe. Rayon d'Or made his delout in England as a two-year-old by winning the Levant Stake, half a mile, at Goodwood, carrying 122 pounds, beating Flavins, Galantha and two others. It I Ooncaster, in September, he won a sweepstake, at three-quarters of a mile, with 129 pounds, heating Charibert and Keconciliation. At the Newmarket Second Octoler Meeting won the Clearwell Stakes, carrying 131 pounds, with such horses as Kingleader and Bay Archer, 122 pounds each, secoml and third, and three others ; the Glasgow Stakes, at the Newmarket lloughton Meeting, three-guarters of mile, beating Kingleader and Glencairn. Durirg the winter and spring which followed, Rayon d'Or was much fancied loth for the 2.000 guineas and Derby, but his ruming was a disappointment. Ife was third to Charibert and Cadogan for the 2,000 guineas, and was mplaced for the Derly, won ly Sir Bevys. At Ascot, on the first day, he was third for the l'rince of Wales Stakes, to Wheel of Fortune and Adventure, but on the third day he won the St. James' Palace Stakes with 122 pounds, over the severe "Old Mile," beating Charibert, Ruperra and seven others. At Goorlwood Rayon l'Or won the Sussex Stakes, one mile, beating Ruperra, Leap Year and Exeter, and won the great Doncaster St. leger, Nuperra second and Exeter third, and fourteen others umplaced, including the winner of the Derly, Sir Bevys. The next day Rayon d'or "walked over" for the Zetland Stakes, Mr. Crawford's Pell Mell Colt saving his stake. At the Newmarket First Octoler Meeting won the Great Foal Stakes with $13^{1}$ pounds, beating Discord, Palmbearer and three others, but at the same meeting was leaten ly Bay Archer for the Newmarket St. Leger, he yielding 7 pounds, after which Kayon d'Or won the Select Stakes, Kowley Mile, beating Discord and three others ; the Champion Stakes, across the llat, one mile, 2 furlongs, 73 yards, leeating I'lacida, the Oaks wimer, Exeter and hive others, and the Greur Challenge Stakes, Bretly Course, six furlongs, beating Lollypop, Placida, Parole and others. He ended his three-year-old carcer lyy ruming third for a handicap "Across the Flat" to Out of Bounds, who carried ino pounds to Rayon d'Or's 126 pounds. Ilis earning for the year amounted to $\$ 57.735$. As a four-year-old Rayon d'or began by wiming the lrix du Cadran, 2 miles anl 5 furlongs, heating Zut, Salteador and others, and the Prix Rainbow, 3 miles and a furlong, beating Zut and Clocher at the Paris Spring Meeting in March. Ife was immerliately afterward sent to England, where, on the 1 Gth of April, at Newmarket, he "walked orer" for the Post Stakes (the two midlle miles). At the Newmarket litst Spring meeting(wo weeks later-he "walked over" for the I'rince of Wales Stakes (the Cesarewiteh Course). At Ascotthe won the Kuns Memorial Stakes over the New Mile, carrying
$\mathbf{I}_{\mathbf{3}} \mathbf{2}$ pounds; but in running for the Hardwicke Stakes at the same meeting over the Swinley Course (mile and a half) he was beaten a head by Exeter, to whom he was giving to pounds. This race closed his turf career, placing to nis credit a total of $\$ 122,140.65$.

Flageolet, his sire, was a superior race-horse. He won his first race in France at two years old, defeating a large field. Won the llopeful Stakes, one-half mile, at Newmarkei, 128 pounds; won the Rutland Stakes, three-quarters of a mile, 129 pounds, beating His Grace and two others; won the Forlom Stakes, Rowley mile, i2S pounds, beating Lord Mayo, 122 pounds; won Burwell Stakes, 5 furlongs, 128 pounds, defeating Amalie Von Elelreich, 122 pounds; was unplaced in Middle Park Ilate, won by Surinam. Ran second to Andred in the Prendergast Stakes, Surinam and three others behind him. Won the Criterion Stakes, three-yuarters of a mile, defeating Paladin, Kaiser and four others. As a three-year-old ran second to Boiard in the Prix du Jockey Clulb (French Derly), and second to him in the Grand Prix de Paris in 1873. IIe was also second to Apollon in the l'rix dn Cedre, same year. Crossing the Chamnel, he was umplaced in the 2,000 guineas, won ly Gang Forward ; ran second to Cremorne in the Gold Cup at Ascott; won the Goodwood Cup, in which he beat both Favonius and Cremorne, the Derby wimers of 1871 and 1872. He ran second to Uhlan in Brighton Cup ; won the Grand Duke Michael Stakes at Newmarket First October Meeting ; won a free handicap sweepstakes across the flat, and the Jockey Club Cup at the Newmarket Houghton Meeting. As a four-year-old he ran second to Boiard twice in France ; won the Claret Stakes at Newmarket, England ; was second to Boiard in the Gold Cu , and thitd to King Lud and Boiard in the Alexandra Plate, both at Ascot. This closed his turf carcer. Plutus, his sire, was unplaced in the Derby of iS66, but won some races and ran ereditably in others.

Araucaria, Rayon d'Or's dam, was the dam of Camelia, winner of the 1,000 guineas, and ran a dead heat and divided the Oaks Stakes with Enguerrande. Chamant, by Mr. Lorillard's Mortemer, out of Araucaria, won the Middle Park Plate and the Dewhurst Plate in England at two years old, and at three won the 2,000 guineas. The blood on the sire side is a combimation of Touchstone through Orlando, a Derby winner, Bay Middleton, son of Sultan, a l Jerby wimer, Venison and Glencoe, through Darkness, a winner of the Ascot Stakes. (on the dam's sile, Touchstone, St. Leger winner, Priam, Derly winner, and Glencoe, through Pocahontas, dam of Stockwell, Rataplan, King Tom, etc. An analysis of the talulated pedigree will show that he is richly and fashionably lined; he has a double cross of Glencoe, a triple cross of Diomed, a double cross of Tonchstone, fortified by the blood of Whalebone, doubled in upon the Ilerorl and Eclipse blood on loth sides to the Byerly Mare, dam of the Two True Blues. Rayon d'Or is prolablly the most magnificent specimen of his race ever imported. He is the highest priced horse ever shipped across the Atlantic. His cost delivered at his home is little short of $\$ 40,000$. In color he is a rich, true chestmut, with a large, rather faint, star in his forehead, standing 16 hands, $3^{\frac{1}{2}}$ inches in height. He has a beautiful head, very broad between the cycs, with a fine, clean and tapering ear; neck, long but broad where it enters the head; shoulders well set and broad, with great depth of girth; gool, round barrel, with splendid lack, hip and loin. His hips will be found broad, with great length from the point of the hip to the whirlmone, and thence to stitle and hocks, the latter clean cut and well placerl, and the finest, soundest and best set of legs ever seen unter a horse ; in fact, it is one of his great excellent points, and certainly nothing is more essential to a good race-horse. Kayon d'Or (Ray of Gold) deserves his name.

The wimnings of the get of Rayon d'Or in 1886, their lirst appearance on the American turf, were $\mathbf{H}_{\mathbf{1}} \mathbf{1}, 965$; in 1887, $\$ 32,955$.

(iypsy ?ueen won the Spinaway Stake, Saratoga, live furlongs, $1: 03$, value $\$ 2,925$; the Saratoga Stake, Saratoga, six furlongs, $1: 16$, value $\$ 5,020$; the Tennessee Stake, Saratoga, six furlongs, 1:16 $\frac{1}{2}$, value ${ }^{2} \mathbf{1}, 950$, and the Misses' Stake, Saratogn, six furlongs, $1: 16$, value $\$ 1, S_{75}$.

Belle d'Or won the Annual llomehred Stake, Baltimore, one mile, i:45, value $\$ 1,050$, and the Chesapeake Stake, baltimore, one mile and a quarter, $2: 19$, value 9.950 .

1 efense won the Tidal stake, Coney 1sland, one mile, $1:+2_{1}^{3}$, value $=7,720$.
Laura Stone won the lyy Leaf Stake, Nashville, half a mile, :5r, value 1,000 , and the Kensington dandical, Chicago, sis furlongs, $1: 16 \frac{1}{1}$, value $1: 2.40$.

Ransom won the Camrlen Stake, Momouth P'ark, six furlongs, $1: 17 \frac{1}{1}$, value $\$ 2,955$, and Tipstaff won the Sapling Stake, Monmouth lark, six furlongs, $1: 15 \frac{1}{1}$, value 56,350 .


## ALGERINE.

(WINNER OF THE BELMONT STAKES AT JEROME PARK in iS76.)

"Algerine, by Abi-el-K゙arler, son of * Iustralian, was bred by Major Thomas W. Doswell, Bullfield Stud, Hanover Junction, Va.; foaled 1873 , dam Nina, the dam of Planet, Excheyuer, Ninette. Ecliptic, etc., Ly ( Mll boston. Algerine did not rum as a two-year-old; he male his bow to the pullic in the Preakness Stakes at Baltimore in 1876 , $1 \frac{1}{2}$ miles, and was thirl to Shirley and Raprahannock in $2: 443$. At Jerome Park he won the Belmont Stakes, $1 \frac{1}{2}$ miles, in $2: 40 \frac{1}{2}$, beating Fiwllesticks, the winner of the Withers Stakes, Barricale, Mother to Bassett (Charley IIoward) and Red Coat, each carrying ro pounds. Ite was mplaced in the Uixie Stakes, 2 miles, at Baltimore, won ly Vigil in $3: 4 \frac{1}{2}$, track muddy. As a four-year-old he started five times, ran second to larole in the Maturity Stakes at Jerome Park, 3 miles, in 5:39; second to St. James, 2 miles, in $3: 49 \frac{1}{2}$; was umplaced in the All-Agerl Sweepstake, $1 \frac{1}{2}$ miles, won by Tom (chiltree in $2: 43$. Won club purse, 2 -mile heats, at Baltimore, in 4:02 $\frac{1}{2}, 3: 50,4: 00$; track very heavy. Barricarle won the second heat ; was unplaced in the lowie Stake, 4-mile heats, won by Ten Broeck in 7: $72 \frac{1}{2}, 7: 40$. Abd-el-Kader, his sire, although badly hipped, was a fine race-horse at all distances; he won a dash of + miles at Saratoga in 1869 , in $7: 3 \mathbf{1}_{1}^{3}$, a very credital, le performance. Nina, the dam of Algerine, was one of the best race-mares of her day; she was a winner at all distances, from one to four-mile heats, in good time, and producel Planet, one of the best horses in the country, at all distances, and for his chances a successful sire. Algerine is a blood bay, $15:$ hands, with black points, and no white about him. He is strongly inbred to Sir Archy, and on the sire's side is a grandson of the great West Australian, wimner of the triplle events, 2,000 gumeas, 1)erly and St. Leger, in I853. Boston, the sire of his dam, wasthe best horse of any day. Algerine has no colts yet upon the turf, but from good mares should get wimers and stayers; he traces on both sides of sire and dam many times, to lIerod and Eclipse, through the famous Waxy and Dick Andrews, and with the Archy and Diomed blood on looth sides, through Diomed's leest sons."

The entire produce of Algerine, living to he two years old, numbers but thirtytwo, three of which are of double parentage. Twenty of these have gone to the post and furnished the large proportion of fifteen winuers, viz: Aurelia, Brian Boru, 1. II. D., Allarene, Somersct, Krishna, Tunis, I. C. Burnet, Irish Dan, Sirocco, Velvet, Simoon, Karlha, Bimacle and Torso.

# WANDERER. 


AT LANG BRANCII, AND WESTCIIEくTER ('Ul AT JERWNI I'IRK, IS73.)

"Wanderer, hy lexington, som of Boston, hrel in the Woodburn Stud, Ky., foraled 1868 , dam Coral, dim of theas loy Vandal, son of cilencoe out of *Caimgorme by Cotherstone, winner of the 2,000 suineas and lerty, wo of Tonchstone winner of the St. Leger.

Wanderer is descemled from one of the most noted racing families of Englane?, tracing lack through an own sister to *alcneoe to the famous Web by Waxy. The family has furmished some of the mot moted race-horses and successful sires of the English turf. From it came Whalelone wimer of the Derty in aSto; Whisker. winner of the same evem in 1815 ; Cohwel, winner of the Galis and 1 , ooo guineas in 1824 ; Ridllesworth, wimer of the 2 ooo guineas ant Iherly in 1836 : Glencoe, wimer of the 2,000 gimeas in 1831 : liay Middleton, wimer of the 2,000 guineas and Goodwood Cup, in 1534 ; Blue Gown, winner of the Derly in 1868 ; Silvio, winner of both Derby and St. Leger in 1877 , and a hout of others.

Wanderer made his first appearance as a three-year-ohl and was mplaced in the Belmont Stakes at Jerome lark, and the Jersey Derby at Long Branch, botn events having been won by his half hother, Hary Bassett. At Long Branch he won a club, purse, mile heats, in $1: 48: 1$, $48 \frac{1}{4}$, defeating a fied of seven. In his four-year-old form, at New orleans, he won a race of mile heats in 1:51, 1:47 $\frac{1}{1}$, $1: 47 \frac{1}{2}$, beating Frank Ross, winner of the lirst heat, Niagara and Glemrose; won the Kailroad Stakes at Nashville, Temn, two-mile heats, in $3: 41 \frac{1}{1}, 3: 33_{2}^{3}$, heating Hollywool, Frogtown, etc., and walked over for cluh, purse, two-mile heats. As a live-year-old he won the Monmouth Cup at Long Branch, 2 ! miles, in 4:34, leating l'reakness, II ubhard and others; won the Westchester Cup at Jerome l'ank, 21 miles, in $4: 04$, beating True Bhes. Eolns and others. At Saratoga, ran second to lluthard, 3 miles in 5:34, leating IIary bassett and King Ifenry. Same meeting ran second to hizona, id miles, in 2:3S, leating bers Tweed and Eolus. As a six-year-ohl won chul purse at Savanmal, (ia., 2 miles, in $3: 43 \frac{1}{2}$, heating Granger and four others, and also same meeting, a club purse, 1 miles, in $2: 18$ : beating()itolan and Tabitha. At Nashville, Tem., won the Johnson Stakes, $2 \frac{1}{1}$ miles, in $4: 06 \frac{1}{2}$, leating llanchette, St. George and two others. Mi Jerome l'ak ran second to Shytock, son of lexington, in the Westchester C'uj, $2 \frac{1}{1}$ miles, $144: 13$, heating Liaie Lucas, Ald-el-Korce and two others, track heavy. Saratoga won club, prise, 2 ! miles, in 4 :00! , heating Felloweraft, Jack Frost, Galway and Katic l'ease. Same !lace, ran second to Felloweraft, 4 miles, in
 beat Katie l'ease and was timed the distance in $7: 20$.

Wamlerer has been quite a success in the stud, having only a fow mares, he sired One Itime a wimer $1 \frac{1}{\frac{1}{3}}$ mile in $1: 55^{\frac{1}{2}}, 1 \frac{1}{1}$ miles in $2: 09_{1}^{\frac{1}{1}}$, mile heats in $\mathrm{I}: 44^{\frac{1}{2}, 1: 4 \frac{1}{2} \text {. }}$ JMhorn Stakes, $1_{1}^{3}$ miles in $3: 05 \frac{1}{1}$. Mimie C. (Mrs. Chubbs), wimner of the filly atakes at Lexington. Juanta, $1 \frac{1}{1}$ miles in $2: 10$. Lizzie S, filly stakes at Levington, half mile in 0:49 Coppucte Stakes at St. Louts, three-guarters of a mile in $1: 1 S_{2}$; live furlongs in $1: 02$; there-quarters of a mile in $1: 16 \frac{1}{2}$; one mile in $1: 43$. Mary Lamphier, Farragut, Nomad, Wahefiel, Cash Clay, Waterforl, Proplet, Rambler, Wandering, wimer one mile in $1: 45$, and Capital Stakes, one mile in $1: 44_{i}^{3}$, and others all wimers. His colls are the lest the dams have produced. Ile is a rich gokden chestmut, with the marks of his sire : is hambomely shaped and of very bloodlike appearance, muscular and highly finished. His sire was the best race-horse and stallion this commery has producet; his dam ishy the hest son of tilencoe and traces Wrough his own sister to Glencoe and Wed, liy lVaxy to a Natual Barl, Mare. Thin is one of the pare sources through which the hoor of Lexington and dilencoe should le preserved."

## Imported KANTAKA.

Kantaka, by Scottish Chief, son of Lord of the Isles, by Touchstone, was bred by Mr. W. Blenkiron, England, foaled 188o, dam Seclusion (Hermit's dam), by Tadmor. Kantaka was lought as a yearling in England by Mr. P. Lorillard for the sum of $\$ 5,000$, and was trained there ly Mr. Lorillard's trainers, Mr. Puryear and Mr. Pincus, but never ran on account of injuries received in his exercise. He is represented, however, by Messrs. Puryear and lincus as one of the most promising yearlings they ever trained. liy an examination of his peligree it will be seen that he is one of the finest bred horses in the world, heing more than a half brother to llermit, winner of the English Derby in 1867 , and who during the the past ten years has risen intofame as the leading sire of England, having sired Peter, Shotover, St. Blaise, Tristan, Thebais, Clairvaux, St. Marguerite, Yueen Adelaide and St. IIelena.

On the sire's side, Scottish Chief is by Lord of the lsles, by Touchstone, and Hermit's sire, Newminster, is ly Touchstone. Kantaka is a true chestnut, 15 hands and 3 inches high.

Kantaka is young in the stud and has hat hut eleven starters at this writing (June I5, 'S9), five of them securing wiminglurackets, viz: Canteen, G. I). Boyten, Dock Wick, Irish Dan (Kantaka or Algerine), and Tipstaff (Rayon d'Or or Kantaka.)


## ADELAIDE.

At two years old started three times, running second to Parole in both the Saratoga and Alabama Stakes, and third to Sultana in the Two-Iear-Old Sweepstakes at Saratoga. At three years old started but once, running unplaced in mite-and-a half purse to Ore Knob at Jerome Park.
