Plan of Ground Floor

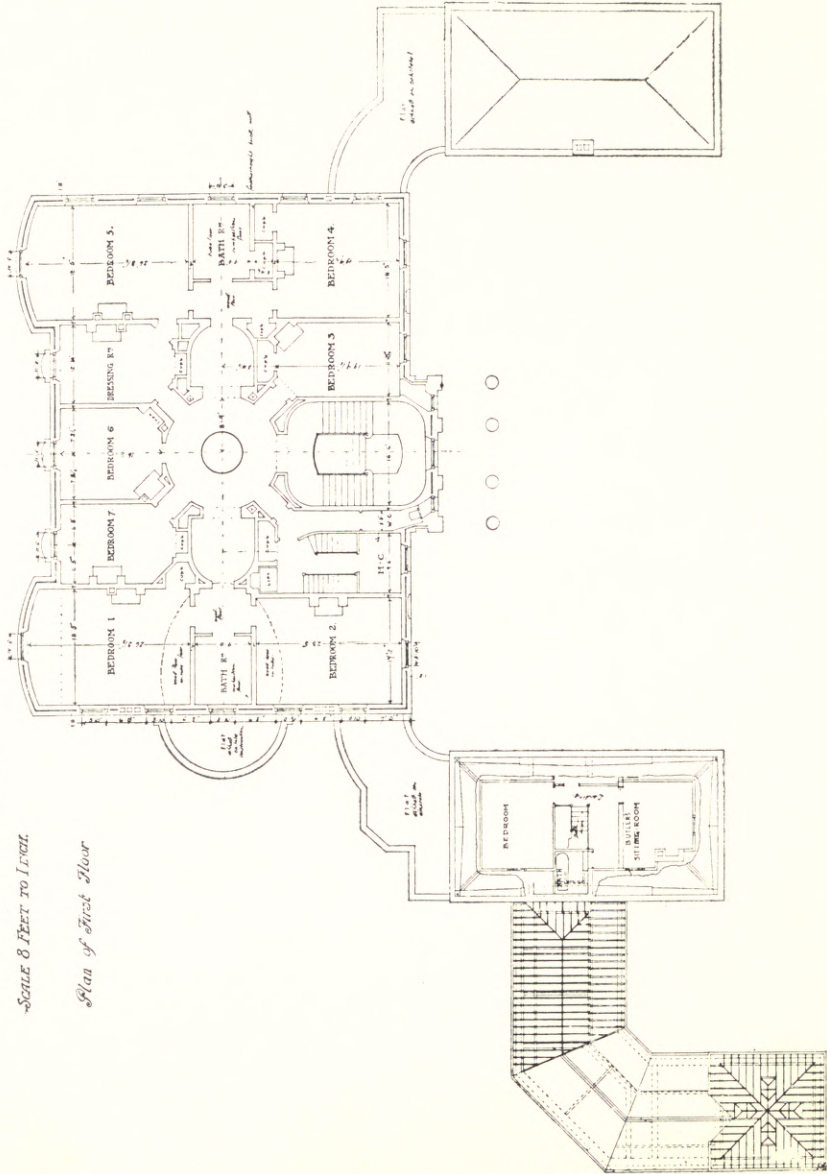

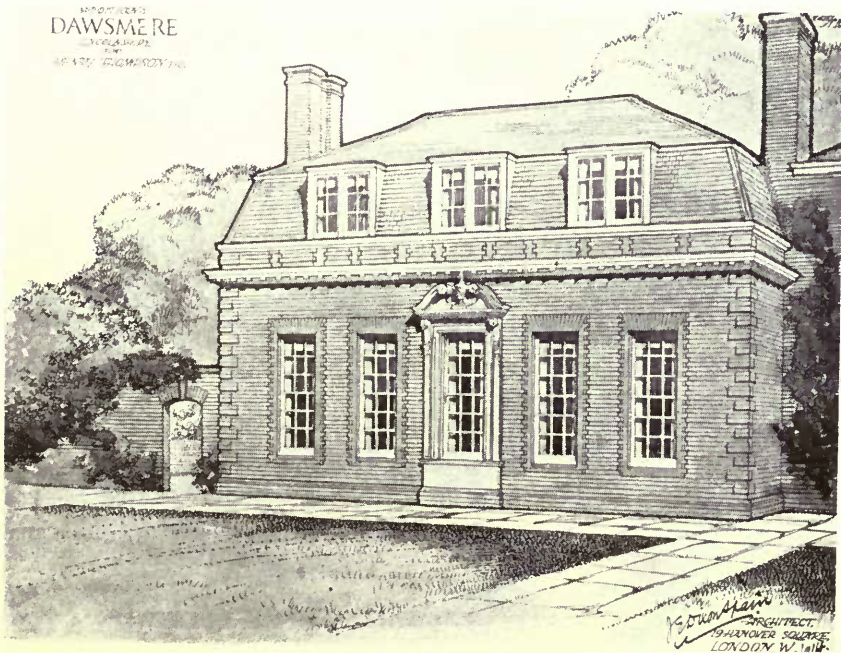


Symington Lodge, Lanarkshire : Ground Floor Plan.

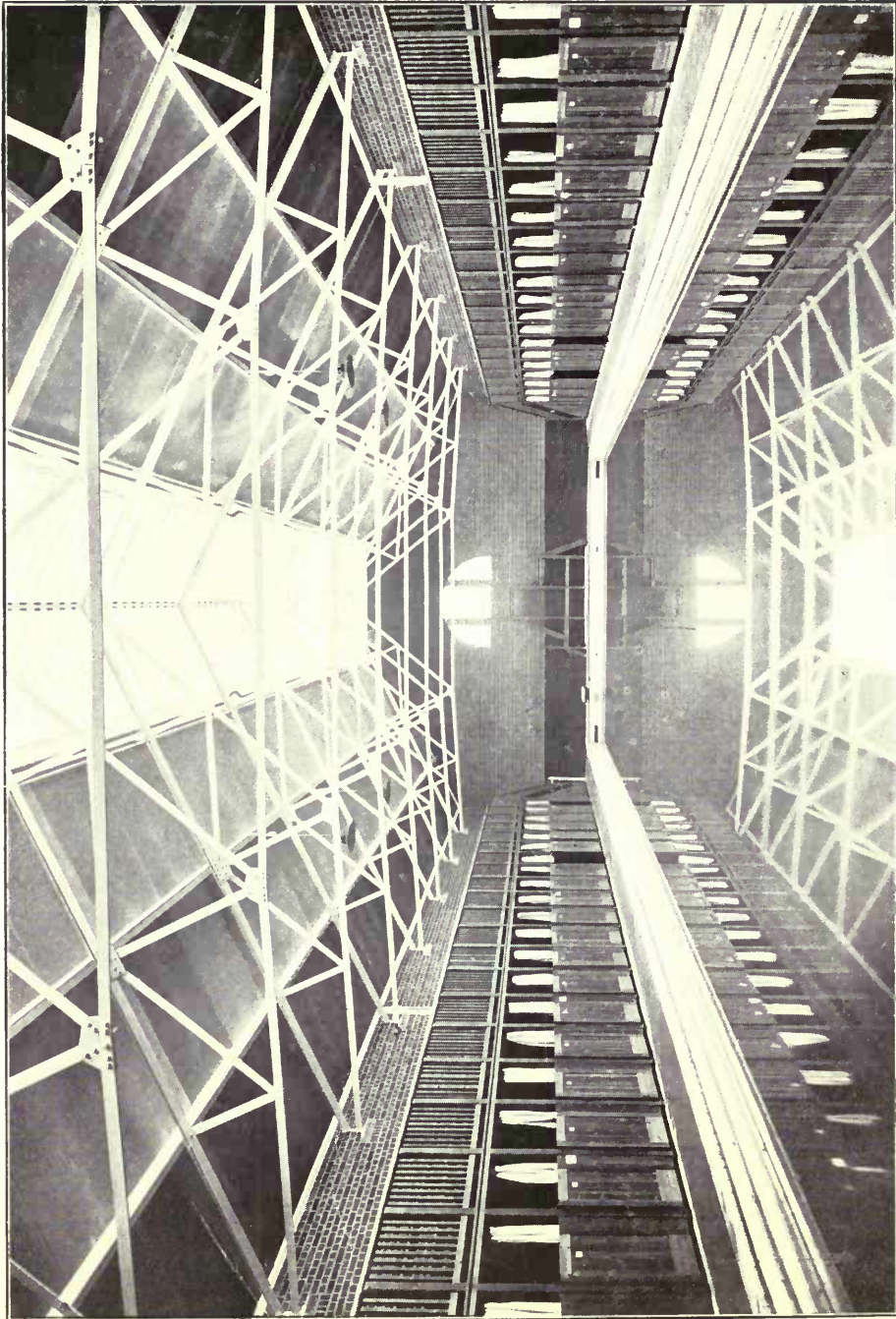


BASEMENT PLAN.

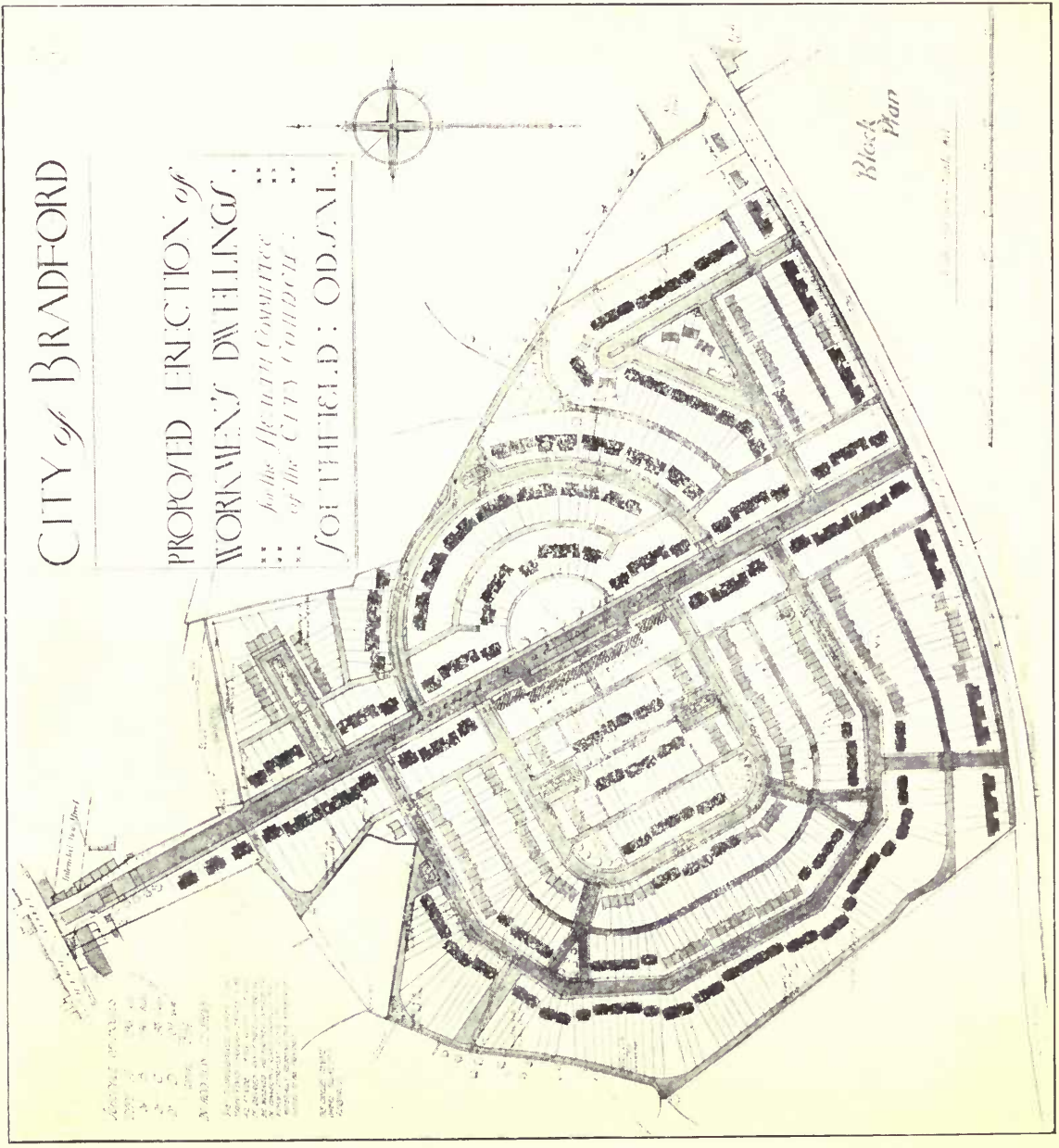

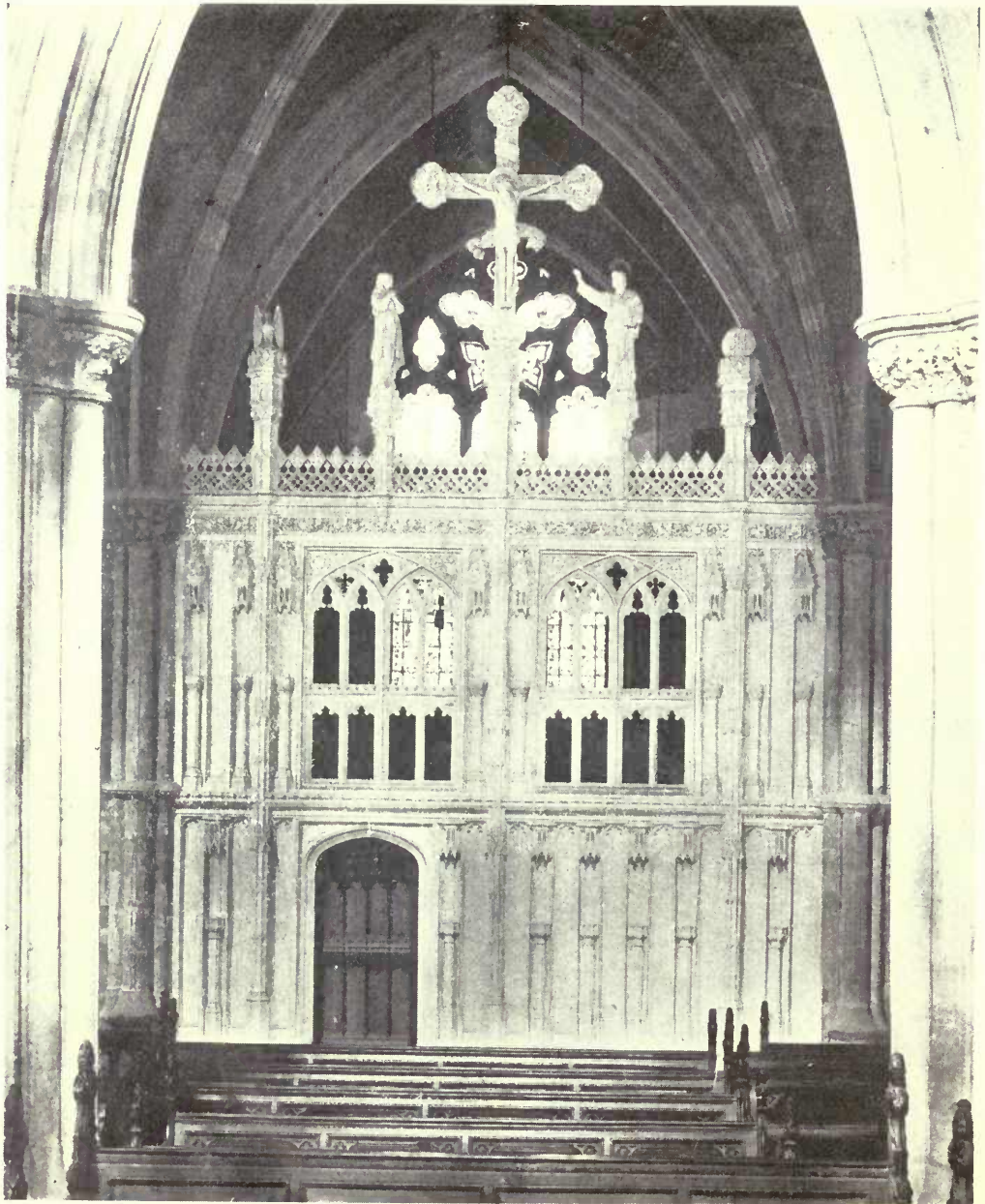

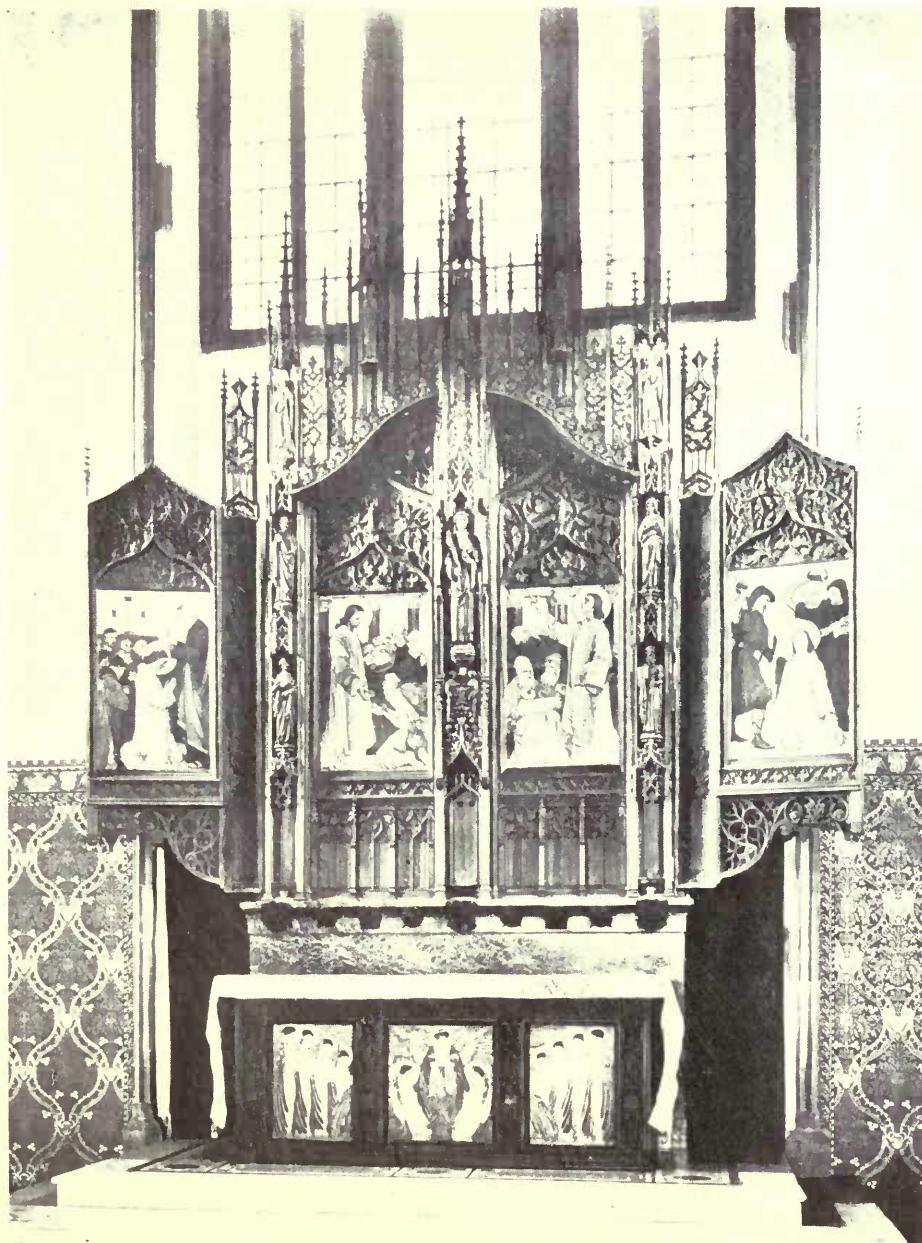
