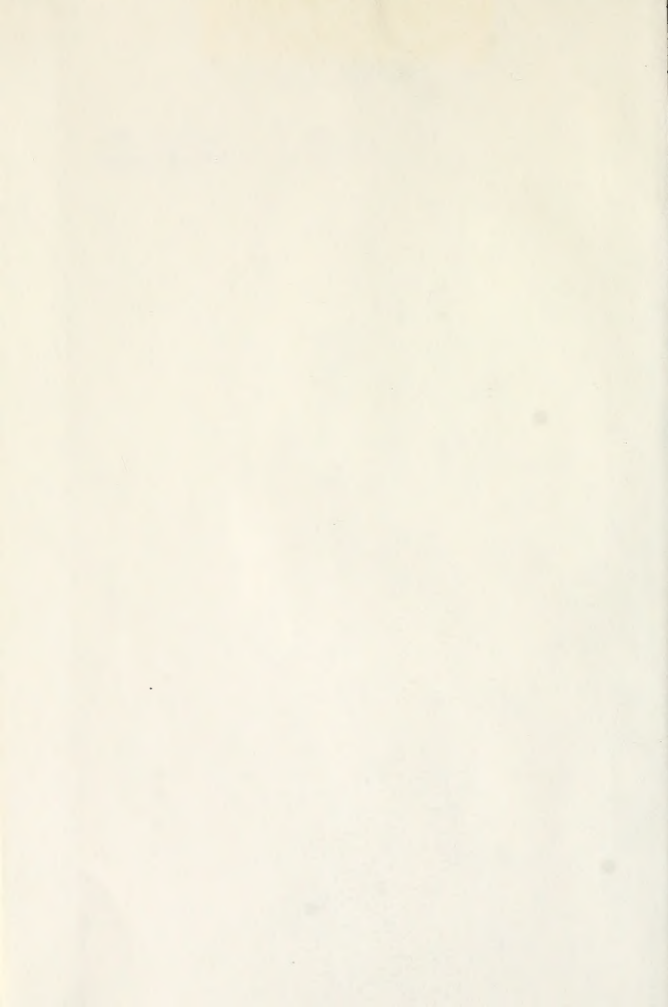

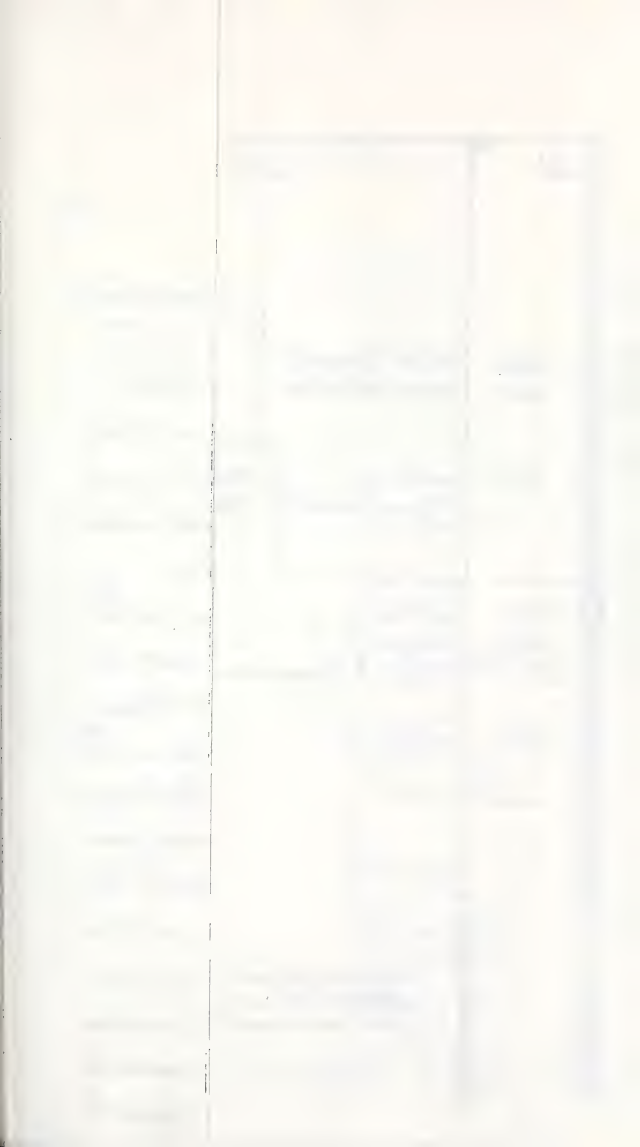

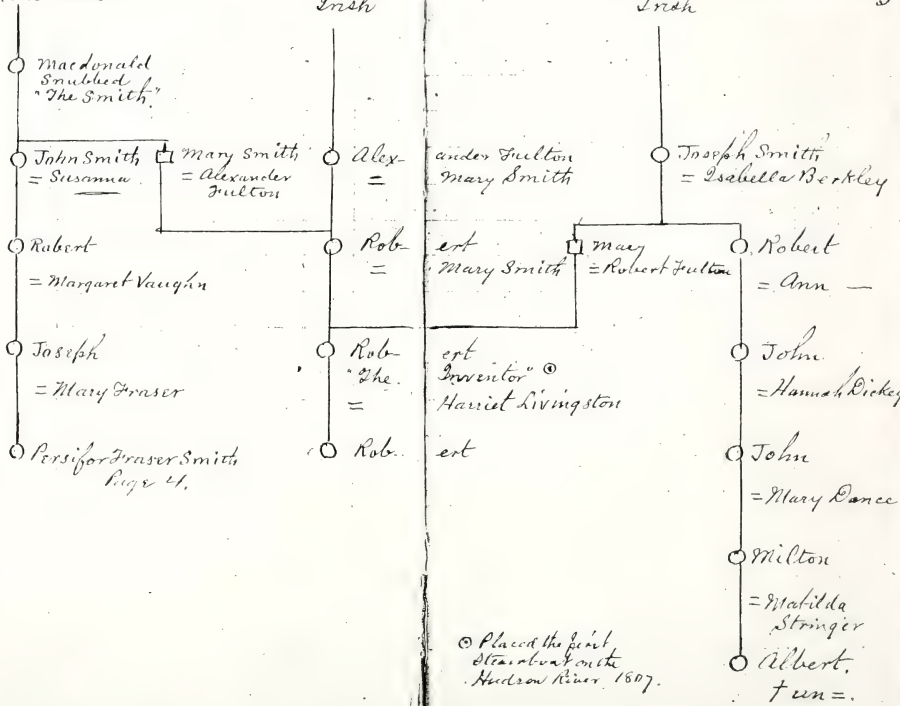

2.5
Ancestry of Persifor Frazer Smith.

At the end of the 17th century the Macdonalds lived in the N.E. part of Ireland, King William III. about the time of the battle of the Boyne.

Having lost a shoe from his horse, it was replaced by one of the Macdonalds and by the King dubbed the Smith.

Their son John and Susanna his wife left their home in 1720, one year after the enforcing of "the Test" and whose special grievance was not the raising of the rent of their homestead, but the absolute refusal of their landlord to renew their lease unless they would comply with the require-

ment of that hated act.

With her brother John came Mary Smith who married Alexander Fulton, removed to Little Britain, Lancaster Co. and to whom in due time was born a grandson Robert Fulton, who has indissolubly linked his name with the history of steam navigation.

John Smith died Dec. 19 1765 aged 79 years, and his wife Susanna, Dec. 24, 1767 aged 76 years. They were parents of 15 children.

Three elder brothers having sought their fortunes elsewhere, the homestead in Uxchelau fell to Robert, who was born at sea during the voyage to this country, and who

married Dec. 20 1758. Margaret
Vaughn of (Welsh descent) of
Red Lion, Huchlan township.

In 1754 Sergt. Robert Smith
went to Reading to be qualified
during the war between the French
and English. He next appears in
the commencement of the Revolution,
in Aug. 1775, he was elected a
delegate from Chester Co. that
sat in the convention which on
Sep. 28. 1776 adopted the first
State constitution of Penna.

On March 12. 1777 the Supreme
Executive Council appointed
him lieutenant of Chester Co.

March 29. 1777 he became
Sheriff of the County. He died
in 1803 aged 83 years, and

his wife died in Phila. in 1822
aged 87 years. - Issue

 Manor. Married Isabel
 Bertley, and had 9 children.

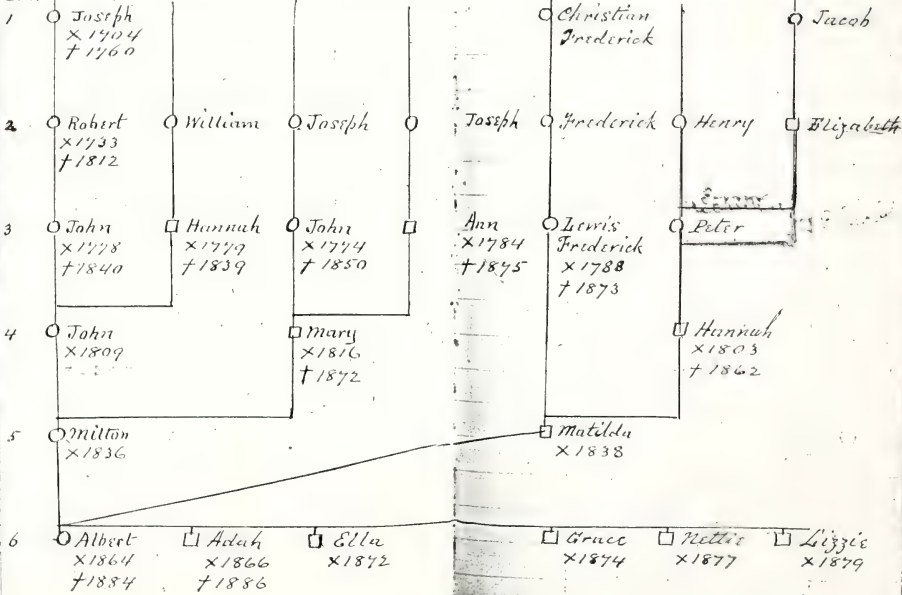

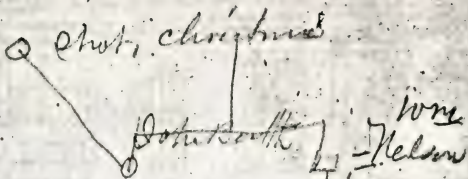

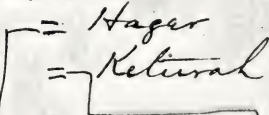
