The scientific names in these lists are based on the official Appendices I and II as at 22 October 1987 and Appendix III as at 21 September 1988, and on previous editions of the official Appendices produced by the CITES Secretariat. The English common names are derived from many different sources but the main criterion for selection has been aptness. The majority are included in Common Names of Species Listed on Appendices I and II also produced by the CITES Secretariat.

INTERPRETATION:

1. Species included in these Appendices are referred to:
 - a) by the name of the species; or
 - b) as being all of the species included in a higher taxon or designated part thereof.
2. The abbreviation "spp." is used to denote all species of a higher taxon.
3. Other references to taxa higher than species are for the purposes of information or classification only.
4. The abbreviation "p.e." is used to denote species which are possibly extinct.
5. An asterisk (*) placed against the name of a species or higher taxon indicates that one or more geographically separate populations, subspecies or species of that species or taxon are included in Appendix I and that these populations, subspecies or species are excluded from Appendix II.
6. Two asterisks (**) placed against the name of a species or higher taxon indicates that one or more geographically separate populations, subspecies or species of that species or taxon are included in Appendix II and that these populations, subspecies or species are excluded from Appendix I.
7. The symbol (N) indicates that further details concerning that taxon may be found in the Notes on pages 35-39.
8. The symbol (F) indicates that details concerning further changes in the listing of that taxon may be found in the Special Flora Notes on pages 40-41.
9. The symbol (III) indicates that a part or the whole of the taxon was previously listed in Appendix III.

3. Other references to taxa higher than species are for the purpose of information or classification only.
4. An asterisk (*) placed against the name of a species or higher taxon indicates that one or more geographically separate populations, subspecies or species of that species or taxon was included in Appendix I and that these populations, subspecies or species were excluded from Appendix III. This clause has been inapplicable since 5 March 1986.
5. a) Two asterisks (**) placed against the name of a species indicate that one subspecies is included in Appendix II and that this subspecies is excluded from Appendix III.
b) Until 5 March 1986, two asterisks (**) placed against the name of a species or higher taxon indicated that one or more geographically separate populations, subspecies or species of that species or taxon were included in Appendix II and that these populations, subspecies or species were excluded from Appendix III.
6. The two-letter country codes placed against the names of species or other taxa are those of the Parties submitting these species or taxa for inclusion in this Appendix (see KEY).
7. Any animal or plant, whether alive or dead, of a species or other taxon listed in this Appendix, is covered by the provisions of the Convention, as is any readily recognizable part or derivative thereof.
8. The symbol (C) placed against the name of a species or higher taxon denotes that this species or higher taxon was included in Appendix I, except for Canada which entered a specific reservation with regard to them. This clause has been inapplicable since 4 February 1977.
9. The symbol (P) placed against the name of a species or higher taxon denotes that this species or higher taxon was included in Appendix II, except for Canada which entered a specific reservation with regard to them. This clause has been inapplicable since 4 February 1977.
10. The symbol (N) indicates that further details concerning that taxon may be found in the Notes on pages 35-39.

- CACTACEAE* spp. (b) : Until 29 August 1986, the listing of Cactaceae spp. in Appendix II was annotated "All species of the family in the Americas". This annotation was deleted by an amendment proposed by the Netherlands. The proposal stated that there were four possible interpretations of the annotated listing of Cactaceae spp. in Appendix II:
- a. All cacti regardless of their origin and status (either wild-collected or artificially propagated) were covered by CITES; or
 - b. All cacti taken in the wild in the Americas or artificially propagated in the Americas were covered by the Convention. Therefore, cacti artificially propagated or from naturalized populations from outside the Americas were not covered, except for *Rhipsalis* spp. which was listed separately; or
 - c. All cacti specimens were covered by CITES controls except those from naturalized populations outside the Americas. All specimens of *Rhipsalis* spp. were covered, regardless of their source; or
 - d. Appendix II cactus species included only those whose wild populations were completely confined to the Americas. Therefore, with the exception of *Rhipsalis* spp. which was separately listed, all species with naturalized populations outside the Americas were not covered by CITES controls.
- On the basis of these interpretations of the annotation, its deletion resulted in one of the following four additions to Appendix II with respect to which Austria has entered a reservation:
- a. None; or
 - b. All cacti artificially propagated outside the Americas and from naturalized populations outside the Americas, except *Rhipsalis* spp. and species already in Appendix I; or
 - c. All naturalized populations of Appendix II cacti outside the Americas except those of *Rhipsalis* spp.; or
 - d. All species of cactus that have naturalized populations outside the Americas except *Rhipsalis* spp. and those listed in Appendix I.
