# SELECTMEN'S REPORT.

Hyde Park, February 14, 1870.

Fellow Citizens:—Before retiring from our official station we hand you, as is customary, an account of the receipts and expenditures of the Town for the past financial year.

As the money expended greatly exceeds that appropriated, we think it due to you, and to ourselves, that we explain (to some extent) the cause of this excess.

We reprove ourselves for making the estimates on the new streets too hastily, and can only excuse this by pleading lack of time to make careful surveys, and close approximations to the amount of labor to be accomplished.

On the other hand, the appropriation for this work was five thousand dollars less than the amount thought necessary, and solicited by this Board.

In making our figures, we made no allowance for repairing damages caused by change of grade on these streets; it being the usual custom to settle such claims after the completion of the work, either by compromise with the Selectmen, or by a process of law. Instead of resorting to either of these methods, we took the responsibility to repair damages as we progressed; and we believe this plan to have been much more satisfactory to the owners of the estates injured than any other in practice; and, although attended with considerable expense, costing the Town far less than though adjusted in any other manner.

At the junction of Maple and Walnut Streets, we met with a difficulty that was not foreseen. Owing to the conformation of the hill, we found that it was absolutely impracticable to locate Maple Street as laid down on the plan of this section of our town; and, in changing to its present position, it was necessary to raise Walnut Street to its present grade, as well as to move the store near the

railroad, and to construct the walls now to be seen on Maple and Walnut Streets.

We, moreover, were not prepared to find such a stubborn resistance by Dame Nature to our efforts to reduce the grades on Mount Neponset; the structure of this hill being in places almost adamantine in its nature, and only to be worn away, as it were, by the continuous blows of the pick-axe.

Now, while feeling liable to censure for want of care in making our estimates, we are satisfied that our plans were correct, and, as those originally adopted were strictly adhered to, no labor was lost on account of their change. We also believe that the labor on these streets (considering the somewhat extraordinary combination of circumstances, and also considering the system, or lack of system, under which it was done) has not been extravagantly expensive, and we have reason to hope that, as time rolls on, you will have no cause to regret the expenditure of the money used in their construction.

We have alluded to the system of making town-ways adopted by us, and in general practice by the Town authorities in our vicinity; and, on this point, desire to say a few words. Generally speaking, it is not economical, or even practical, to let such work out by the contract, and it is, therefore, usually accomplished by the day, under the supervision of the highway surveyors. Now, these officers, as a rule, are selected from the business portion of the community, and have not, apart from their occupation, that amount of time to devote to the interest of the Town which true economy would seem to require. For this reason, our work has been unsatisfactory to ourselves, and (as it is quite probable that the Town officers will be drawn from the same class in the future as they have been in the past) we fear that those who follow us in this work will labor with the same ungratifying result, unless another system is adopted.

Former impressions, developed by the last year's experience into fixed convictions, urge us to counsel you to do no more of this sort of work until enough has accumulated to warrant the employment (for one season at least) of a skilled engineer to lay out the work, and of an experienced road-master, to personally and constantly

superintend it. We also believe that it would be greatly to the advantage of the Town to own the teams employed; buying the horses in the spring, and disposing of them, if thought best, in the fall.

An iron bridge, of the Moseley pattern, has been placed across Mother Brook, on Central Park Avenue. It has cost something more than was appropriated, owing, in part, to a reduction of the estimate, and also to the fact that the bridge is longer and wider than the one first under consideration, therefore affording better accommodation to the traveling public, and is not so open to the objections of the owners of water privileges along this stream.

The population of our town is rapidly increasing, and so are its wants, which keep pace with its growth. This is particularly apparent in regard to the school accommodations, which are entirely insufficient to meet the present necessities of the town.

It is imperative that we have more and better school buildings, and you will soon be called upon to decide to what extent they shall be increased, and where they shall be located.

In contemplating the future, it is plainly to be seen that a large amount of money will be required in furnishing the neccesary town buildings, and in making town-ways in the most densely settled portions of our Town; but if this cost is met gradually, we need not be overburdened by taxation in the endeavor to place our town in a condition that will compare favorably with those surrounding us.

# REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON BY-LAWS.

The committee to whom was referred the subject of preparing By-Laws for the Town of Hyde Park have attended to that duty, and respectfully submit the following draft:—

#### BY-LAWS.

#### NOTIFICATION OF TOWN MEETINGS.

Every Town Meeting shall be notified by posting a copy of the Warrant calling the same, in five public places in the Town, seven days, at least, before the day appointed for said meeting.

#### RULES FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF TOWN MEETINGS.

- 1. No final vote shall be reconsidered, except upon a motion made within one hour after such vote has passed, unless such reconsideration is ordered by a vote of three-fourths of the voters present.
- 2. All questions submitted for the consideration of the Town, involving the expenditure of money, shall be in writing; and all other motions shall be reduced to writing, if required by the presiding officer.
- 3. No vote, fixing the period for closing a ballot, shall be reconsidered after such ballot shall have commenced; but it may be in order to extend the period without such reconsideration.
- 4. When a question is under debate, motions shall be received to adjourn, to lay on the table, the previous question, to postpone indefinitely, to postpone to a time certain, to commit, or to amend; which several motions shall have precedence in the order in which they are herein arranged.
- 5. The powers and duties of the presiding officer, not especially provided for by law, or by the foregoing rules, shall be determined by the rules of practice contained in *Cushing's Manual*, so far as they are adapted to the condition and powers of the Town.

#### FINANCIAL YEARS.

The Financial Year of the Town shall begin with the first day of April in each year, and end with the thirty-first day of March following.

#### ANNUAL TOWN MEETING.

The Annual Town Meeting shall be on the second Tuesday of April in each year, and all reports of town officers shall be made at that time.

#### REPORTS OF COMMITTEES.

No action shall be had at any Town Meeting on the report of any committee previously chosen, unless the same shall be specially notified in the Warrant for calling such meeting.

#### MEETING OF TOWN OFFICERS.

The Selectmen, Overseers of the Poor, Surveyors of Highways, and School Committee, shall post up, in some conspicuous place, at their official rooms, a notice of the times of their respective meetings.

#### COLLECTION OF TAXES.

- 1. The assessments of taxes shall be completed, and a list of the same delivered to the Collector, on or before the first day of August of each year.
- 2. All taxes may be assessed, except poll taxes, if paid on or before the first day of October next after the assessment, shall be entitled to a discount of two per cent. All single poll taxes shall be paid in fourteen days after demand. All taxes shall be paid in full on or before the first day of November; and, if not so paid, interest shall be added at the rate of twelve per cent. per annum.

#### REMOVAL OF BUILDINGS AND OBSTRUCTION OF HIGHWAYS.

- 1. No building shall be removed over a public street without the written permission of the Selectmen, and the Selectmen shall in no case grant permission to remove any building, which in its removal will cause the injury or destruction of any tree or shrub, the property of individuals, whether in the street or otherwise, unless the written consent of the owners of said property shall be first had and obtained.
- 2. Such written permission shall contain a condition that the owner of such building, or the person or persons removing the same, shall pay the Town all damages, costs and expenses for which the Town may be liable or compelled to pay, by reason of said street being obstructed or encumbered.
- 3. No person shall place or cause to be placed in any of the public streets, sidewalks, lands, or upon any of the common lands of the Town, without a written license from the Selectmen, any

manure, dirt, gravel, stones, building materials, wood, coal, barrels, boxes, merchandise, or any rubbish of any kind whatever, and suffer the same to remain for twenty-four hours. Such license shall not be granted in the case of persons building, when the person whose land is built upon has sufficient adjecent land on which the materials may be deposited. Upon notice from one or more of the Selectmen to any person offending as aforesaid, or to the person owning the substance or article placed in violation of this By-Law, such person or owner shall immediately remove the same.

#### PASTURING OF CATTLE OR OTHER ANIMALS ON STREETS OR WAYS.

- 1. The Town hereby adopts and avails itself of the provisions of Chapter 45 of the General Statutes, relating to the pasturing of cattle or other animals in streets or ways.
- 2. No person shall be allowed to pasture any cattle or other animals upon any streets or ways in said Town, either with or without a keeper, except within the limits of such way adjoining his own premises.

#### PENALTIES UNDER THE BY-LAWS.

Every violation of any of the foregoing By-Laws shall be punished by a fine of not less than one dollar nor more than twenty dollars, to be recovered by complaint before any Trial Justice in the County of Norfolk.

#### PROSECUTIONS UNDER THE BY-LAWS.

It shall be the duty of the Selectmen to prosecute every violation of any of the foregoing By-Laws by complaint before any Trial Justice in the County of Norfolk.

#### BY-LAWS, WHEN TO TAKE EFFECT.

These By-Laws shall go into effect from and after their passage, and their approval by the Superior Court within and for the County of Norfolk.

ARTICLE 4.—A. H. Brainard, of the Committee on By-Laws, reported a draft.

Voted, to accept the report of the Committee, and adopt the By-Laws recommended. EXTRACT FROM SAME, OF TOWN MEETING HOLDEN MONDAY, APRIL 5, 1869.

ARTICLE 10.—Voters to so amend the By-Laws as to change the time of holding the annual Town Meeting from the first Monday in April to the first Monday in March, and the close of the financial year from February fifteenth to January fifteenth.

EXTRACT FROM SAME, OF TOWN MEETING HOLDEN THURSDAY, OCTOBER 14, 1869.

ARTICLE 2.—Voted to have the following incorporated among the By-Laws of the town:—

"Coasting on any of the highways of the Town is prohibited, and the Constables and Police Officers are hereby instructed to enforce this law."
