REPORT.

To the Legislature of the State of New York:

The trustees of the State Library

RESPECTFULLY REPORT :

That the number of volumes in the Library at the close of the year 1857, was forty-nine thousand one hundred and seventy-eight.

There have been added during the last year three thousand six hundred and eighty-two volumes, of which two thousand and sixty-seven were by purchase, and one thousand six hundred and fifteen volumes by donation and exchange; making the number at the close of 1858, fifty-two thousand eight hundred and sixty.

A list of donations and of works, obtained under the system of international and State exchange, is hereto annexed. The list of purchases will be delayed until the next annual report, when it is proposed to present it with the accessions, from all sources, since the completion and publication of the catalogue of 1855, to form a supplementary catalogue.

This will be in place of a full general catalogue, as authorized by statute to be published every five years, the trustees being influenced by a desire to limit the expenses of the Library within the demands of a proper economy.

The system of exchange with scientific societies of Great Britain, alluded to in the last report, has been brought into active operation, and is placing in the Library their proceedings, many of which are of great value, and could not well be obtained by any other means.

The trustees regret to state, that three large cases containing many valuable works, transmitted by M. Vattemare, in May last, were received in a condition of almost utter ruin, the vessel in which they were shipped having been wrecked, and the books remaining in water several months. They were carefully removed from the cases, and such as were not wholly destroyed, were dried, and have been re-bound. It is hoped that some of the last works

may be restored, while others, which are rare, and had been collected with great pains, we cannot expect soon to replace.

De Bry's collection of Voyages to America and the East Indies, printed from 1591 to 1634, in twenty-five parts, complete, a very rare work, of great value, and in excellent condition, has been secured at a small expense in money, the cost having been defrayed principally by the exchange of duplicates, and the public documents of the State.

A collection of five thousand English pamphlets has been received, for which the same number of American pamphlets is to be returned.

The value of this class of publications is often under-estimated. When properly classified and arranged, they exhibit the progress and events of the age in which they are published, in a way which it is difficult to supply from any other source.

The trustees invite contributions of American pamphlets from the friends of the Library, both for the direct purposes of the Library, and for exchange.

In the last report mention was made of an effort to supply deficiencies in the Statute Laws and Legislative Documents of the other States. This effort has, to a considerable extent, been successful; and it is believed that, with these laws and documents, this Library is better furnished than any other in the country.

A continuation of the great work on patents, in course of publication by the Government of Great Britain, for 1857, has been received.

The appropriation for binding the work made in 1857 is nearly exhausted, and it is respectfully submitted to the Legislature, whether provision should not be made for the binding of the volumes of 1858, which it is understood will soon be ready for delivery. With the appropriation of the unexpended balance of the former appropriation, about six hundred dollars will be sufficient for the purpose.

The expense of binding for a library, which is rapidly increasing, must necessarily be large. Many books now published are so slightly bound as to be wholly unfit to be placed on the shelves. Most of the English law books, which are indispensable to the law department of the Library, are in this condition; and the same may be stated of many of the donations.

The annual appropriations for this purpose, until 1857, were insufficient, and deficiencies were often supplied by special appropriation. The binding appropriation was then increased, in the

hope that the expenditure could be brought within the sum provided. The trustees have steadily directed their efforts to this object, and hope to be able to limit their expenditures to the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars, the appropriation of the last two years.

The New York State Library has become a just matter of pride to the citizens of the State. It has been the purpose of the Trustees to gather whatever sheds light on the past history of the State and country, and to provide in the various departments of art, literature and science, such works as are beyond the means of ordinary students.

The Trustees cannot doubt that the Legislature, in the exercise of an enlightened liberality, will continue to supply the means for providing such works as the advancing progress of science and civilization at once furnish and demand.

R E P O R T .

TO THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK.

The Trustees of the State Library Respectfully Report :

That the number of volumes in the library at the close of the year 1858, was fifty-two thousand eight hundred and sixty.

There have been added during the past year, two thousand nine hundred and twenty-two volumes, making the number of volumes at the close of the year 1859, fifty-five thousand seven hundred and eighty.

The usual list of books obtained by donation and exchange is herewith presented. The donations are principally from disinterested and valued friends of the library. The exchange is with individuals, societies and states. The basis of the system is the public documents of the State, and the several scientific and historical works which have been published or placed at the disposal of the trustees of the library by legislative authority. A large portion of the works included in the catalogue have been brought to the library by this means, and embrace many valuable publications which it would be difficult to obtain by purchase. The Natural History of the State, as a means of exchange, is exhausted; and the Colonial History, by repeated distribution, is reduced to about one hundred and thirty copies. As there is little probability that any other of the historical records of the State will soon be published, the trustees therefore earnestly recommend that the law which directs the Colonial History "to be used for the purpose of literary exchange" should not be interfered with.

A loss by shipwreck of portions of several cases of books, transmitted by M. Vattemare, under the system of international exchange, was stated in the last report. The trustees are gratified in being able to say, that by his efforts and influence a large portion of the loss has been resupplied.

During the year exchanges have been instituted with the Academy of Sciences of Milan and of Vienna.

By the generous liberality of the government of Denmark, the library has been put in possession of a copy of the magnificent work of Lepsius, on the Antiquities of Egypt and Ethiopia. The correspondence connected with this valuable gift is herewith communicated. The interest taken in this matter by the Hon. Mr. de Raasloff, the Danish Charge d'Affaires in this country, entitles him to the warmest thanks of the friends of the library.

The first series of the work on English Patents, from March 2d, 1617 (14 James I.), to October 1, 1852 (16 Victoria), has been received. The magnitude of this part of the work may, in some manner, be understood, when it is stated that it contains more than 14,000 specifications, with full letter press descriptions. The trustees are of opinion that it can be arranged at a moderate cost, in a way convenient for reference, without binding, by which a large expenditure will be avoided. It will be less consulted than the new series; and being provided with full indices, its contents are clearly exhibited, and any desired specification may be readily found. The continuation of the new series, through 1858, and a part of 1859, has been received, and an appropriation of six hundred dollars will be necessary for binding the work.

A continuation of the works of Frederick the Great, in the same beautiful style of typography with the former volumes, has been received from the government of Prussia.

From the library of the city Amsterdam, more than fifty volumes of valuable ancient works have been received.

The trustees refer, in a spirit of gratification, which they are confident is shared with them by the citizens of the State, to the progress and present condition of the library. They believe it to be by far the best State Library in the country, and ranks high among the most valuable collections. Unless the same liberal provision for its increase, which up to the last year has been made by the Legislature of the State, shall be continued, its progress must be seriously retarded. Any such result, the trustees, in common with its numerous friends, would most deeply deplore.

REPORT.

To the Hon. the Legislature of the State of New York :

The Trustees of the State Library present this, their forty-third, annual report.

At the close of the year 1859, the number of volumes in the library was..... 55,779

There have been added during the year 1860..... 2,015

Making the total number of volumes at the close of 1860.. 57,794

Of these there were of law, statutes, and state papers ... 17,018

In the general library..... 40,776

Of the additions during the year :

The additions for four years past have been reported as follows :

1857..... 4,710

1858..... 3,682

1859..... 2,922

1860..... 2,015

It will thus be seen that the rate of increase of the library has been very materially diminished during the last two years. This arises from the fact that the annual appropriation for its enlargement, which for a long series of years had been fixed at \$3,100, and which, during the years 1857 and 1858, had been increased to \$4,000, was reduced by the Legislature, in 1859, to \$2,000, at which it has since been continued.

The committee of the trustees charged with the care of the library, have for three years past personally represented to the

appropriate legislative committees the importance of larger appropriations for its increase, and the trustees also urged it in their last annual report, but they regret to say without success. They do not hesitate to aver that no appropriation made by the State has been more prudently and judiciously managed than the moderate sum heretofore entrusted to their care, and they very deeply regret that the Legislature has reduced it so much below the amount needed to maintain the usefulness and value of the library.

In pursuance of the course heretofore uniformly pursued, the efforts of the trustees have been first directed to keeping up the Law department. This absorbs at least one-half of the present appropriation, leaving about one thousand dollars per annum for the increase of the general library, a sum entirely inadequate to its wants and character.

The trustees submit these remarks to the Legislature, with great respect, and in the hope that another year will not be suffered to pass without an increase of the annual appropriation.

Annexed hereto is a catalogue of the additions, by donation and exchange, during the past calendar year; and also an account current, showing the receipts and expenditures during the fiscal year, ending October 1, 1860.

Although the publication of a new catalogue of the library at this time is authorized by law, it has been thought expedient not to undertake it for the present, but to substitute therefor a supplemental volume, containing the additions since the publication of the catalogue of 1855-56. This supplement is now in preparation, and will soon be completed and published.

During the past year a large addition of the great work on English Patents has been received. The trustees do not propose to bind any of this series, but to place them, properly arranged and lettered, in cases, which they believe will be found amply sufficient both for their preservation, and for the purposes of reference.

The system of exchanges with foreign governments, and the other States of the Union, has been continued as heretofore, and with the usual results.

To the Honorable the Legislature of the State of New York :

The Trustees of the State Library respectfully submit their forty-fourth annual report.

The condition of the Library at the close of the year 1860 was as follows :

The reduced appropriations of the last three years fully account for the diminished rate of increase of the library. The attention of the Legislature having been repeatedly called to this subject, the trustees may now only express their regret that with the limited means at their disposal they are unable to keep pace

with the rapid developments of science, the advancing progress of the arts, and the extending triumphs of modern civilization.

A supplement to the catalogue of the general library of 1855-6, to which reference was made in the last annual report of the trustees, has been completed and is now ready for distribution. A supplemental catalogue of the law and State papers department is in course of preparation. These supplements will make the catalogue of the entire library complete. Their publication, instead of the full catalogue authorized by statute, has been prompted by the same scrupulous economy which has heretofore governed the trustees in administering the affairs of the library.

The usual catalogue of books received by donation and exchange during the year, and a statement of receipts and expenditures are hereto annexed.

The trustees will continue their long cherished purpose of making the New York State Library an honor to the State and a rich repository of the garnered treasures of literature and science. For the means of doing this they must look to the wise liberality of the Legislature.

REPORT.

To the Honorable the Legislature of the State of New York :

The Forty-fifth Annual Report on the condition of the State Library is herewith respectfully submitted by the trustees :

At the close of the year 1861, as stated in their last report, the whole number of volumes in the library was	59,776
In the law department	17,397
In the general library	42,379
At the close of the year 1862, the whole number of volumes in the library had been increased to	63,104
By additions to the law department of	473
do do general library of	2,855
Total	3,328

Of these additions there were by purchase	1,760
By donation or exchange	1,568

The whole number of volumes in both departments added since the publication of the catalogue in 1856, is 19,473.

During the four years from 1858 to 1861 inclusive, there has been a constant diminution in the growth of the library, consequent upon reduced appropriations for those years, while, in the meantime, the demand for its enlargement becomes constantly more urgent. By the liberality of the last Legislature, the annual appropriation was enlarged, and the trustees have been enabled, in consequence, to make additions exceeding those of the last two years.

The following is a statement of the increase of the library for the last six years :

A supplemental catalogue of the law department, which will complete the catalogue of the whole library, is now nearly ready.

The Legislature appropriated last year two hundred and fifty dollars for the purchase of cases in which the last series of the Patent Reports presented by the British Government might be arranged for safe keeping and convenient reference. This arrangement has proved satisfactory. It has been found necessary, however, to procure a larger number of cases than was provided for in the appropriation referred to. For the purpose of defraying the expense of this additional number, the trustees respectfully ask an appropriation of one hundred and twenty-five dollars.

Appended to this report will be found the usual catalogue of books received by donation or exchange, a statement of receipts and expenditures, and a catalogue of the books added since the issue of the Supplement of 1861.
