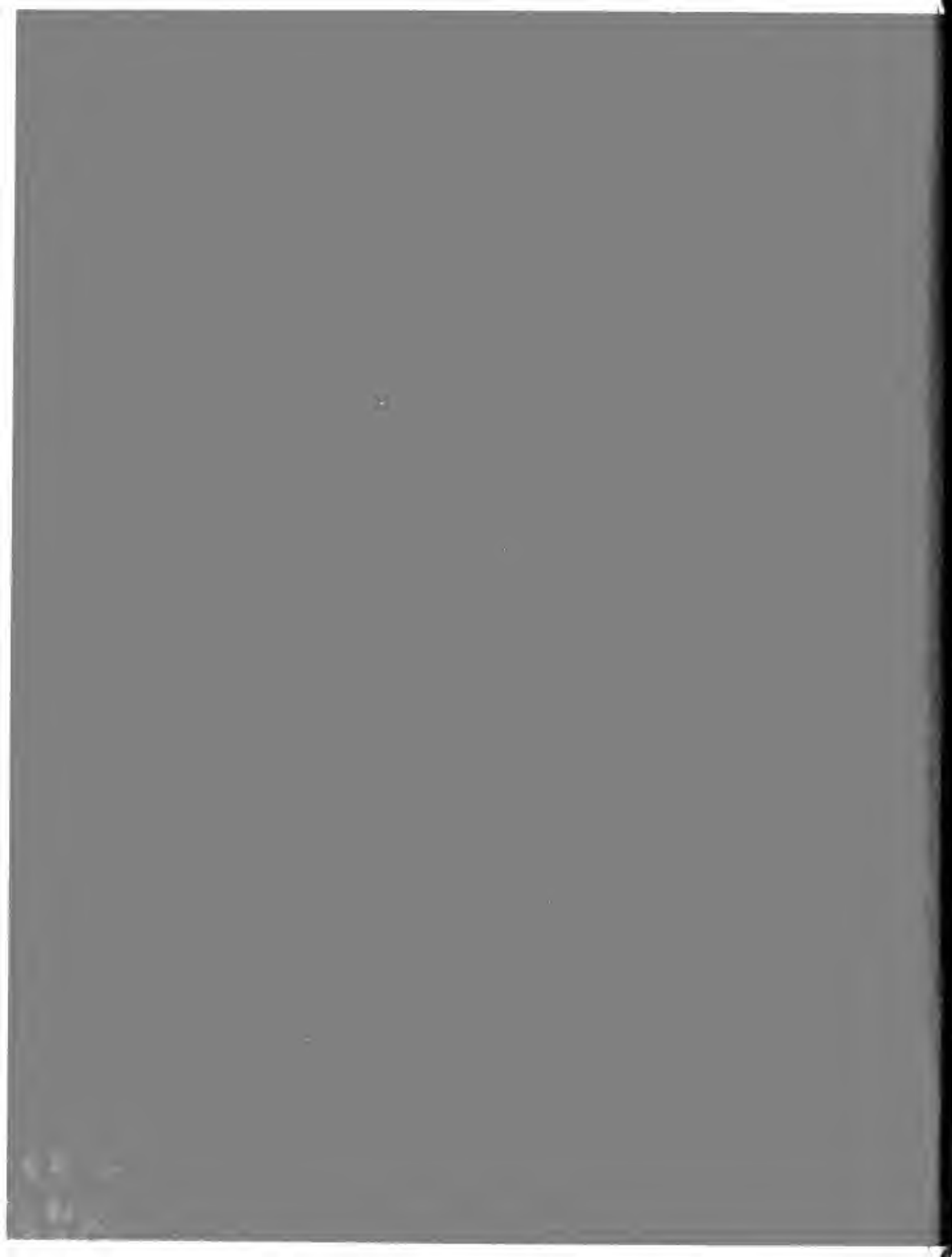

# President's Message

I am delighted about the publication of this yearbook for it captures the essence of the University while maintaining a pictorial record of the year for students, faculty, staff and community to enjoy.

Indeed, compressed into these pages are a collection of memories that will be with us forever: our classmates and instructors; the buildings where we studied; the social, academic, professional, and athletic organizations and activities in which we participated; the sponsors who supported us; and the wider communities in which we and our school exists.

Moreover, the rejuvenation of issuing a yearbook this year comes at a critical time in the history of our school. Since taking office as President two years ago, the entire university was reaccredited after a recent evaluation and accreditation process was completed by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS). We are proud of this reaccreditation because, by national standards, the University is reaffirmed that it is highly capable of meeting the academic challenges facing the higher education community. Graduate degrees are offered at the Shaw University School of Divinity which has received full accreditation by the American Theological Society (ATS). Graduate degrees in Education are offered and plans are underway to offer advanced degrees in Business.

Many other examples point to Shaw University's commitment to excellence. First, numerous students have expressed their exultation about the overall excellence and wide range of majors that they find at Shaw University. They have good reason to be enthusiastic in that several 2004 graduates were selected over students from larger institutions to participate in fully paid graduate programs. Implementation of the President's Award for Outstanding Academic Achievement led to nine members of the football team making the All CIAA Academic Team. Academic achievement is honored in a number of other ways that included having pictures of representative students placed prominently in Debnam Hall (administration building) and the James E. Cheek Learning Center (library). What is more, a provision for students to publish an on-line student newspaper, *The Bear Facts*, was recently put into place. Very often small groups of students and faculty meet to share ideas and aspirations for Shaw University and to establish stronger communications with the administration. This kind of interchange led to the initiation of the Shaw Man and Shaw Woman Society which challenges each young man and woman in the Shaw family to strive toward excellence, integrity, intellect, resourcefulness, caring, determination, thoughtfulness, graciousness, and love. Regarding technology, the University installed the most advanced, state-of-the-art telecommunications platform of any institution of higher learning in the state of North Carolina. Also, computer laboratories throughout the campus and residential halls were upgraded.

These are but a few of the positive developments that make it clear that "A New Shaw for a New Millennium" is emerging. Indeed, we are making "Strides to Excellence." We want "Only the Best."

I applaud the entire Shaw family for its contribution to excellence.
