A BILL

To be entitled An act for the relief of Leach & Avery.

1     *The Congress of the Confederate States of America do enact, That*  
2     the treasurer of the Confederate States be, and he is hereby, author-  
3     ized and directed to pay to Messrs. Leach & Avery, or their legal  
4     representatives, two hundred dollars, out of any money in the  
5     treasury not otherwise appropriated, the value of a house of  
6     theirs, used as a post house, and burnt by order of the provost  
7     marshal of the city of Tuscaloosa, in the State of Alabama.
