## A BILL

To be entitled An Act providing for the auditing and payment of properly authenticated claims.

- 1 WHEREAS, Under authority of Lt. Gen. E. Kirby Smith, com-
- 2 manding the Trans-Mississippi Military Department, large quan-
- 3 tities of cotton have been purchased for the use of the Confed-
- 4 erate States by W. J. Hutchins, appointed for that purpose, for
- 5 which certificates have been given, providing that payment should
- 6 be made as Congress might thereafter prescribe. AND WHERE-
- 7 AS, Said claims cannot be paid without the sanction of Congress,
- 8 according to the terms of the contract, Therefore,
- 1 The Congress of the Confederate States of America do enact,
- 2 That the Secretary of the Treasury do cause all such claims for
- 3 cotton sold and delivered to the said W. J. Hutchins, for the
- 4 use of the Confederate States, to be examined and audited by
- 5 the proper accounting officer of the Trans-Mississippi Depart-
- 6 ment, according to such regulations as he may deem just and
- 7 proper, and that there be paid therefor just compensation, out
- 8 of any funds appropriated thereto.
