A BILL

To be entitled An Act providing for the auditing and payment of properly authenticated claims against the Cotton Bureau in the Trans Mississippi Department.

- 1 WHEREAS, Under authority of Lieut. Gen. E. Kirby Smith, com-
- 2 manding the Trans-Mississippi Military Department, large quan-
- 3 tities of cotton have been purchased for the use of the Confeder-
- 4 ate States, by W. A. Broadwell, appointed for that purpose, and
- 5 for which certificates have been given, providing that payment
- 6 should be made as Congress might thereafter prescribe. AND
- 7 WHEREAS, Said claims cannot be paid without the sanction of
- 8 Congress, according to the terms of the contract, Therefore,
- 1 The Congress of the Confederate States of America dogenact,
- 2 That the Secretary of the Treasury do cause all such claims for
- 3 cotton sold and delivered to the said W. A. Broadwell for the
- 4 use of the Confederate States, to be examined and audited by
- 5 the proper accounting officer of the Trans-Mississippi Military
- 6 Department, according to such regulations as he may deem just
- 7 and proper, and that there be paid therefor just compensation
- 8 out of any funds appropriated thereto.
