A BILL

To increase the number of acting midshipmen in the navy, and to prescribe the manner of appointment.

1 SECTION 1. *The Congress of the Confederate States of America*
2 *do enact*, That the number of acting midshipmen in the navy
3 shall be increased to one hundred and fifty, who shall be ap-
4 pointed, subject to the rules and regulations for the government
5 of the naval school, as follows: One from each Congressional
6 district, upon the nomination of the representative thereof in
7 Congress: two at large from each State, upon the nomination
8 of the Senators thereof respectively: and the remaining eighteen
9 by the President at large.
