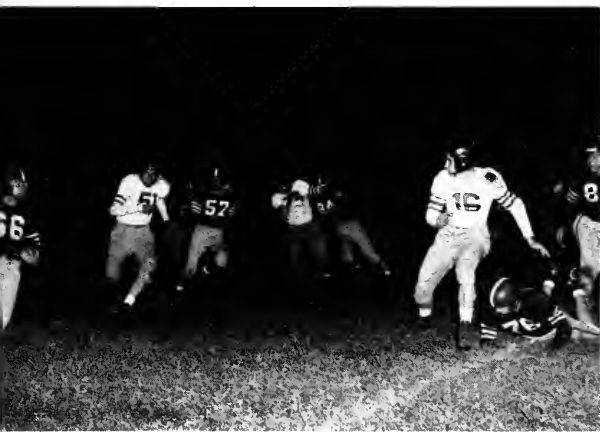

## ATHLETICS AT MILLSAPS

Millsaps maintains football, baseball, and basketball teams in the Dixie Conference. Millsaps athletes are men who play these sports for the love of the game. They devote their time and energy to these sports for the joy of winning and participating. These athletes are at Millsaps for an education first—for athletics second.

Millsaps captured the Dixie Conference Football Championship this year for the first time in the history of the school. In basket-ball, the Millsaps five won the consolation bracket for the second consecutive year.

The Majors traveled to Pensacola, Florida, in search of their first win of the season against the Naval Air Station "Goslins," but were defeated by the score of 13-7. The Major's lone score was made by Kalil, with T. W. Lewis adding the extra point.

The Majors gained their first victory of the season by defeating the Sewanee Tigers by the score of 7-6. Glenn Cain scored the Major's touchdown on a 23 yard quarterback sneak, and T. W. Lewis adding the winning extra point.

Meeting their arch rivals next, the Majors took the Choctaws in stride by the score of 12-7. Great defensive work on the part of the forward wall and the scoring of Kalil and Collins gave the Majors their most prized win of the season.

In the next game, with Howard, the Majors won the conference championship by defeating the Bulldogs 27-14. This game was marked by the brilliant generalship and passing of Eddie Collins. Kalil, Parker, Cain, and Scott scored the TD's with Parker adding 3 extra points.

The Majors met defeat in the closing game of the season at the hands of the Hendrix College Indians. Glorioso scored the only Millsaps touchdown in this 14-6 defeat.

In basketball, the Majors were led to the consolation championship by two time All-Dixie Phil Wallace. The Major five was rounded out by Glenn Cain, Bob Gorday, Jim Allen, and Rod Jeffreys.

How the Majors will do in baseball remains at this writing, to be seen. Coach "Sammy" has four returning lettermen to build his team around — Glorioso, Woods, Kurts, and Townes.

Millsaps also maintains a fine program of intramurals in speedball, basketball, softball, golf, and tennis for those who don't enter intercollegiate athletics.

In speedball, the Pikes took the crown by going undefeated. The Ministers were runner-ups and the Kappa Sigs placed third. The All-Star team was composed of four Pikes—Dunbar, Whitehouse, Roebuck, and Smith; four Ministers—Anderson, White, Bowers, and Bolton; two Kappa Alphas—Allen and Crisler; and two Kappa Sigs—Moore and Clement.

The Independents took the basketball crown with the Pikes second and the Kappa Sigs third. Two Pikes—Roebuck and Frazier; two Kappa Sigs—Woods and Powell; and Independent John Crabb made up the All-Star team.
