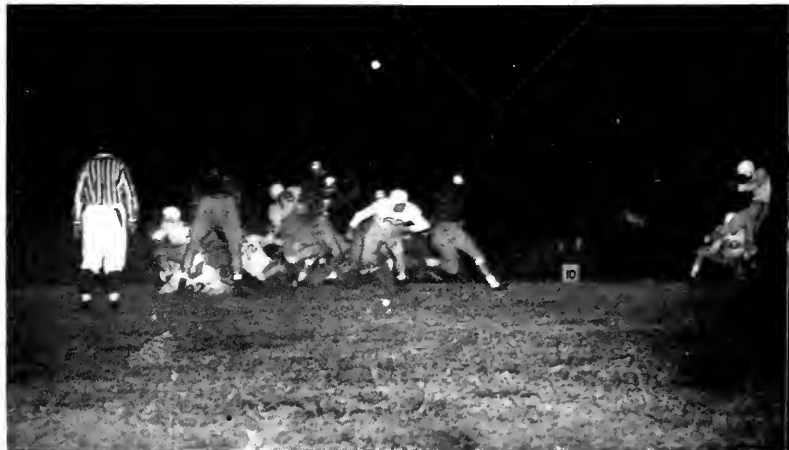

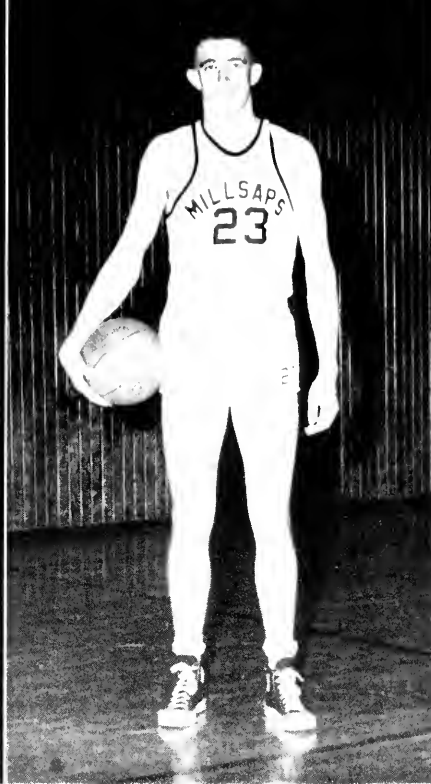
# BASKETBALL
