Boule de Suif (1880) is a short story by the late 19th century writer Guy de Maupassant. It is arguably his most famous story, and is the title story for his collection on the Franco-Prussian War, entitled Boule de Suif et Autres Contes de la Guerre (Boule de Suif and Other Stories of the War).
