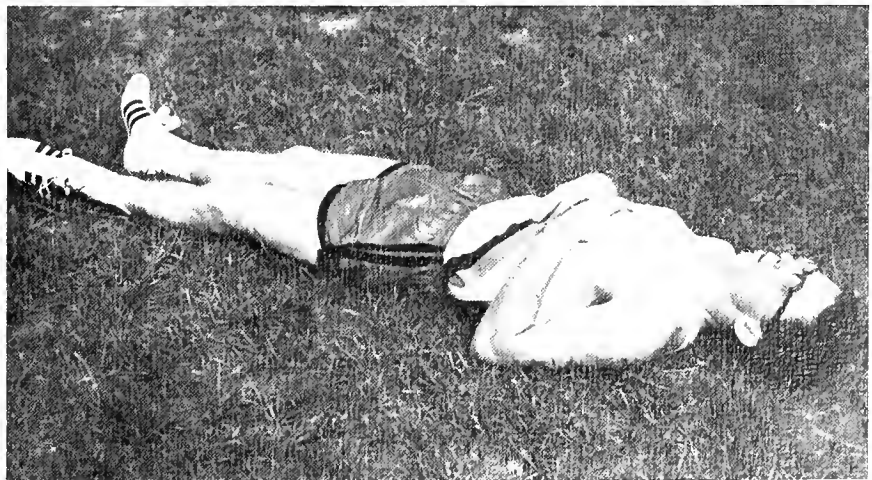

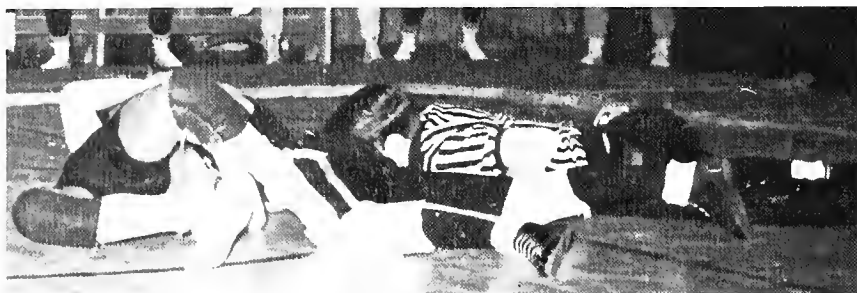

The Buff cagers got off to a slow start this year but managed to end the season with a 10—20 over-all record and a 3—7 record in the conference. The team won seven out of their ten last games and were fifth in the nation in free throw percentage.

Leading the Buffs this year were "Toonie" Cash with an average of 26.9 points per game and Bill Seeger with an average of 16.2 points per game. Cash, a freshman, also received an Honorable mention to the All-American team and made All-Conference.

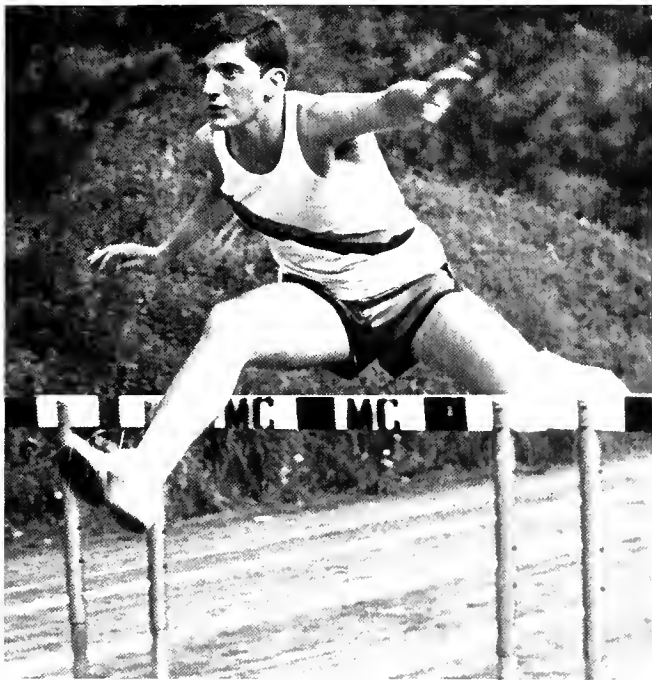

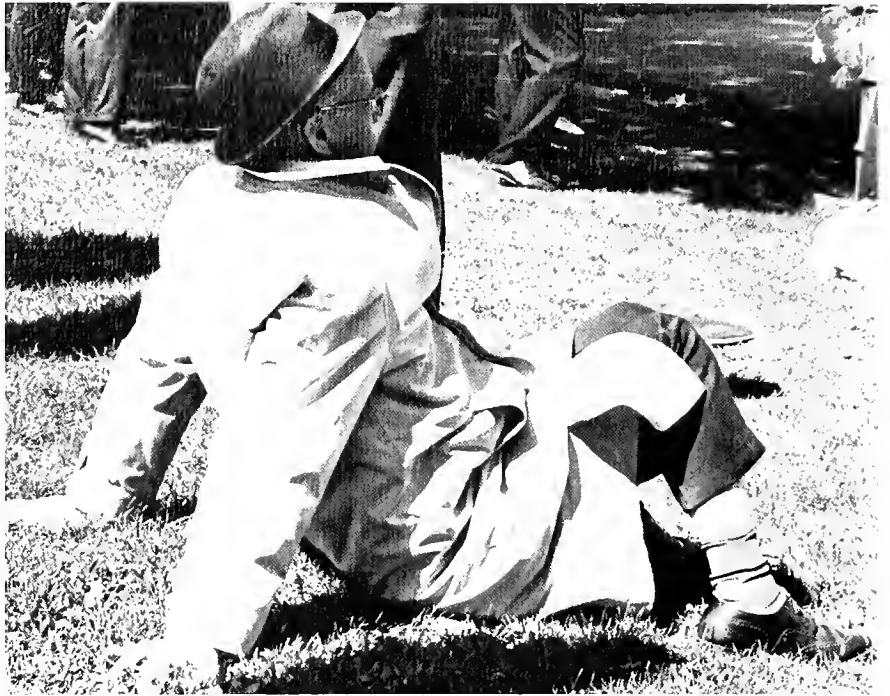
President's Message
