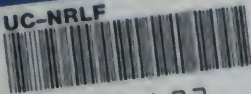

As a rule they are separate publications, no attempt having been made to extend the list by taking from town histories or serials of any kind. Durrie's Index (4432.70) will be found a very satisfactory guide to the students in investigating publications of that character. It may save time and trouble to know that when the shelf number begins with 24, 25, or 45, the work indicated is the history of an English or Scotch, not of an American family. In many instances the books are restricted to hall use.

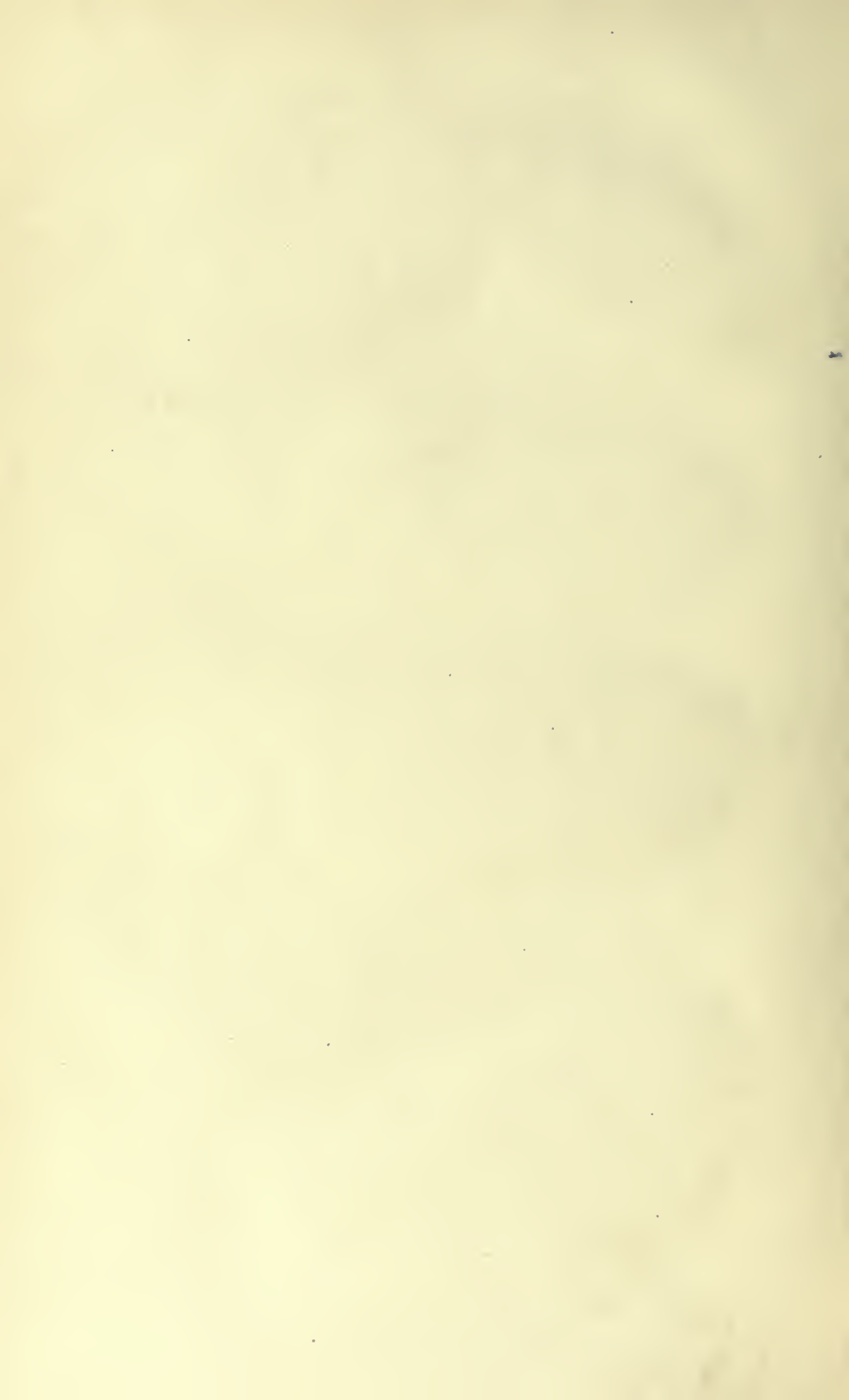

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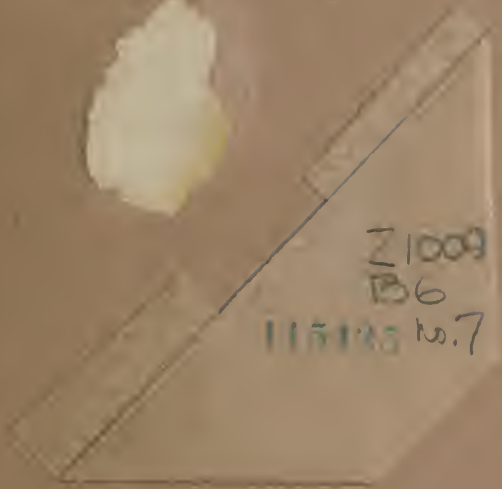
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
