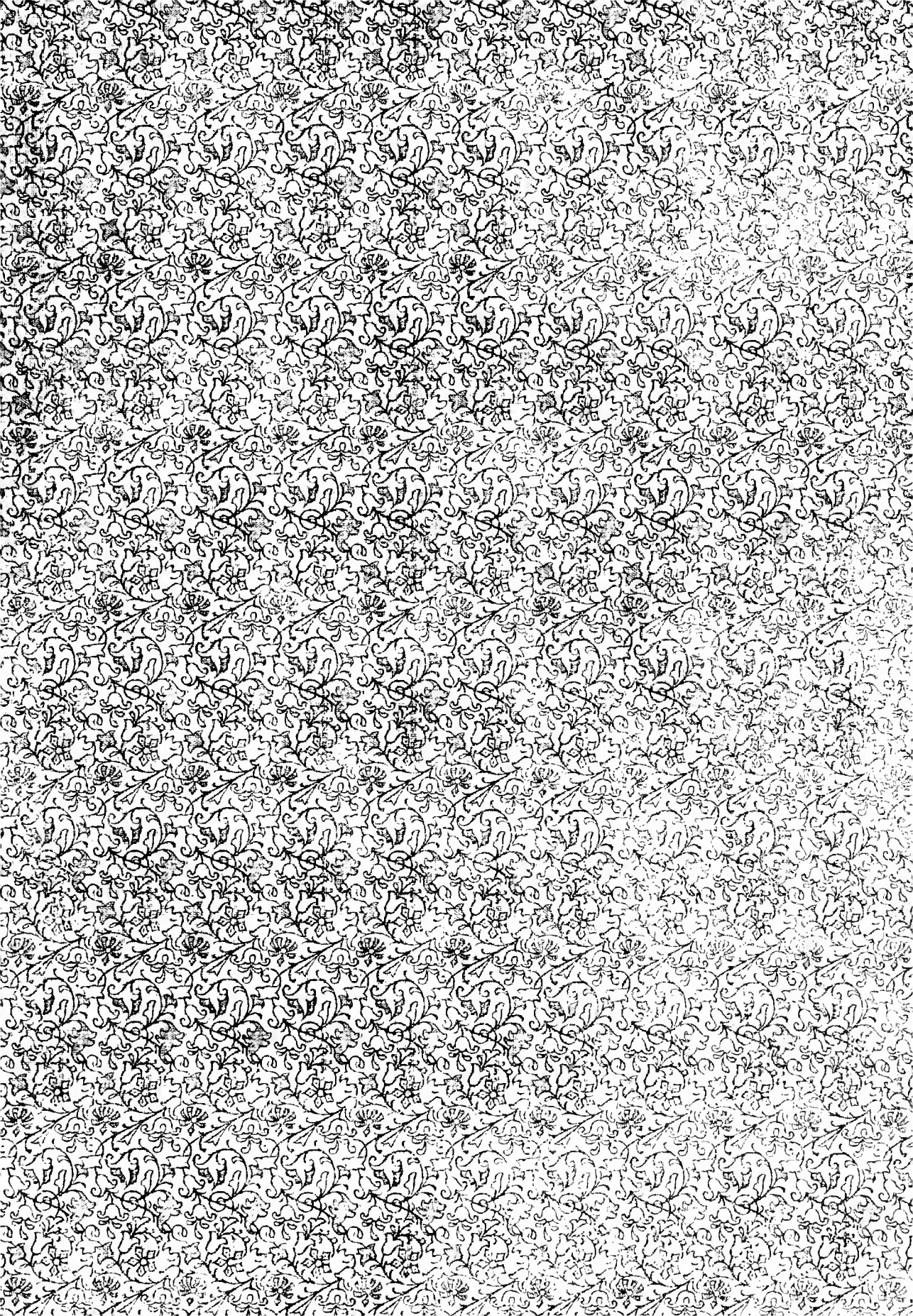

The ground was finally given into the charge of the Village Trustees and they had the place carefully surveyed by Thomas V. Smith, so as to locate each grave, and a copy of each inscription filed with the Village Clerk and the stones put under ground and a park made of the space.

This Park lies next east of the Presbyterian Church. The stones were covered in 1897

When this copy was made, in November 1904, the stones which are underscored with red ink were still standing and no reason could be found as to why.

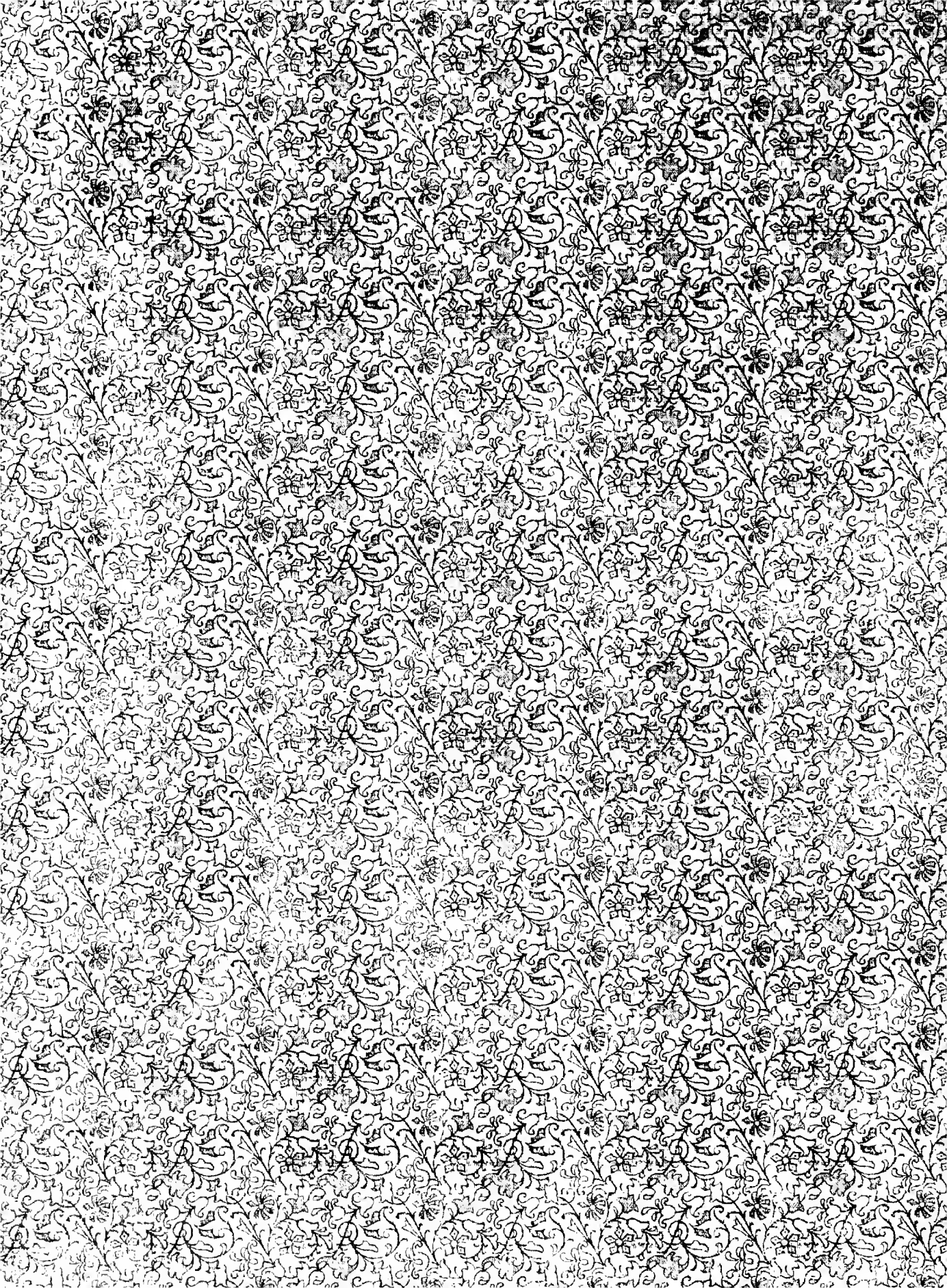

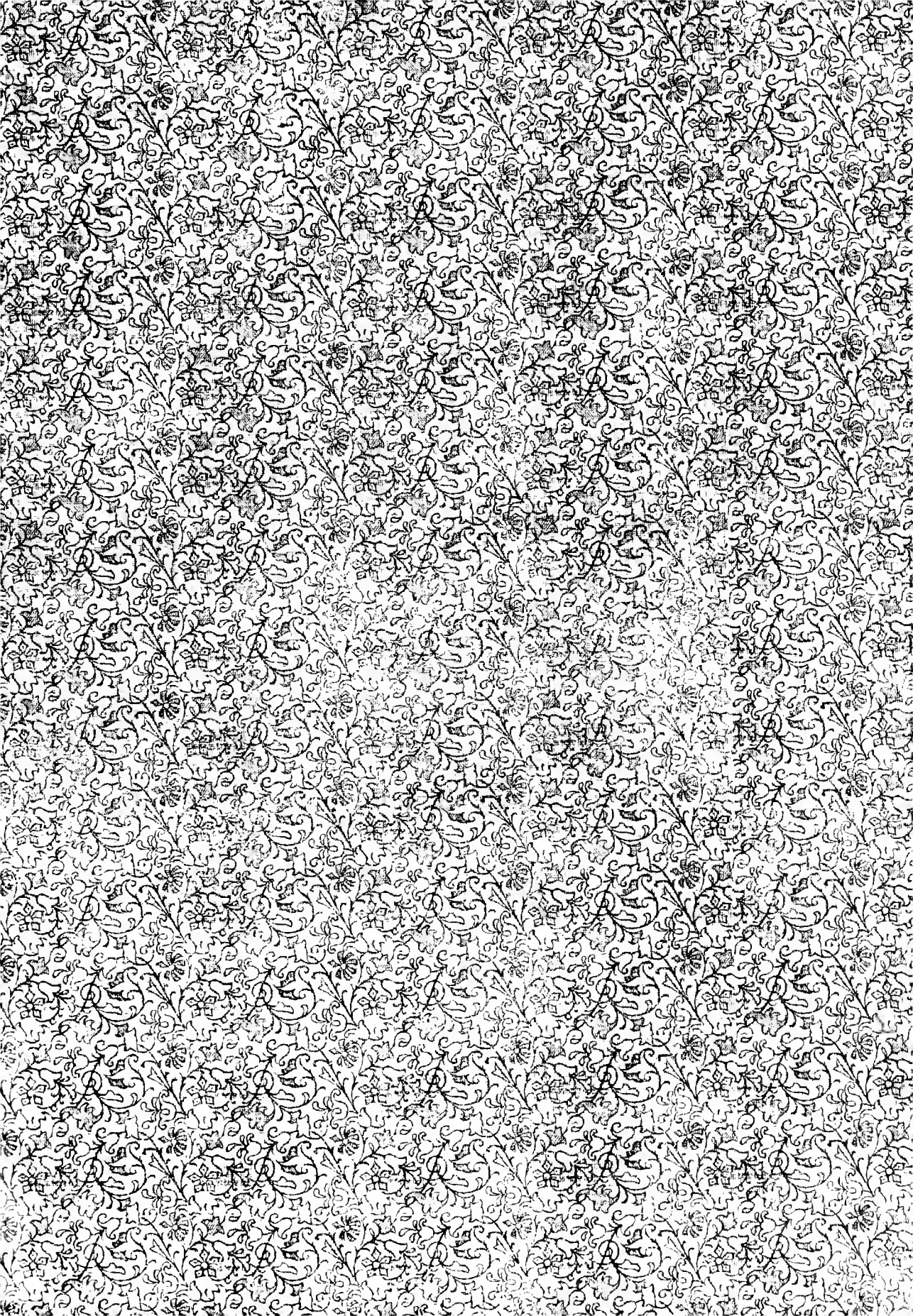
