CIRCULAR.

CONFEDERATE STATES OF AMERICA,
SUBSISTENCE DEPARTMENT,
Richmond, January 5, 1864.

When there is no meat ration, a pound of sound potatoes, if possessed, should be added to the bread ration. If neither meat nor potatoes, then three-fourths of a pound of flour or meal will be added to the present ration of flour or meal. When both meat and flour or meal can be furnished, and potatoes are likewise possessed, one pound of potatoes will be substituted for one-fourth of a pound of flour or meal.
