PREFATORY NOTE

When the schedule for Greek and Latin literature was printed in 1928 as part of the volume P-PA, Philology, Linguistic, Classical Philology, Classical Literature, it included the classification of Byzantine and Modern Greek literature and of Medieval and Modern Latin literature only in skeleton form in the synopsis which came at the beginning of the volume. This is now printed in full and completes the schedule for Greek and Latin literature.

The schemes were prepared by Mr. Clarence W. Parley, then Chief of the Classification Division. They were completed in 1933 and made available in typewritten form to the staff and, by inter-library loan, to classifiers in other libraries. Expansions and minor additions made since that date have been incorporated.
