COBOURG, ONTARIO

Cobourg is located 70 miles east of Toronto, on the Montreal-Toronto Highway. We have a population of 5,500, with most of our citizens owning their homes. Our harbour is open the entire year, and vessels from abroad, as well as lake vessels, are able to call for load or to discharge their cargoes at our docks. It is the only harbour of safety available to vessels during stress of weather on the north shore.

TRANSPORTATION

Cobourg is well situated for transportation facilities, being on the main lines of both transcontinental railways,—the Canadian National and the Canadian Pacific, and the Canadian National

Ferries give us daily connections with Rochester, N.Y., and points east. This Ferry connection brings in factory coal at the lowest freight rate enjoyed by any town within the area known as Eastern Ontario. In addition King's Highway No. 2 affords car and truck service of great efficiency.

INDUSTRIES

Our industries are diversified, and our workers have enjoyed fairly steady employment. We have no dead factory buildings, everyone being occupied by a live industry, as witness the photographs of several of our plants shown in this booklet.

LABOUR

We have a desirable class of home-owning and satisfied mechanics and labourers, trained in a diversity of crafts, and with no labour troubles.

POWER AND WATER

Ample power facilities are provided by the Cobourg Public Utilities Commission and at reasonable rates. Water sufficient for all manufacturing purposes and of excellent quality is also available, and our plant capacity has recently been increased by the addition of two filters and an overhead storage tank of 300,000 gallons.

FACTORY SITES

We have a number of most desirable sites for factory purposes, with facilities for railway sidings, and all have direct rail connection with the harbour. There are sites available at the harbour for industries which would require waterfront accommodation.

AS A DISTRIBUTING CENTRE

As a distributing centre for manufactured goods Cobourg offers exceptional advantages, having facilities for railway, highway and waterfront commerce. It is also a Port of Entry for Customs purposes.

Cobourg Harbour (View No. 1)

This view of the Harbour shows vessels with 18 ft. draft unloading at our docks. The Car Ferries require 22 feet of water and are readily accommodated at their own docks. This picture also shows the rail connections at the Harbour.

This view shows the S.S. Dewstone, from England, unloading textile machinery. We have also had other overseas vessels unload here, bringing in machinery, jute, hides and other merchandise for merchants and for our factories. One of the two large Car Ferries of the Canadian National Steamship Lines is also shown. Cobourg is their home port.
