
It is these experiences — those that we have outside of the classroom — that make us the sociable and mature people we should strive to be.



The campus couple is a unique species of human being. Although known to consist of two individuals, this social phenomenon often thinks and acts as one. Bisection of the species can be an unhappy event.











ABOUT THE TEAMS
