
streets. The winner of this year's parade was the Class of 2009 with a float that portrayed "The Game of Life." After the parade, many went to



of *The Tempest*. In midst of his direction and advice, the cast were able to use his expertise to enrich their performance. Directing the production was theatre professor Michael Swanson.





>oming into the 2008 season, the members of the field hockey team had high expectations. The team was tied for second place in the 2008 Commonwealth Conference field hockey preseason poll. The Lady Jays began their season with a six game running streak, which set the tone for the 2008 season. Leading the team this year were senior captains Megan Angstadt and Tiffany Vogel.
