As leaders of tomorrow you have completed four years of apprenticeship of life. You have grown sturdy as an oak tree and have matured from stripling to an embending tower of strength.



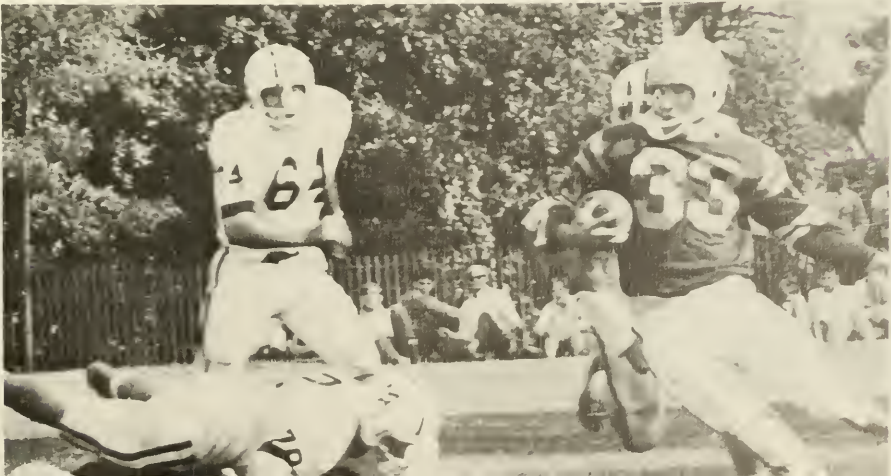
Captain Ted Cottrell, John Nice, Harry Capazolli, and Wayne Mehalick were selected to the past season M.A.C. All-Star Team.

The Aggies, by the way, finished seventh as a team in the competition which includes the University Division as well.







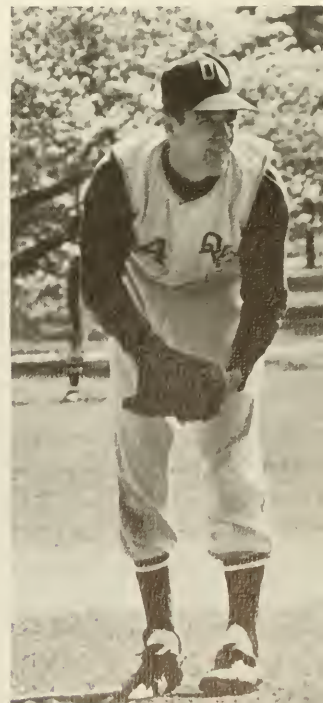
