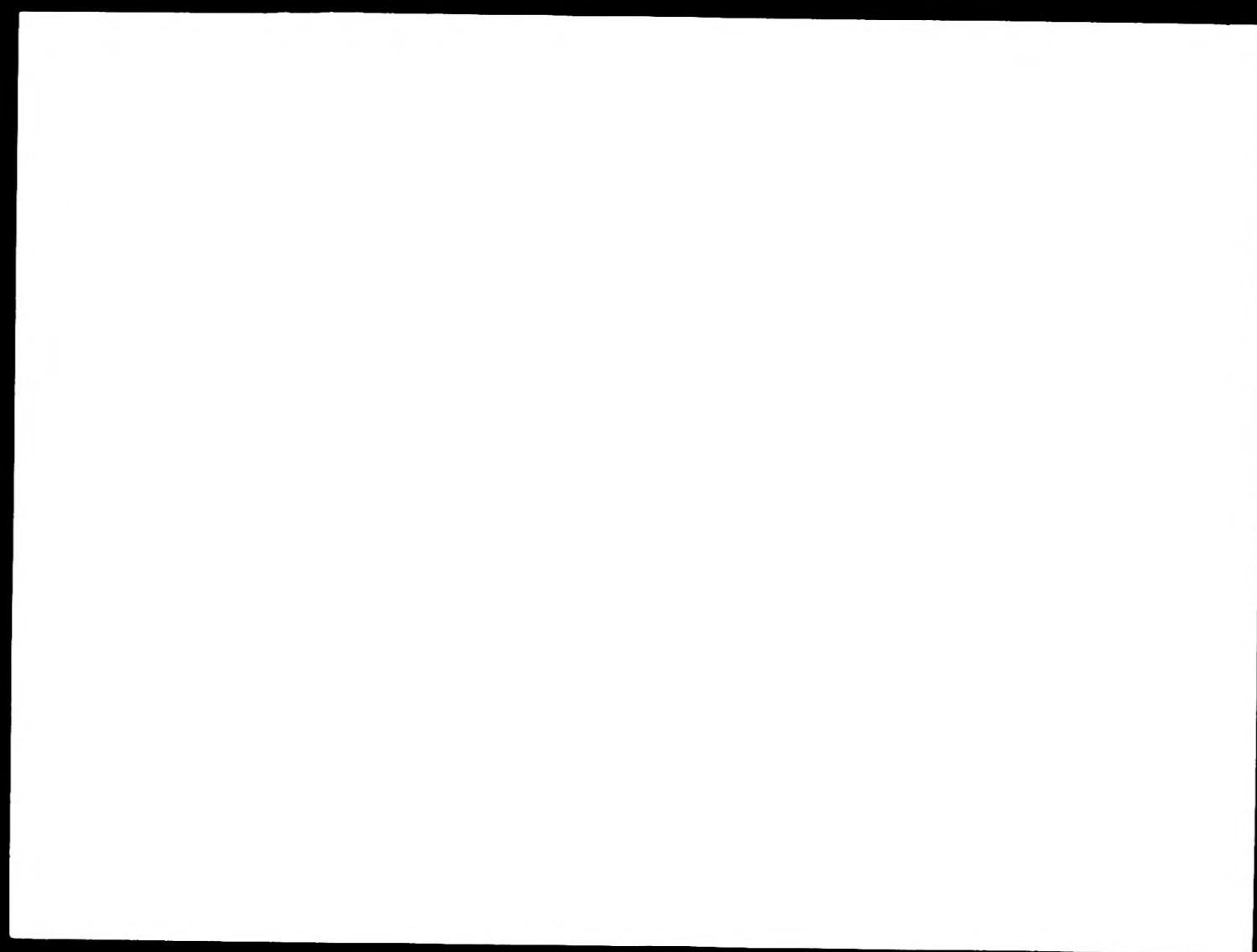




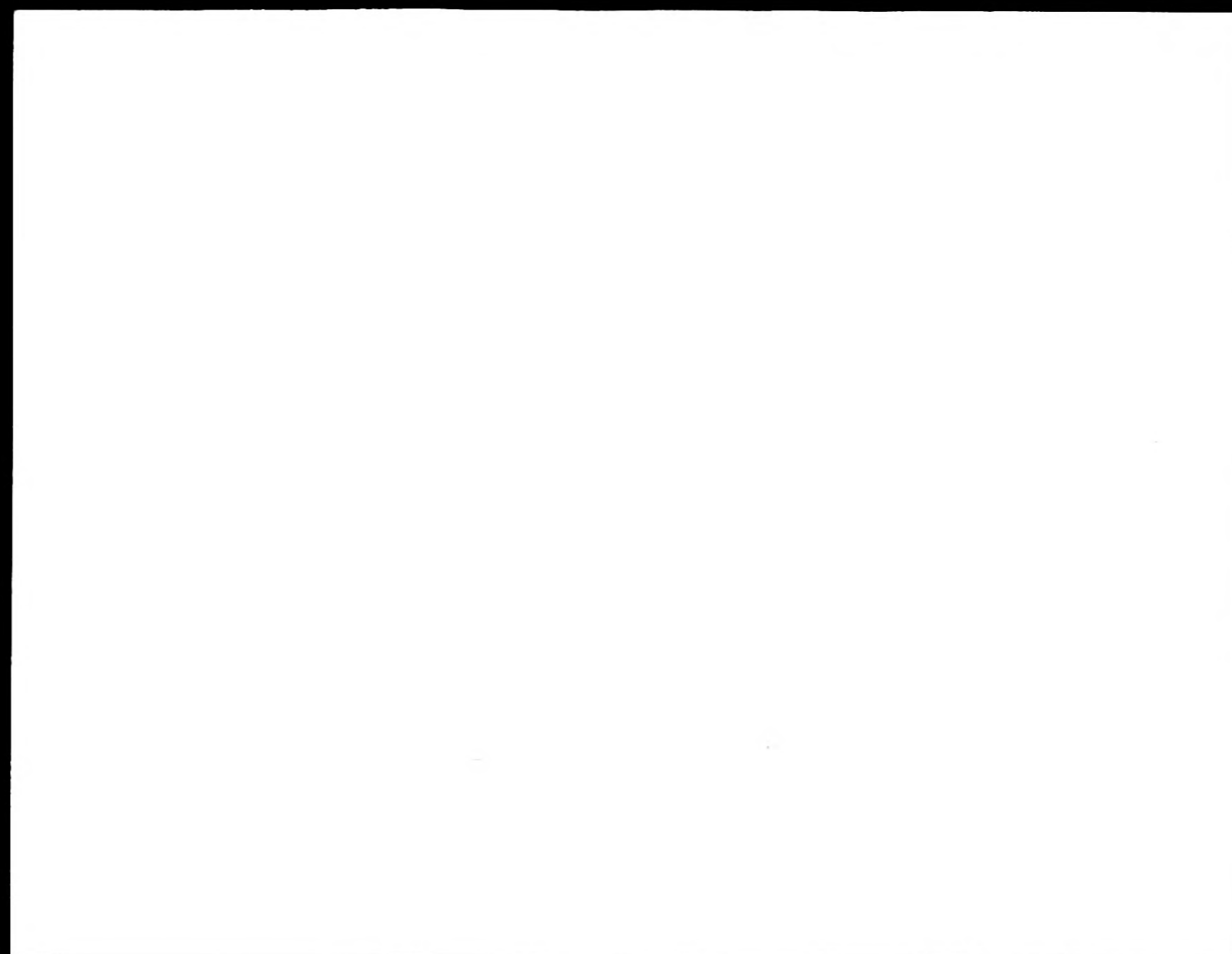




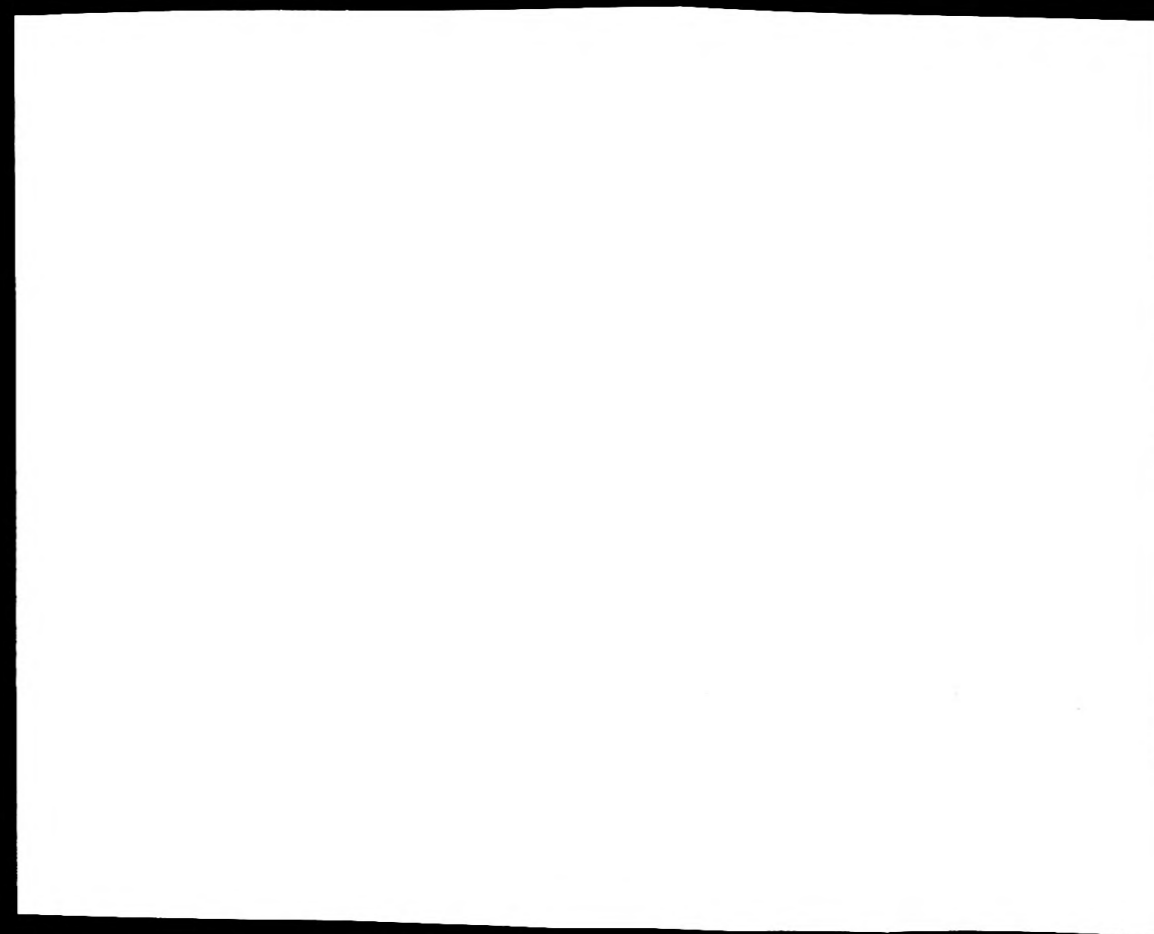




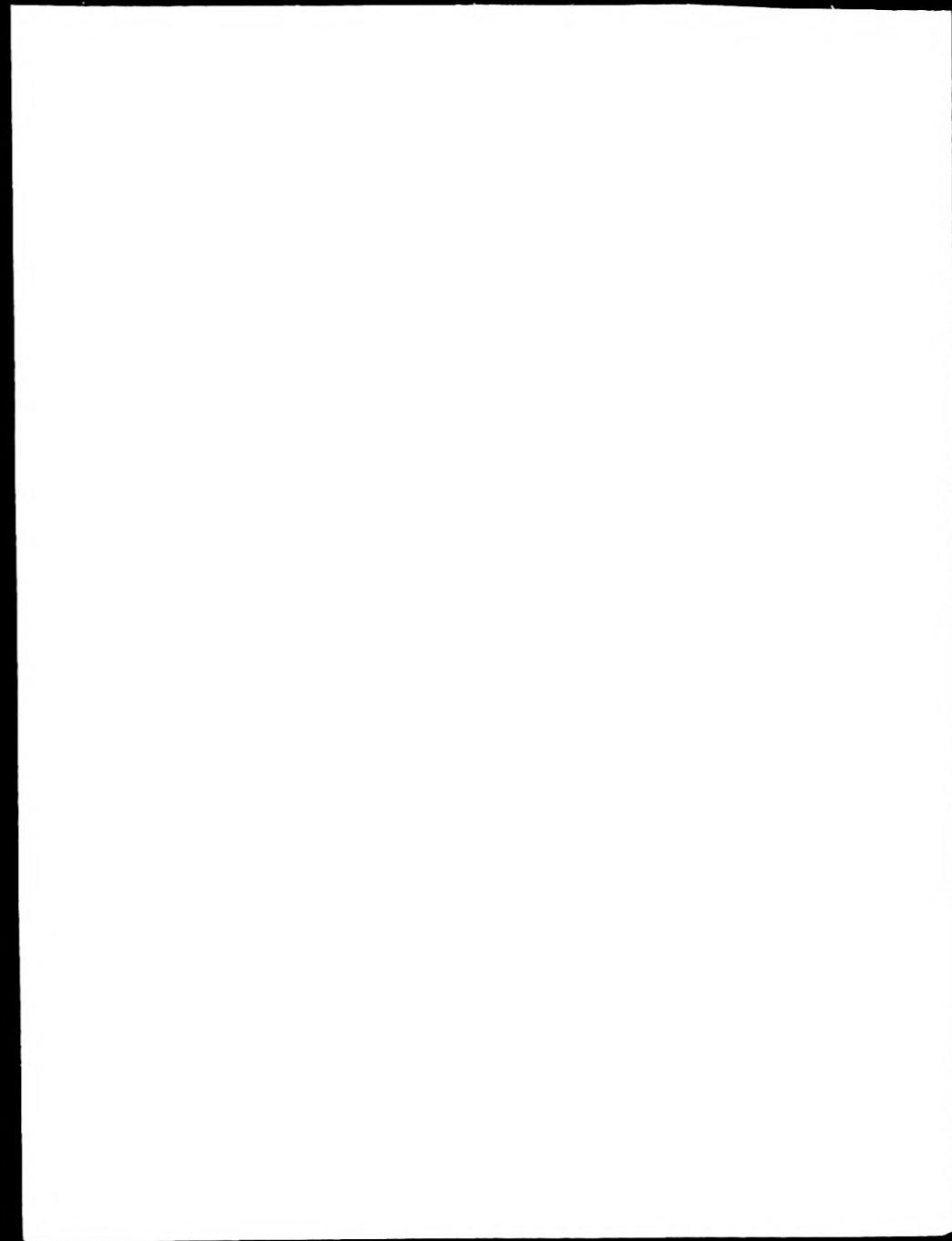




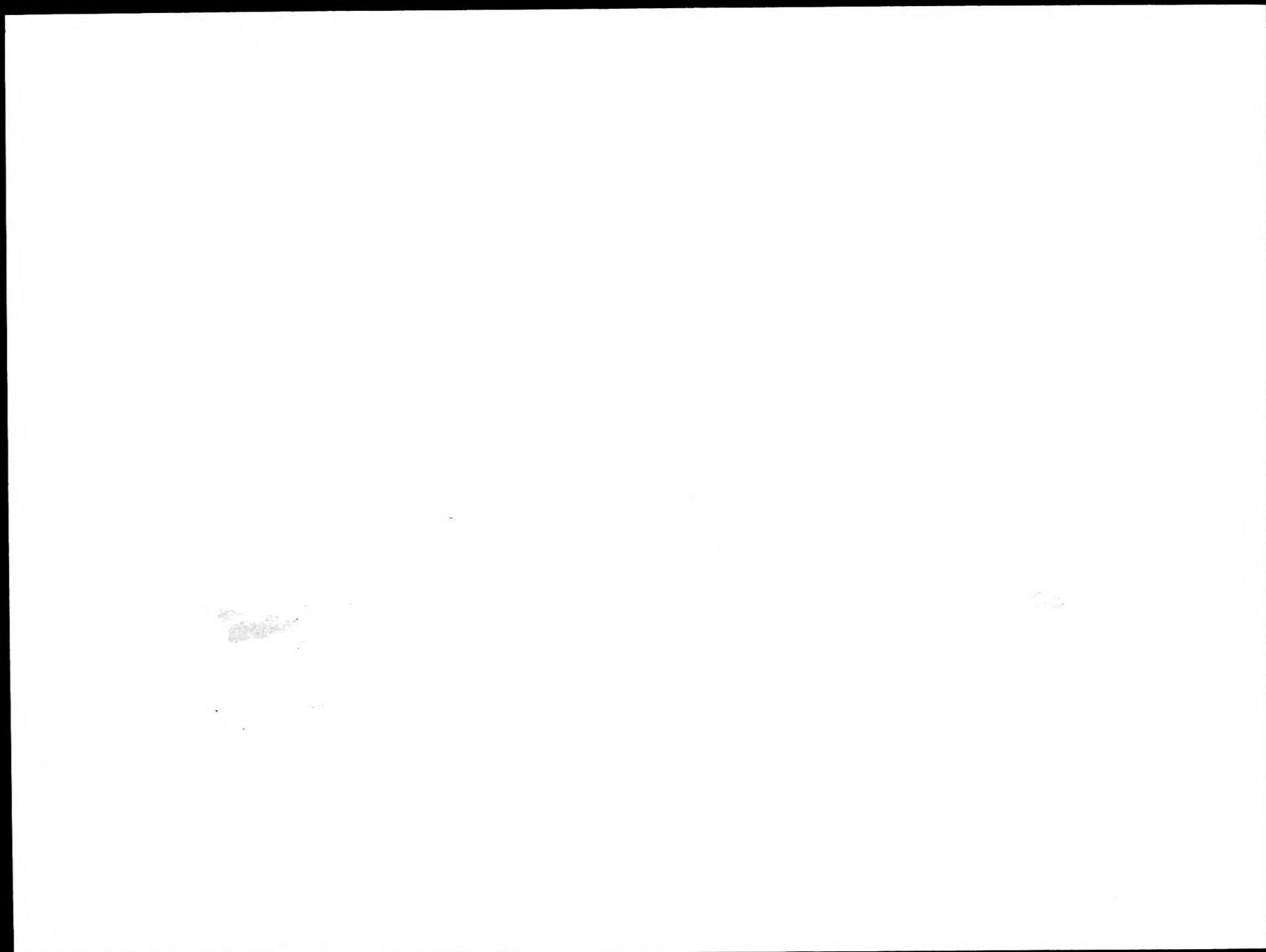




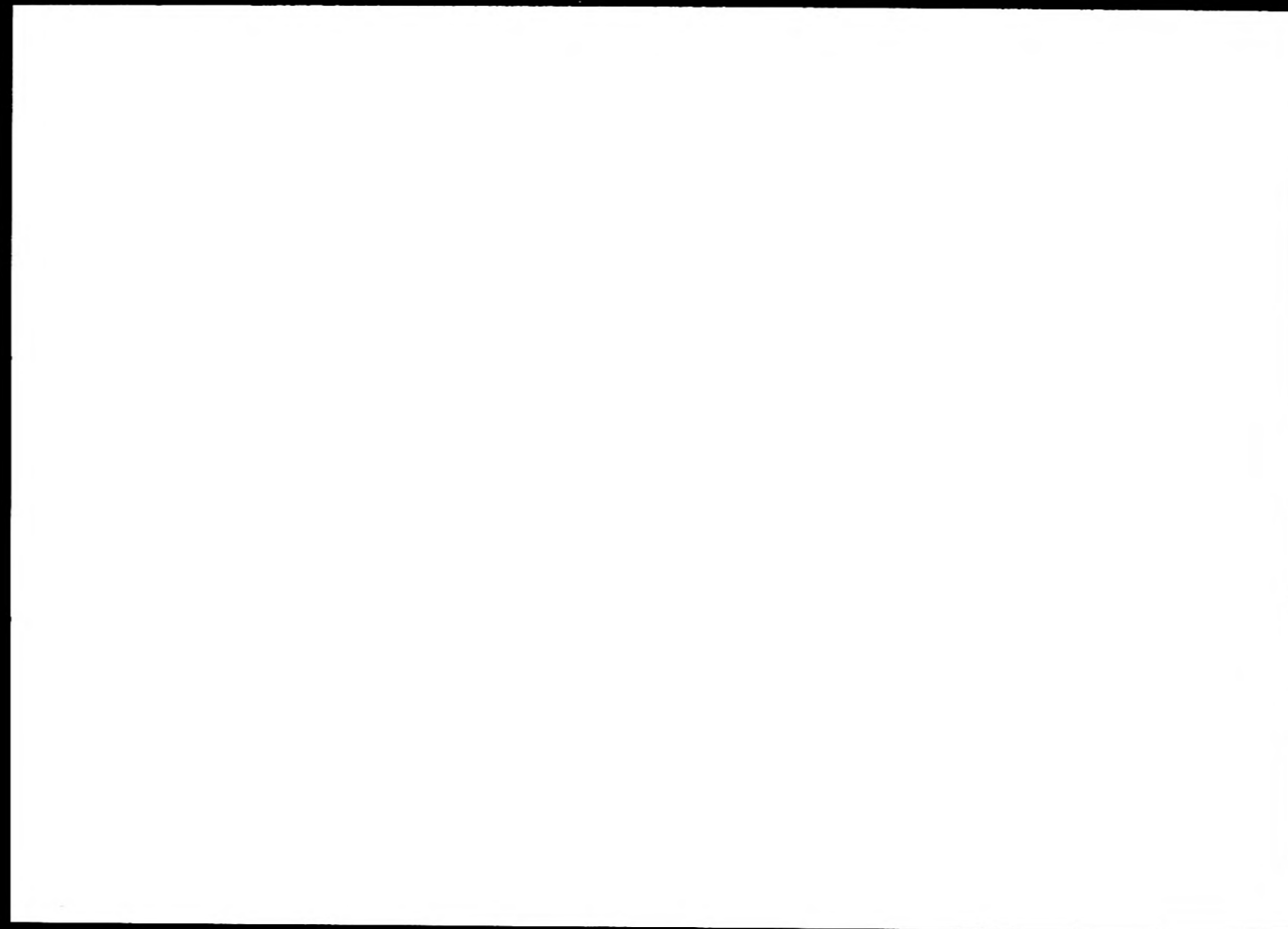


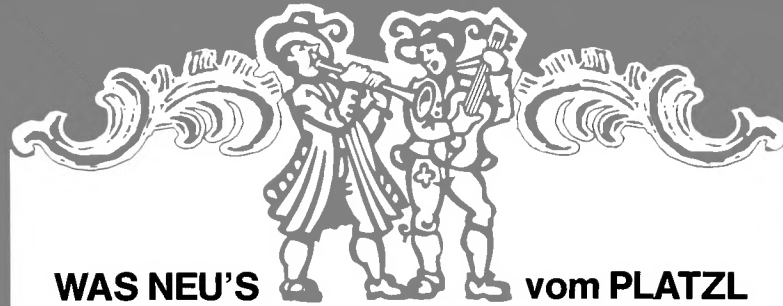












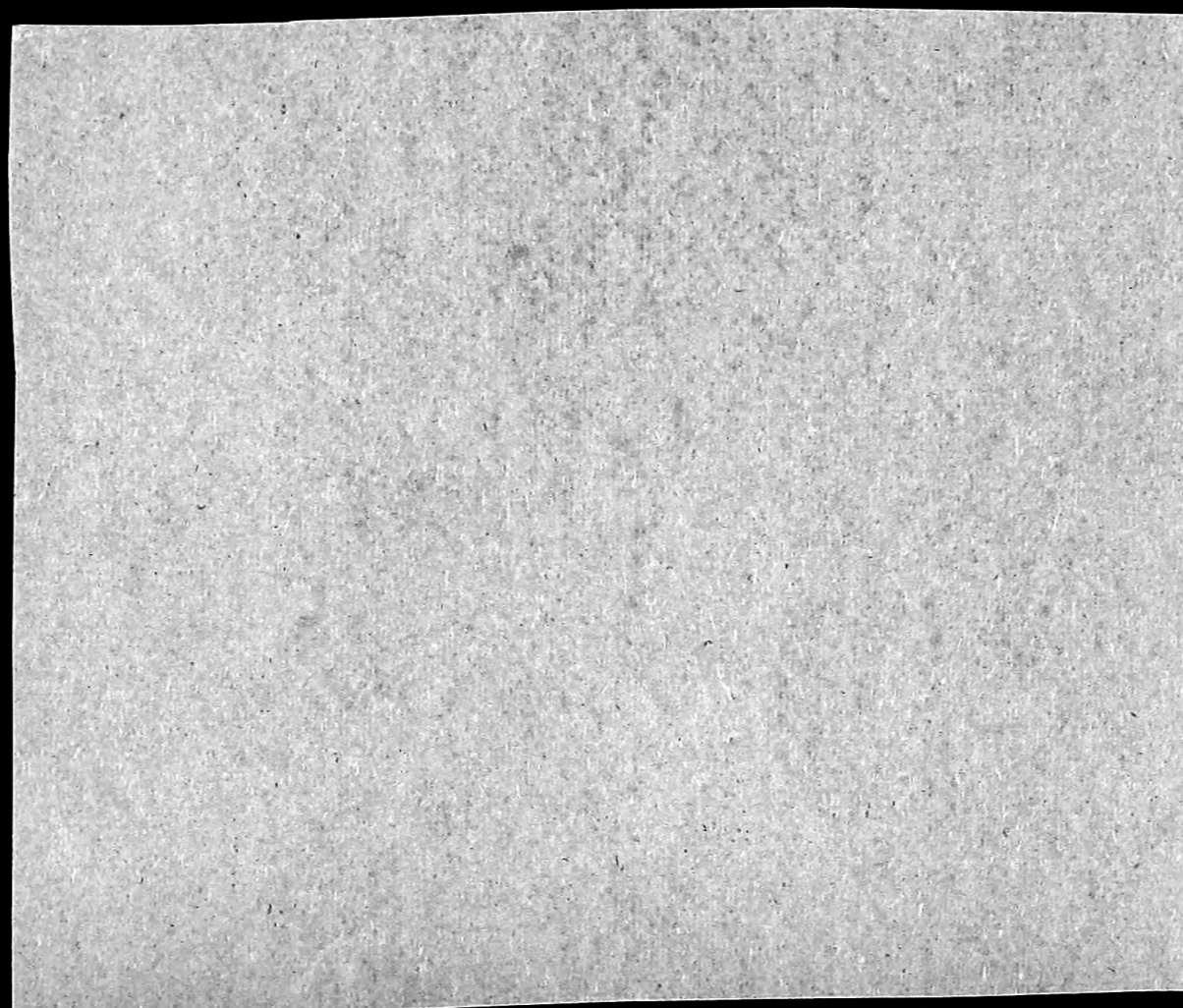
WAS NEU'S vom PLATZL
