With its present growth and interest the Sigma Theta Fraternity can be expected to show even more progress in its future activities.



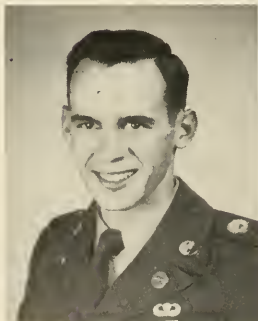

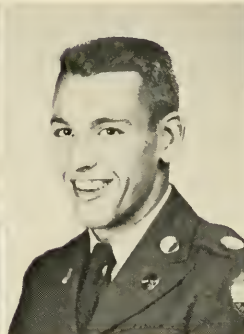


The Rex Fraternity is one of the traditional organizations of North Georgia College. It was organized in 1917 and is the oldest fraternity now on the campus.
