The following brief account of John Darby of Marblehead, Mass., and of the first four generations of his descendants is published, in this meagre form, first, to preserve concerning this family, genealogical facts that have cost much time and labor to collect; second, to induce all who are interested, to aid in correcting its errors and to contribute additional facts.

I have some material with regard to nearly all the persons mentioned in this list. It is my wish and hope to publish within a reasonable time a fuller account of this family down, perhaps, to the eighth generation, in America. Who the emigrant ancestor was, and what his connection with English forbears, are questions still to be answered.

Those who can detect and correct errors in the data which follow, or supply further information, are earnestly requested to do so without delay.

1. JOHN¹ DARBY, fisherman, resided at Marblehead, Mass. His parentage, place and date of birth, place and date of marriage, and of death are unknown. The earliest known mention of him occurs in Coffin's Copy of Essex Co. (Mass.) Court Records, Vol. II, p. 300. He is named there as a creditor of John Clay, a Marblehead fisherman who had been slain by the Indians. The amount of the debt was £3; the date of entry in Coffin is Nov. 8, 1677.

His wife's name was Alice ———. Her parentage, date of birth and of death are not known. The inventory of John Darby's estate, bearing date of June 17, 1690, is found in Coffin's Copy of Essex Co. Court Records, Vol. III, p. 419

July 2, 1690, John Darby's widow m. John³ Woodbury, of Beverly, son of John² and Elizabeth Woodbury, and grandson of John¹ and Agnes Woodbury, emigrants. John³ Woodbury was bapt. First Ch., Salem, Mass., Oct. 24, 1641; d. North Beverly, Jan. 2, 1716.

John Darby, March 15, 1683, bought of the selectmen of Marblehead a lot of land in that town for 20s. This lot was sold, Oct. 26, 1713, to Ebenezer Ingalls, of Marblehead, cooper, for £15. (Essex Co. Deeds, V. 27, p. 77.) Benjamin Darby's name does not appear in this deed. His tax in Beverly was abated Nov. 22, 1708.

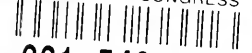
