INTRODUCTION

A decade ago, when Virginia Faye Taylor and I prepared the death notices carried in the local newspaper, we were pleased with the information that the little booklet provided. Almost 200 copies were distributed.

A systematic review and checking of information has been made allowing a number of additional notices to be included in the revised and enlarged edition presented here. The entire manuscript has been retyped and corrected to provide the most accurate information possible.

Entries followed by (1) are from Myra Inman's diary which spans the period 1859-1865. Myra Inman was a teenager who kept a daily diary for her activities during the period. In addition to entries about activities with school, church, and family, there were entries for deaths and marriages. These citations have been included to make the booklet more comprehensive.

After the name will be given the age at the time of death (if available), the death date is preceded by "d," the cause of death, and the issue of the Cleveland Banner in which the obituary was recorded. Some individuals have several entries, particularly those with some church or fraternal association. When more than one reference is available, it is indicated by a number in parenthesis, as (2) or (3).

This publication includes well over a thousand names for individuals who died in Bradley County, as well as the surrounding counties of James, McMinn, Polk, Rhea, and some other East Tennessee or North Georgia counties. Some former residents who migrated to the West had their obituary notices recorded in the local newspaper. 1/8/92
