


# ELIJAH CLARENCE HILLS • 1867-1932



ELIJAH CLARENCE HILLS was, from 1922 till his death, first a Professor of Spanish and then Professor of Romance Philology at the University of California. A native of Illinois, reared in Florida, he graduated from Cornell in 1892 and studied in Paris; he was successively professor in Rollins College, in Colorado College, librarian of the Hispanic Society of America, and head for romance languages at Indiana University. For his distinguished achievements in Spanish philology, he was made Knight Commander of the Royal Order of Queen Isabel.

In Professor Hills were combined vast and precise learning with extraordinary humanity. Though a grammarian and philologist, his teaching implied the great world. He had a talent for friendship: capable of the seclusions of the scholar and editor and born to an inviolable personal dignity, he possessed also an uncommon social charm which exercised itself in widening circles. His charity showed as kindliness, deference, tolerance, the sharing of the possessions his long labors had accumulated. He was a wise collector of books, and specialized in Spanish lexicons. Mrs. Hills presented to the University of California his collection of books, one of which is here inscribed to his memory.





# A BIT OF HISTORY

In the late fall of 1914, Mr. L. A. Wilkins endeavored to form in New York City a society of teachers of Spanish. The person named to head the organization, neglected, though urged, to proceed with the work. In September, 1916, Mr. Wilkins again proposed that the teachers of Spanish form an organization. For this purpose, on October 21, 1916, a meeting was held at which a constitution was adopted for a society calling itself The Association of Teachers of Spanish. The following persons were elected officers: President, Lawrence A. Wilkins; Vice-President, Alfred Coester; Secretary-Treasurer, Miss H. G. Smithers; Corresponding Secretary, Max A. Luria.

During the winter, Professor A. M. Espinosa, of Stanford University, who had heard from Mr. Wilkins of the activities of this Association, entered into correspondence with him and with Professor J. D. Fitz-Gerald, of the University of Illinois, concerning the formation of a national society and the publication of a journal, HISPANIA, which would be its official organ. Professor Fitz-Gerald suggested the nationalization of the New York Association. Professor Espinosa urged the immediate organization of The American Association of Teachers of Spanish, and to supply funds to meet the expenses of organization, persuaded Mr. Juan C. Cebrián and Mr. Archer M. Huntington to give their assistance. Mr. Wilkins, as temporary president, and Dr. Coester, as temporary secretary-treasurer, prepared a circular letter which was sent to large numbers of teachers throughout the United States in May, 1917.

At the same time, the New York teachers decided to make their organization national in scope and become the New York Chapter of The American Association of Teachers of Spanish. The response to the circular letter was so good that Mr. Wilkins appointed a committee to draw up a constitution, of which Professor Ventura Fuentes of the College of the City of New York was chairman.

This committee reported at the first annual meeting held in the auditorium of The College of the City of New York on December 29, 1917. The constitution was adopted. The officers named by the

committee on nominations, Professor Fitz-Gerald chairman, were elected for a term of two years. Professor Espinosa was appointed editor of HISPANIA, to be published quarterly; an organization number of which had appeared in November.

At the second annual meeting, held in Barnard College, New York, December 28, 1918, the report of the committee on seal, Dr. Coester, chairman, was accepted. The first reproduction of the seal ever made in its proper colors is given in the frontispiece of this book. Professor Fitz-Gerald, chairman of the committee on honorary members, proposed thirty foreign Hispanists for honorary membership and they were duly elected. Furthermore, the financial affairs of the Association, owing to the increase in membership and the activity of the advertising manager, Dr. E. W. Roessler, were reported in such a flourishing condition that it was voted to publish six numbers of HISPANIA, though the section in the constitution defining the journal as a quarterly was left unchanged.

The third annual meeting was held at Washington, D. C., in the Law School of George Washington University on December 27, 1919. The fourth annual meeting met at Chicago in the Auditorium Hotel. The innovation of holding meetings on two days, December 30 and 31, 1920, was tried with such success that the custom was continued at the fifth annual meeting, again in the Law School of George Washington University, December 30 and 31, 1921.

### CONSTITUTION

### Article I. Name.

The name of this Association shall be The American Association of Teachers of Spanish.

# Article II. Purpose.

The purpose of this Association shall be the advancement of the study of the Spanish Language and Literature through the promotion of friendly relations among its members; through the publication of articles and the results of investigation by members, or others; through the presentation and discussion of papers at annual meetings; and through such other means as may tend to promote the efficiency of its members as teachers of Spanish.

# Article III. Membership.

- 1. The membership of this Association shall be composed of two classes: active and honorary.
- 2. Active membership shall be open to all teachers of Spanish and to all those interested in the teaching of Spanish.
- 3. Distinguished Hispanists, to a number not to exceed thirty, may be elected to honorary membership. Honorary members shall receive an engraved certificate of election, sealed with the seal of the Association and signed by the President and the Secretary-Treasurer; and they shall receive gratis the official publication of the Association. Honorary members shall enjoy all the privileges of active members except the right to vote.

# Article IV. Officers.

- 1. The officers of this Association shall be a President, three Vice-Presidents, a Secretary-Treasurer, and an Executive Council consisting of these five officers and four other members.
- 2. The term of these officers shall be as follows: for the President, Third Vice-President, and one of the four other members, one year; for the Second Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, and one of the four other members, two years; for the First Vice-President, and two of the other four members, three years.
- 3. Elections shall be held at each annual meeting, and all officers shall be elected by a majority vote.

- 4. Vacancies occurring between two annual meetings shall be filled by action of the Executive Council.
  - 5. There shall be Honorary Presidents.

# Article V. Duties of Officers.

The President, Vice-President, and Secretary-Treasurer shall perform the usual duties of such officers.

The Executive Council shall perform the duties hereinafter provided.

### Article VI. Election of Members.

Application for membership may be made to the Secretary-Treasurer by any person desiring to become a member.

All persons receiving the affirmative vote of a majority of the Executive Council shall become members of the Association upon payment of the annual dues.

#### Article VII. The Executive Council.

- 1. The President shall act as Chairman of the Executive Council.
- 2. The Council shall make all arrangements for the annual meeting, and shall cause to be printed a copy of the program in the issue of HISPANIA immediately preceding the annual meeting.
- 3. The Council may appoint committees to investigate and report upon subjects germane to the purposes of the Association.

#### Article VIII. Dues.

- 1. Each active member shall pay two dollars annually to the Secretary-Treasurer, fifty cents for dues and one dollar and fifty cents for subscription to HISPANIA; and no member who is in default shall be qualified to exercise any privilege of membership.
- 2. Any person who is in arrears more than one year may be dropped from the rolls.
  - 3. Honorary members shall be exempt from the payment of dues.
- 4. Any member, or any person eligible to membership, may become a life member by a single payment of twenty-five dollars.
- 5. No memberships in the Association nor subscriptions to HISPANIA shall be separately accepted; all members of the Association are subscribers to HISPANIA.

# Article IX. Official Organ of the Association.

- 1. The official publication of this Association shall be known as HISPANIA, and it shall appear quarterly.
- 2. The Editorial Staff of this publication shall be appointed by the Executive Council and shall consist of the following: an Editor, two Consulting Editors, nine Associate Editors, and an Advertising Manager.
- 3. These shall hold office for three years, except the Associate Editors, who shall be appointed as follows: The first year the President shall appoint three Associate Editors for a term of one year, three for two years, and three for three years. Thereafter, the Executive Council shall appoint annually three Associate Editors for a term of three years.

# Article X. Annual Meeting.

The Association shall meet annually at such time and place as the Executive Council may select, and those present shall constitute a quorum.

# Article XI. By-Laws.

By-Laws may be adopted at any annual meeting of the Association.

#### Article XII. Amendments.

- 1. The Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote of those present and voting at any annual meeting; provided that written notice of any proposed amendment shall be sent to the Secretary-Treasurer by at least five members of the Association in time to be published in the last issue of HISPANIA prior to the meeting at which it is to be voted upon.
- 2. It shall be the duty of the Secretary-Treasurer to cause to be published in HISPANIA all amendments thus proposed.

# By-Laws.

1. Nominations for Office. At each annual meeting the President shall appoint a committee of five, not officers of the Association, to present nominations for the offices to be filled at the next annual meeting. The nominations shall be printed in the form of a ballot in the last issue of HISPANIA previous to the annual meeting; and a blank space shall be provided for each office, under the name of the

candidate nominated by the committee, upon which additional nominations may be made. Members who do not intend to be present at the annual meeting may then use these ballots to send their votes by mail to the Secretary-Treasurer, who shall, at the meeting, count these mail votes with those cast at the meeting.

Nominations of the first officers of the Association shall be made for a term of two years, and the first officers elected will, accordingly, hold office for two years.

- 2. Meetings of the Executive Council. There shall be a regular annual meeting of the Executive Council prior to the meeting of the Association. A special meeting of the Executive Council shall be called by the President on the written request of at least four members of the Council, and notice of such meeting shall be sent to every member two weeks in advance.
- 3. Local Chapters. Local chapters may be organized by fifteen or more members of the Association in regional groups of institutions for such purposes not inconsistent with the Constitution and By-Laws of the National Association as such chapters may determine. The Constitutions of such chapters must be approved by the Executive Council of the National Association, and the members must all be in good standing in the parent organization.
- 4. Committee on Honorary Membership. There shall be a standing committee of ten who shall report to the Executive Council the names and qualifications of persons for honorary memberships. Such report shall be made yearly in time to be printed in HISPANIA before the occurrence of the annual meeting of the Association.

#### HISPANIA

The first issue of the official organ of the Association was the Organization Number published in November, 1917, consisting of forty pages. Volume I in its four numbers contained 282 pages of articles, reviews, and bibliographies. With volume II, began the practice of printing six numbers corresponding to the months of February, March, May, October, November, and December. It had 328 pages. Volume III consisted of 340 pages, volume IV of 332 pages, and volume V, it is hoped, will offer its readers about 400 pages. Testifying to the recognition of the importance of the matter HISPANIA presents to Spanish students is the increasing number of the great libraries now members of the Association.

The editorial policy of HISPANIA, consistently followed from its inception, was thus stated in the Organization Number, by the Editor:

"The betterment of the teaching of Spanish in our schools and colleges is our chief aim. The pedagogical side of our work, however, is to be viewed from a broad standpoint. Real, sympathetic teaching involves more than mere class drill or reciting lessons from textbooks. The American teacher of Spanish of tomorrow must be well prepared not only in the ordinary school and college disciplines which involve a good knowledge of the language and literature of Spain and the ability and enthusiasm necessary for successful teaching. Equally necessary is a complete and sympathetic understanding of the history and culture of Spain and Spanish America. For these reasons, Hispania, aside from giving to problems of pure pedagogical interest the great attention which they deserve, will also attempt to interpret sympathetically to our pupils and teachers of Spanish the history and culture of the great Spain of the past and present."


