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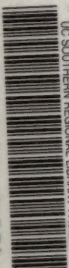
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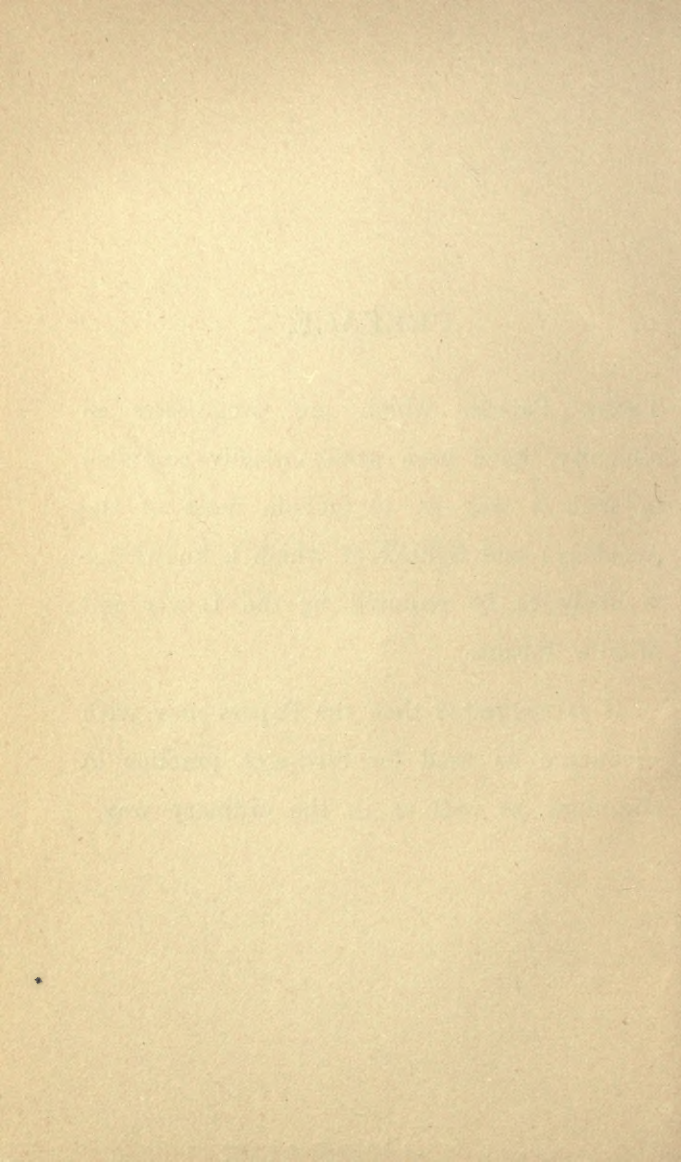
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## PREFACE.

THESE Papers, which are progressive in difficulty, have been systematically compiled in such a way as to include most of the Accidence and Syntax of which a knowledge is likely to be required by the Lower and Middle Forms.

It is suggested that the Papers may with advantage be used for *vivâ-voce* practice in Grammar, as well as in the ordinary way.

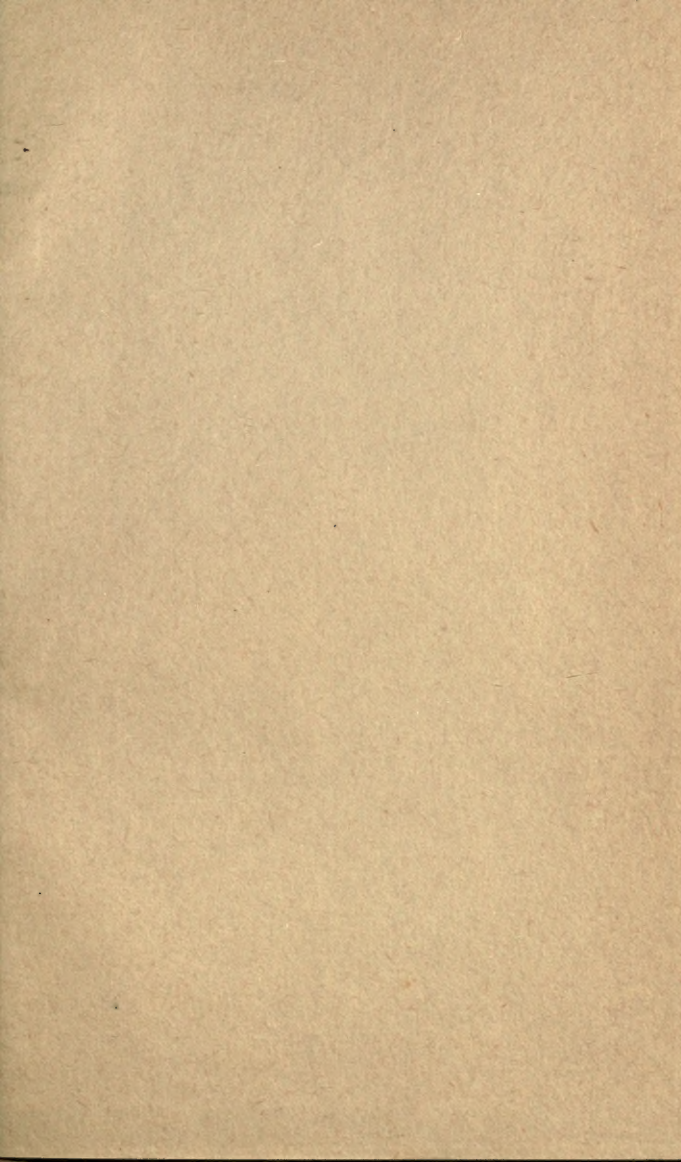
