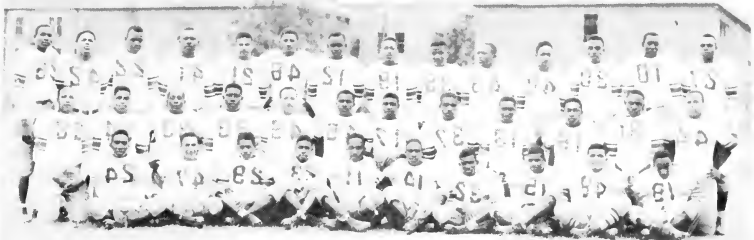












## THE FIGHTING PIRATES
