CLASS HISTORY

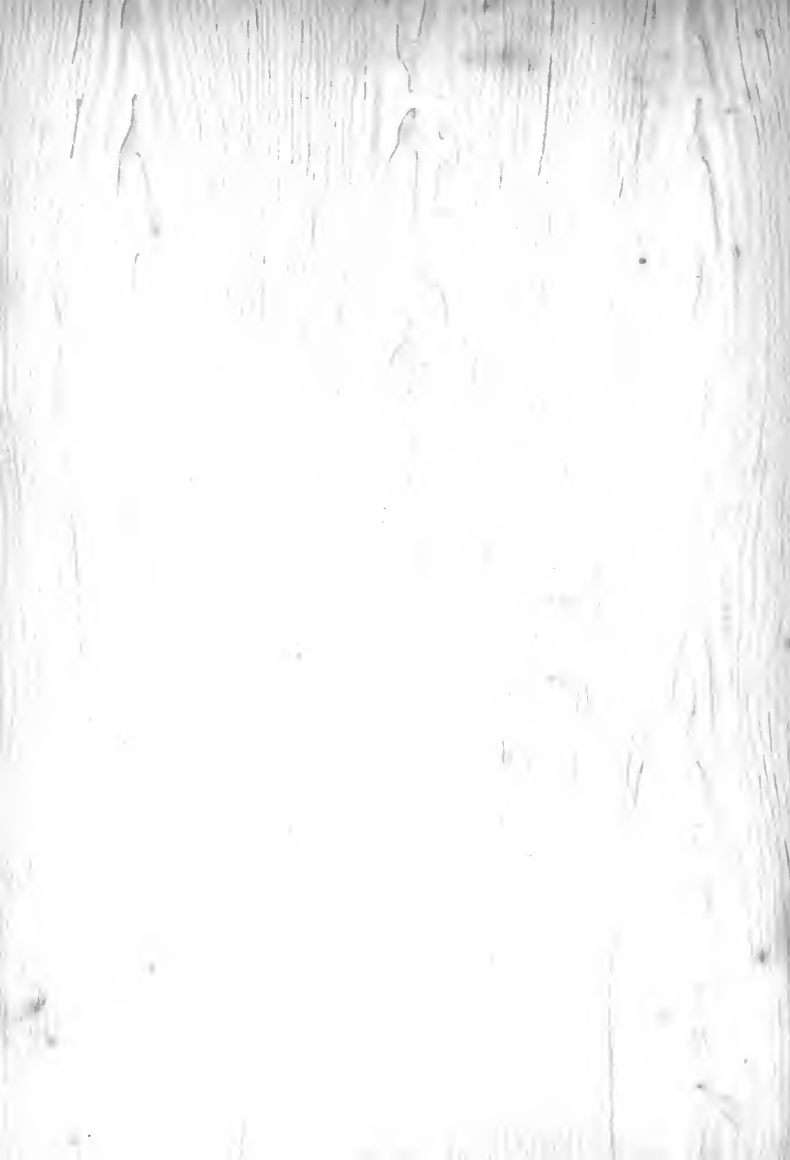

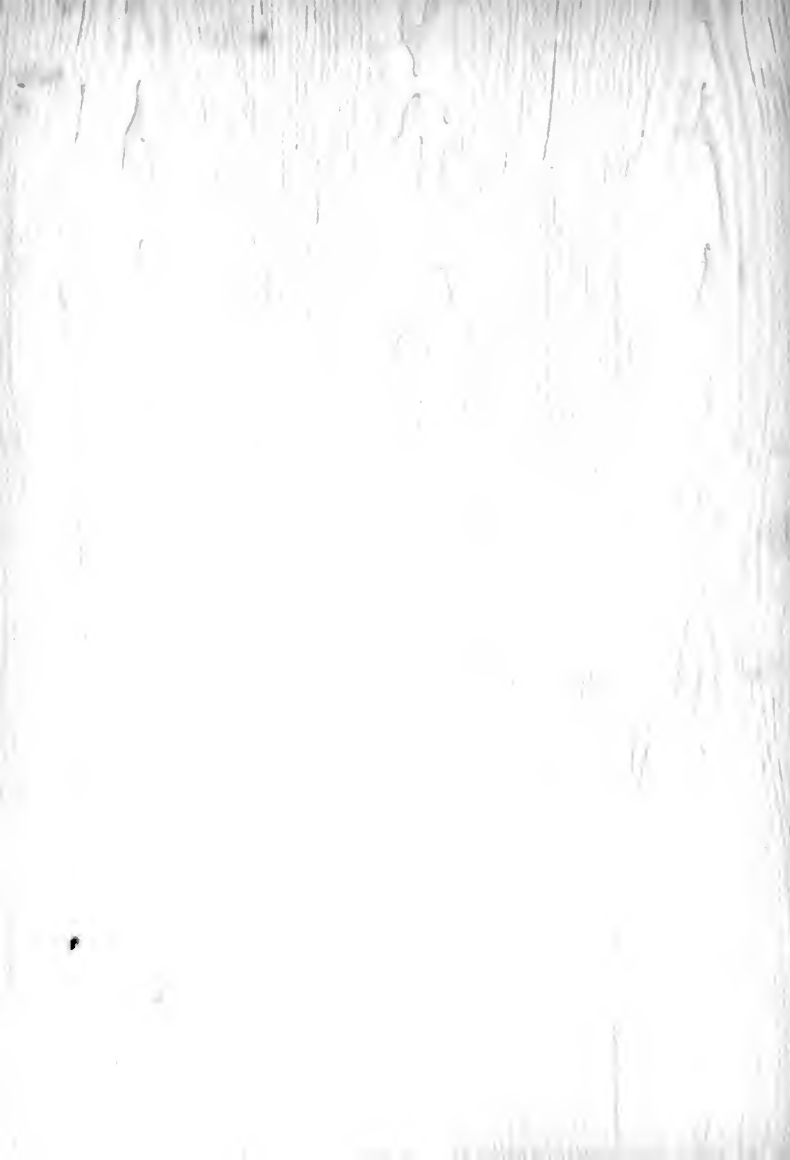
Hail to the White, and hail to the Blue, hail to the Fighting Pirates.
