GEORGE the Third, by the Grace of God, King of Great Britain, France and Ireland, Defender of the Faith &c. To all to whom thefe Prefents fhall come, GREETING. WHEREAS John Burton, Musician, hath, by his Petition, humbly reprefented unto Us, That he has, with great Labour and Study, composed Ten Sonatas for the Harpfichord, and feveral other Pieces of Vocal and Inftrumental Mufick; And, in Regard the faid Works are intirely New, and were never before printed, hath humbly befought Us to grant Him Our Royal Privilege and Licence for the Sole Printing and Publishing thereof for the Term of Fourteen Years; AND WHEREAS We, being willing to give all due Encouragement to Works of this Nature, are gracioufly pleafed to condefcend to that his Requeft, WE DO, therefore, by thefe Prefents, fo far as may be agreeable to the Statute in that Behalf made and provided, grant unto him, the faid John Burton, his Executors, Adminiftrators, and Affigns, Our Royal Licence for the Sole Printing and Publifhing the faid Works for the Term of Fourteen Years, to be computed from the Date hereof; Strictly forbiding all Our Subjects within Our Kingdoms and Dominions, to reprint or abridge the Same, either in the like, or any other Volume or Volumes whatfoever; or to import, buy, vend, utter, or diftribute any Copies thereof reprinted beyond the Seas, during the aforefaid Term of Fourteen Years, without the Confent or Approbation of the faid John Burton, his Heirs, Executors, and Affigns, under their Hands and Seals first had and obtained, as they will answer the contrary at their Perils. Whereof the Commissioners and other Officers of Our Cuftoms, and the Mafter, Warden, and Company of Stationers, are to take Notice that due Obedience may be rendered to Our Pleafure herein declared. GIVEN at Our Court at St James's the Twelfth Day of July 1766 in the Sixth Year of Our Reign.
